# REPORT.

OFFICE OF THE STATE LIBRARIAN,  
DES MOINES, October 1, 1879. }

*To the Honorable, the Legislature of the State of Iowa:*

IN accordance with legal requirement, I have the pleasure herewith to present to your honorable body the following report of this department of the public service.

Since July 1, 1878, a quarterly report has been made to the Governor, and will be found on file in his office.

At the date of the last report the whole number of books in the library was..... 15,836

Additions made since are:

By purchase..... 1,201

By donation and exchange..... 1,136

Total additions..... 2,337

Whole number in library..... 18,273

The balance of cash on hand will be used to pay for books already ordered and subscribed for, but which could not be delivered before the close of the fiscal year.

Previous to 1878 the miscellaneous expenses of the library, including expressage and binding, were paid out of the contingent fund; since that time, as will be seen from the financial statement, they have been paid from the library fund, thus reducing the amount of said fund \$541.20 in the two years.

In view of the late financial depression it has been thought best by the management of the library to reduce its business to a cash basis,



selling our Supreme Court Reports for cash and paying cash for all purchases, by which arrangement we save time and money.

I would respectfully call your attention to the valuable aid the Geological Report of Iowa would give to the library. I am assured that many, if not all, of the scientific associations of Europe would be glad to give us their publications in exchange for our geological reports. There are now in the hands of Messrs. Mills & Co. 600 "White's Geological Reports of Iowa" which they agree to furnish to the State for the cost of printing and binding. Were they turned over to the library for the purpose of exchange, they would be an invaluable aid in procuring scientific works.

With the rapidly increasing number of volumes, and the necessary cataloguing of the same; the preparation of books for binding; the large and constantly increasing correspondence; the increased number of visitors and the attention they should receive; the examination of catalogues and circulars, and the making of lists for purchase; the time consumed through the want of a good subject catalogue—in directing young students and strangers who wish to consult the general library in their search for "everything you have" on a certain topic; these and a thousand-and-one details known only to librarians, require so much time and labor that at times some duties must be hurried through and others put off "to a more convenient season." I would therefore respectfully request that the librarian be legally authorized to employ, by the advice and consent of the trustees, such clerical help as may be thought necessary to properly discharge the duties of the office.
