Pastor's Notes



PRAYERS FOR OUR NEW PRIEST

On Saturday, May 18, Francis Cardinal George will ordain ten new priests for the Archdiocese of Chicago, including Brendan Guilfoil. Please keep Father Guilfoil, who Cardinal George has assigned to St. Mary, in your prayers. Please pray also for all of the ordination class and their families. Father Guilfoil will begin offering Mass here on the last weekend of June.

FINANCIAL UPDATE

As we move toward the conclusion of the fiscal year, I am most grateful for the donations we receive that support our ministries, including our school and religious education program. In addition to the weekly collections, the gifts of stock that we receive throughout the year, plus your strong support at Christmas and Easter, help us fulfill the mission Christ entrusted to the Church. Thank you.

Permit me to share some news about the parish debt. As you may know, we still owe \$249,120 for the construction of the Learning Center which was opened six years ago. Thank you to all who contributed \$37,756 in capital donations in the past fiscal year toward reducing our debt. I am pleased to share with you that after consultation with the Parish Finance Council, we have sufficient cash on reserve to pay off our remaining debt of \$211,364. So, at the end of this month, we will pay off the remainder of the debt. I believe this will be the first time since 1997 that St. Mary's will be free of debt.

Thank you to all who so generously helped us pay down the parish debt. I thank you for your support and am always most willing to answer any question about our parish finances. Deo gratias!

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

Once again there will be a procession with the Most Blessed Sacrament on Sunday, June 2, at the conclusion of the noon Mass. The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ is a fitting day for public prayer honoring the presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Children who made their First Holy Communion are invited to be part of the procession.

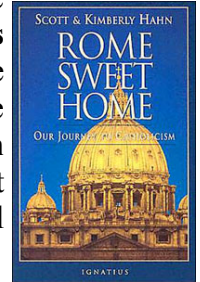


Feed My Starving Children Service Event
