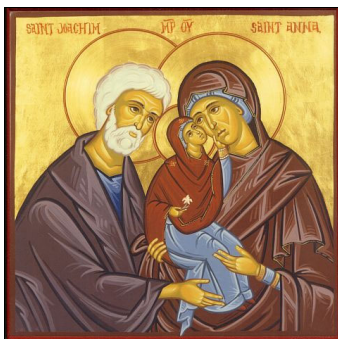

MISSION APPEAL THIS WEEKEND

TO TEACH WHO CHRIST IS

As mentioned previously, Cardinal George has announced that our entire archdiocese will be involved in a new campaign on behalf of Catholic education and faith formation: **To Teach Who Christ Is**. The campaign will help parishes support local Catholic schools, religious education programs, youth ministry and adult faith formation. St. Mary's is developing a case statement for our own campaign here in the parish. One aspect of our campaign will be to raise funds for financial assistance for families in our school and religious education program who have difficulty in covering the tuition or fees. Another aspect of our campaign will be to strengthen and expand our ministry to high school students.

While a campaign needs many volunteers to be successful, the first volunteers I am organizing is a group of parishioners who will pray daily for the Lord's blessing on the "**To Teach Who Christ Is**" campaign. Please look for more information about the campaign each week in the bulletin and on our website.

GO MAKE OF ALL DISCIPLES

I have spent some time this summer looking at the religion curriculum for our school and religious education program. Currently, both our school and religious education program use the "Blest Are We" series published by RCL Benziger. While that series has many strengths, I also believe we need to supplement those texts with additional resources for the teachers and catechists. So this year the children will continue using the "Blest Are We" series and their teachers will also be given the texts from the "Faith and Life" series from Ignatius Press. I am impressed with how the "Faith and Life" books cover the Incarnation, the Divinity and Humanity of Jesus, the nature of the Church, and the Sacraments, especially the Mass. Investing in the teachers and catechists is important, so that they can be as effective as possible in sharing our faith with the children.

My thanks to all who are teachers in the School of St. Mary and the catechists in our religious education program for all of their efforts on behalf of the children.

Religious Education News

During the second week of July, another session of Religious Education summer Intensive classes was held for 6th, 7th, and 8th graders. Students engaged in a variety of activities to learn more about their faith. On Monday, 6th grade students gathered in church for a blessing of Bibles and were each presented a Bible by Father Matthew. They will use the Bibles in their scripture studies for the next three years. Throughout the week, our 7th graders began an in-depth study of Jesus and viewed portions of the film *Jesus of Nazareth*. This year they will continue their study of the life and mission of Jesus and learn how his life affects their lives as Christians. In 8th grade, students researched saints using a variety of materials to help them choose a patron saint for their Confirmation name. They took a field trip to Marytown in Libertyville which is the National Shrine of St. Maximilian Kolbe. At the shrine, students explored the Kolbe Holocaust Exhibit, visited the Rosary Meditation Garden, and viewed relics of saints in the Adoration Chapel. Father Mike came to talk to the 8th graders about the different saints they researched for their name for Confirmation. He spoke with the students about the lives of the saints and how they are models for each of us.

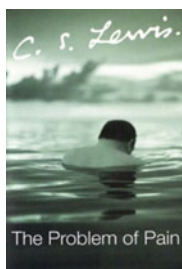
