FOR THE PEOPLE

Dr. J. B. Rosa, chief physicist of the Bureau of Standards of the Treasury Department, has compiled a statistical analysis of the 1920 expenditures of the United States Government as given in the regular supply bills and three deficiency bills. Dr. Rosa's analysis classifies the items in the totals in the following groups:
1. Expenditures arising from recent wars, including interest on public debts, pensions, cost of soldiers and sailors, War Risk Insurance, etc., \$1,853,825,557, about 68 per cent.
2. War and Navy Departments, \$1,125,826,267, about 25 per cent.
3. Primary governmental functions, including members of Congress, President and White House Staff, courts, administration of Federal Departments, etc., \$181,087,259, about 5 per cent.
4. Public works, bridges and harbors, buildings, post roads, reclamation, etc., \$102,202,577, about 2 per cent.
5. Research, educational and development (mines, industry, fisheries, animal and plant industry, markets foreign and domestic, commerce, standards, labor, statistics, children, and women), Bureau of Public Health, education, libraries, etc., \$77,000,000, about 1 per cent.

MAPERS VS. POLITICIANS

Many American cities have decided that municipal administration requires the services of experts. Instead of electing the most popular man to direct municipal affairs, they elect a committee, empowered to hire an expert executive who is experienced in the management of such matters as transportation, sanitation, finance, etc. Such professional city managers are not politicians and are most frequently allied with other cities. There are about one hundred and eighty "city managers" in the United States today, and one of them has been advanced, step by step, from the job of directing a small city in the state of Michigan and a larger city in the state of New York, to that of managing the thriving industrial city of Springfield, Ohio, at a salary of \$100,000 a year. Other cities of importance operating under city-manager charters are the industrial cities of Akron and Dayton, Ohio; Grand Rapids, state of Michigan; and Wheeling, capital of West Virginia.

SUSPICIONS ALLAYED

Zanella Is Said To Have Tried To Bribe Poet's Soldiers to Revolt. D'Annunzio Seeks to Negotiate With Jugos-Slavia.

ROME, July 6.—The D'Annunzio military police have discovered a plot to revolt among his legionaries promoted by the followers of Zanella, the ex-leader of the autonomists and an enemy of D'Annunzio.

Town of Panderna on Sea of Marmora is Occupied by Greeks. Northern and Southern Forces Effect Junction at Omerkeh.
(By The Associated Press)
LONDON, July 6.—A dispatch to the Daily Mail says that the Turkish nationalists have occupied the town of Panderna on the Aegean coast of the Bosporus straits, opposite the allied headquarters on the European side.

According to an official dispatch from Constantinople the Greeks are within three hours possession of the town of Panderna, which is now under the guns of the allied warships. The Turkish army in the region are displaying little or no opposition, says the dispatch.

Dispatches to the Times from Smyrna reports fighting between the Italian and Greek troops near Aesolus, to the southeast of Smyrna when the Turkish nationalists penetrated the Italian lines and burned the Italian station without interference from the Italians. In view of the anxiety of the Greeks to take up positions within the Italian lines when fighting between the Greeks and Italian troops ceased, numerous casualties being reported on both sides.

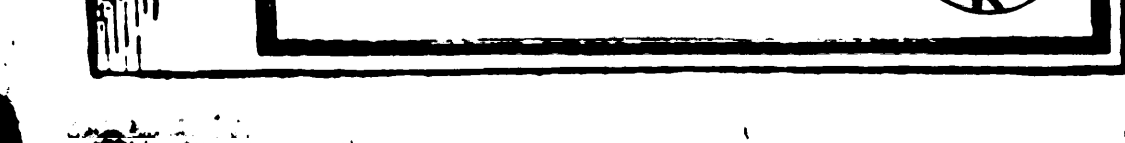
