Sheldon was pinned by Tim Crocker of Kearney in the finals, Deeds lost 9-5 to Travis Rempe of Smith Center and Scherling lost 6-2 to Cody Sparks of Kearney.

Goodland had 102.5 points as a team. Kearney was first with 238.5, Smith Center second with 154.5 and Oakley third with 106.


Behind Goodland were Osborne with 86. Oberlin with 77, McCook, Neb., with 63, Hill City with 38 and Quinter with 0.

The junior varsity had an outstanding weekend, said Coach Steve Evert, and is improving each week


