EDITOR'S COMMENTS

This is another issue for which we have twice as much material as we have space. There are several "administrative" matters that need to be covered, and to the extent necessary we are letting them take priority.

Probably most important is the ALFORD AMERICAN FAMILY ASSOCIATION. There is a separate page and some inserts on this subject. I hope that everyone of you will take time to read it all and that you will consider them very seriously. The preservation and continuation of interest in our family name into the centuries to come may depend on your action on this matter.

I think the second most important matter to be dealt with at this time is our Virginia research project. We asked about your interest, and solicited donation pledges, in the last issue. The response was outstanding and you have indicated, without question, that you would like to participate in such a project. We have begun and are ready for you to send your donation. There is a separate article on the subject that explains what we have done, what we plan to do and how you can help. Almost half of this issue is devoted to a report to you with all the information we have on Alfords of southeastern Virginia for the period 1620 to 1750. As you will see, you can participate by contributing funds to the research effort; and by doing some research yourself, or reporting on research that you have already done. Inserted in the newsletter is a blank form titled "BOOK - PERIODICAL RESEARCH REPORT" which is for use in this effort.

We are printing the first installment of the genealogy of JOHN ALFORD who died 1748 in Virginia and who probably married Mary DAWSON. We have completed the entire line with the the information on hand. It will probably be a year or more before we are able to print the balance of the genealogy. Those who would like to purchase a complete indexed and bound copy may do so for \$9.00 or you may purchase just copies of the remaining 15 pages for \$2.50. Those who want genealogies of Jacob Alford, part of which was published in the last issue may order them. Enclosed is an order slip for use in ordering any of these genealogies.

We tried once before but did not succeed and are now trying again to simplify and reduce costs of processing your orders and renewals. Effective January 1 we are using a new invoicing system which is more automated than the previous system. In an effort to cut mailing costs we are holding most invoices, or receipts, to mail when we next write or send a newsletter.

We completed and mailed the 1986 Alford Directory in January. Shortly after mailing it we learned that our printing shop printed and/or collated some of them improperly. If yours is not correct, and it will be obvious as the family lines and alphbetical list of ancestors are mixed together, please let us know so we can send a corrected copy. If you did not order a copy we can have one printed for you as we print these corrections. The price is \$15,00 and an order slip has been provided for your use.

ALFORD EXCHANGE

18-236 Mr. and Mrs. Irvin P. Alford, P. O. Box 328, Holts Summit, MO 65043 after visiting Clarence Alford a local Alf (subscriber), wrote that they had traced their line back to a LESLIE ALFORD born in England who came to this country as a baby in 1856-57 and died of pneumonia 1886 in the Lake Champlain area. Although we have asked for more information on descendants we have not received a response. We were not able to find anything on Leslie Alford. If any of you can help, please let us know.

18-237 Dr. M. E. Alford, 37 Early Drive, Portsmouth, VA sent information on his family indicating a need for help. Dr. Alford (Marion E.) was the son of WILLIAM D. ALFORD who was born January 10 1893 in Columbus County, North Carolina. William married Jessie MCHARGUE and he died in 1973. He was the son of WILLIAM FRANKLIN ALFORD who was born May 1 1863 in Columbus County, NC, married Isadora SKIPPER and died June 3 1931 at Ft. Pierce (St. Lucie Co.) Florida. We have not been able to pick this family up in any of the census data we have. We do note that William C. Harllee's KINFOLKS, page 2061 mentions a WILLIAM FRANK ALFORD born June 20 1887 in Selkirk (could not find) South Carolina and died June 12 1930 in Tampa Florida. Considering that Columbus County adjoins Robeson County where most of "KINFOLKS" Alfords originated and both adjoin South Carolina, and considering the other dates and places these two seem very close, but slightly different in every respect. Does anyone have any information on Dr. Alfords William Frank Alford? Dr. Alford sent us several pieces of Alford information, and we appreciate that very much.

18-238 Miss Clara Brown 169 Ardmore, Shreveport, LA 71105 came to our attention through the efforts of Julius M. Alford of McComb, MS. Julius had an inquiry in the *Robeson County (NC) Register* and Clara responded with "I am deeply intertested in the families of ADAIR and McTYER." She comes from the well documented family of William C. Harllee's KINFOLKS. Her paternal grandfather was John Byars BROWN who married SUSANNAH ALFORD, daughter of SION ALFORD and Clarky McTYER.

118-239 Mrs. Doris Alford Crosslen, 393 West Shore Drive, Brunswick, GA 31520 wrote in January responding to the Georgia Expansion inquiry we sent her deceased father some time earlier. Doris is the daughter of ROBERT VAUGHN ALFORD who was probably born September 25 1897 and who married Annie Inah ANDERSON. Robert V.'s father was JOHN THOMAS ALFORD and his father was JOEL ALFORD. So far we have been unable to locate anything on these families. We suspect they were not originally from Georgia. Can anyone help?

18-240 Mrs. W. H. (Camille) Crouse, 1609 Park Road, Charlotte, NC 28203 wrote: "Surley do wish some other descendants of the children of WILLIAM AND MARY ALFORD of Wilkes and, later, Stokes County, N. C. would contact you or me and we could compare data and work together on filling in the gaps."

18-241 Claire Dunlap 2105 Sherwood Lane, Shelton WA 98584 is looking for information on OLIVER ALFORD who married Lovina (probably PORTER). They were the parents of CLARISSA ALFORD, born September 8 1781 in Vermont and who married Richard GAGE. Clarissa was Claire's 2nd great grandmother. We are not sure, but we advised Claire that Oliver might have been the son of BENEDICT ALFORD and Rebecca OWEN. Does anyone know for sure?

We were saddened to learn of the passing of one of our earliest ALF's, Max H. Knox 241 W. 17th Street, Chico CA 95928. Max, who was a descendant from the Alvord division of the family had been ill with cancer for some time. His wife, Margery, is one of our more active Newkirk contacts.

We were sorrowed to receive a letter from Edna Jean (Alford) Meade in which she informed us of the passing of her husband, Charles J. MEADE, suddenly by cardiac arrest on May 14 1986. Edna Jean is a descendant of the Irish Alfords of Pennsylvania.

One of you were able to make use of data included in an obituary summarized in the last issue. Myra O. Hunt of Alabama, send us a copy of an obit published in the CAPE COD TIMES Saturday September 13 1986. EDWARD LUCAS ALFORD 84, an electrical engineer died on Thursday. He lived in Meadville, PA since 1985, but prior to that time had resided for about 10 years in Harwich. Mr. Alford was born in Perry, Missouri, graduated from the University of Missouri. He married Alice Helen Emily FREY and they had one son EDMUND R. ALFORD of New Jersey, and a daughter Barbara TORBJORNSEN.

Anne Alford Flippin (Mrs. James), daughter of Dr. C. D. Alford of Hammond, La gave birth to James Alford Flippin November 6 1986. After delivering all those grandchildren, Dr. C. D. (Bo) Alford now has one of his own to play with. His first, but I bet not his last.

ALFORD AMERICAN FAMILY ASSOCIATION

We hope that most of you will see a need for the association and support it by joining. Included with this newsletter is your copy of the "PROPOSED CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS", an application for membership (as one of the founders) and an information sheet needed from each applicant. Each Founding Member will receive a membership certificate suitable for framing and a membership card.

Only those persons who were on our mailing list as of January 1 1987 will be elegible to qualify as a founder of the association and given founding membership. We do plan to invite about 8000 other Alford families to join as charter members. After that all memberships will be just regular memberships subject to the desires of the membership. Everything, including the name is tentative. Since it is your association you will have the option to make changes in name, constitution, registration fees, dues etc. The "Membership Applicant Information Sheet" is the starting place for that. We need each of you to not only join, but to consent to hold one or more offices should you be nominated and elected. The form also asks for your input to several other bits of important start—up business.

It is my intention to keep my Alford work completely separate from the association and as it is able to take over on its own to step completely back in the organization. I do intend to eventually donate all of my material (and probably a computer system) etc to the association. You will notice that the association has a separate mailing address using a different zip code, and this can be changed to one of your addresses as the association gets operational. I am also opening a separate bank account, just for the association maintaining detailed and complete financial records and will turn this all over to a treasurer as soon as one is operational.

As you might expect the association is being started on something less than a shoe string. Membership registration fees and dues will not cover the initial expenses of organization and we sorely need donations from those who can afford to make same. To give some encouragement in this regard, I agree to match the highest donation (up to \$500) made during the year. If one of you should give \$100 I'll also give \$100. If later someone else gives \$150, then I'll add \$50 to the \$100 I originally donated. I will not match each and every donation given, but will make a donation equivalent to the largest given by any member in 1987. A donation slip is enclosed for your convenience in sending a donation.

THE SCHEDULE FOR GETTING THE ASSOCIATION OPERATIONAL IS AS FOLLOWS:

1987 Contact most Alfords of the USA inviting them to become Charter Members; solicit volunteers for office or committee's; solicit comments on the constitution; solicit recommendations for how the association (family) should be divided, and recommendations for time and place of our first national meeting.

1988 Appoint a nominating and elections committee and provide them results of solicitation for volunteers etc. Appoint an ad hoc constitution and by-laws committee and provide them with the recommendations of the membership. Appoint an ad hoc family divisions committee and furnish them the recommendations of the membership along with information on the membership, their locations and ancestral lines. Conduct an election by mail for officers required to be elected. Officers and committee members to assume office and serve until the next annual election.

VIRGINIA RESEARCH PROJECT

Your response to the idea of hiring a professional genealogist to help us learn more about our early Virginia ancestors was overwhelming. We are proceeding with the project and are handling it in the name of the Alford American Family Association. You should go ahead and send your contribution for the research and you may make your check payable to "ALFORD AMERICAN FAMILY ASSOCIATION" or AAFA; or you may make it payable to Gilbert K. Alford, Jr. and I will transfer the funds to the association.

Several of you expressed some concern that we not get ripped off. We are going to proceed very carefully and with your help. We have received a list of all the genealogists who are certified by the National Genealogical Society to do research in Virginia. We have written to all those living in Virginia who might be interested and told them of our project to see if they desire to be considered. We explained to them that we plan to provide them two documents in an effort to make their work more productive and to keep costs down. One document will be a report of all we know, or think we know, about our Alford ancestors of the area from the time of their arrival about 1624 til 1750. This report is printed in this edition of the newsletter and we need your corrections or additions before sending it to the researcher/s.

The other document deals with the literally thousands of "Virginia Sources" sitting on shelves in libraries, that any genealogist may be inclined to go to as part of their research. This can be very time consuming, expensive, and not very productive as Alfords are not mentioned in about 90% of the publications. We plan to provide the researcher/s with a computer printout of all the printed sources that we have checked looking for Alfords, including those we checked and found no Alford. We have printed on the facing page one sample page of the type listing we intend to furnish. Mary and I are trying to check every Virginia publication in our local libraries and we need your help checking references in your home, local library or genealogical society. included and you may reproduce them or tell us how many you need and we will mail more, provided you plan to complete them and send to us. Since we are asking our Chapman and Newkirk contacts to join us in this effort, we thought you might agree to help us look for Chapmans and Newkirks and the form has been designed accordingly. (If you find information on them, as you are bound to do for Chapmans, it is not necessary that you extract the data; but we would appreciate the page numbers.) I believe the form is self explanatory and needs no instructions. The form asks for more information than is included on the enclosed printout which was printed just as a sample for your benefit. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT WE COLLECT REPORTS ON THOSE REFERENCES THAT DO NOT CONTAIN ALFORDS. WHY PAY A RESEARCHER TO DISCOVER IT?

Our original plan was to limit the research to the period from 1620 to 1750 and to the southeastern counties of Virginia. If you would prefer something else express your desires on the reverse side of the donation slip that is enclosed.

I will make the selection of researcher/s based on recommendations received from a committee of several of you after you have reviewed responses from the researchers who say they are interested in undertaking our work.

118-242 Maj. Billy C. Hall, P. O. Box 404, Agoura, CA 91301 is a descendant of SUSANNAH ALFORD HOBBS who was the daughter of LODWICK ALFORD. Major Hall joins the rest of us in our search for more on early Virginia ancestors. He is considering the father of JAMES ALFORD to be JOHN ALFORD and he sees a good possiblity that John was the son of Lt. Col. WILLIAM ALFORD, but like us, he needs some proof. Billy sent us several items of Alford information for which we are most grateful.

18-243 Dr. James E. Phipps, 2008 Wiltshire Boulevard, Huntington, WV 25701 is seeking information on his second great grand mother ELIZABETH ALFORD who was born 1799, probably in what is today West Virginia, and maybe in the area of Greenbrier County. She married Joseph MEADOWS. Her father was GEORGE ALFORD who married Mary BURNSIDE February 14 1793 in Greenbrier County (West) Virginia. Notice the George Alford who is number 28 (see page 24) in the genealogy published in this issue. The circumstances are such that these could be the same. Does anyone have any information on either of the Georges?

In the April 1985 issue (#11) page 5 we published some feedback from Ambassador Weston Adams regarding information on a PHILLIP ALFORD who was cast with Gregory Peck in the movie TO KILL A MOCKINGBIRD. We did not hear anymore on the subject until we received a letter from Col Truman Alford last fall when he sent a copy of an entertainment feature from the CHATTANOOGA NEWS-FREE PRESS (August 10 1986) which was titled "The Life and Times of Phillip Alford." Actually Truman's daughter Martha Alford Marks who lives in the Chicago area saw the article and sent it to them. Using our list of Alford addresses we wrote to the only Phillip Alford in our list with a Birmingham, Alabama address (The article mentioned they talked to him in his office in Birmingham), explaining our program and the interest of several of you in him. Regret to say the Phillip to whom we addressed our letter did not respond. If you should care to try, the address we used was 720 Shades Crest Road, Birmingham, AL 35226.

1989 Hold the first annual meeting, or if this is not possible, hold the second annual election by mail. Membership will review and vote on constitution and by-laws. If possible register the constitution with the appropriate Secretary of State. If a full scale family meeting cannot be scheduled then attempt a meeting of the Board of Trustees and the Executive Committee

VIRGINIA ALFORDS A chronology from 1620's to 1750

The following is a chronological listing of Alford events taking place in Virginia in the 17th century and up through 1750. We need your help in correcting and adding to this account.

Information in each article is written as near a direct quote as possible. Name emphasis and titles were added by the compiler. When a "+" appears in the title additional Alford names are mentioned in the article. Special effort was made to provide maximum source information or references. Comments of the compiler are in italics. In most instances we did not have the opportunity to view the original secondary source (publication). Each entry has been numbered, as a reference, for your convenience

RICHARD ALFORD - 1624-26

- 1. The earliest Alford record found is in John Camden Hotten's <u>The original Lists of Persons of Quality</u>, (Baltimore, Genealogical Publishing Co., 1978) p. 232. —The Muster of Capt. Roger Smith's men over ye Watter," in 1624, "RICHARD ALFORD aged 26 yeres."
- 2. The published Minutes of the Council and General Court of Colonial Virginia mention as a witness, "RICHARD ALFORDE," at "A Courte held the 25th of Aperill 1625" and "RYCHARD ALLFORDE" at "A Courte held the xixth of december 1625." At "A Courte held at James Cittie the XXIth of Awgust 1626," "Whereas RICHARDE ALLFORD was warned by the p(ro)vost marshall on Saturday the 19th of Awgust to appeare before the Gouernor and Councell this p(re)sent Courte day to answere to such matters as Robert Marshall should be alleged against him, with the said Allforde hath not donne, yt is ordered he shall pay for the Contempt 20 li of Tobacco." He got into worse difficulties later on. At "A Courte at James Citty the 21st of January 1627," "Richard Alford Committed prisoner at the suit of Mr. Gill for 500 (weight of) Tobacco." William Curry Harilee, KINFOLKS, A GENBALOGICAL AND BIOGRAPHICAL RECORD, etc (New Orleans, LA, Searcy & Pfaff, Ltd, 1934-37), p. 1443 [NGS Call CS71.H2853 1934-37]

RICHARD ALFORD - November 11 1626

3. On November 11, 1626, the Council of General Court, James City, Virginia, authorized Captain Smith – with a crew – and Captain Mathews – with a crew – including RICHARD ALFORD, to go trading with the Indians into any part of the Bay of Chesapeake, and indicated that the Governor should give them a Commission for this purpose. Hugh Edwin Alford, IN SEARCH OF MY ALFORD ANCESTORS (1972ca), p. 8. [Submitted by Pat Brock Smith]

WILLIAM ALFORD - 1653-1662

4. WILLIAM ALFORD witnessed signatures on documents in Charles City County in 1653. He also witnessed signatures in this county, twice in 1661, and once in 1662. Hugh Bdwin Alford, IN SEARCH OF MY ALFORD ANCESTORS (1972ca), p. 9. [Submitted by Pat Brock Smith]

JOHN ALFORD & WILLIAM ALFORD - 1654-1663

5. The record of the First Settlers in the Colonies of North America names 1,000 "Servants and Apprentices" who sailed from Bristol, England to Virginia, Maryland and other points on the Atlantic Coast between 1654 and 1685. JOHN ALFORD & WILLIAM ALFORD were included in the 1,000 emigrants, date, place of birth and marital status unknown. They sailed between 1654 and 1663; William's destination – Virginia, but John's was not known. Hugh Bdwin Alford, IN SEARCH OF MY ALFORD ANCESTORS (1972ca), p. 9-10. [Submitted by Pat Brock Smith]

ANTHONY ALFORD - March 4 1656

6. Patent Book 4, page 85 (124) shows Miles Dixon, Gentleman received 500 acres in Northumberland Co. on March 4 1656 for transporting 10 persons including ANTHONY ALFORD. (1) Nell Marion Nugent, CAVALIERS AND PIONEERS, ABSTRACTS OF VIRGINIA LAND PATENTS AND GRANTS, 1623-66, Vol I, (Richmond, 1934) (Reprinted Baltimore, MD, Genealogical Publishing Company, 1963) p. 343-4. In view of the absence of any evidence to support the land grant to William Alford, the compiler leans back to the John Alford theory as expressed by Boddie. See # 86 below for a report with a conflicting date of 1785 and without mention of "James."

1/ The only proven information on John Alford and his family comes from his 1748 will in which his children were listed. The will was written Movember 13 1748 and probated January 4 1748 (old calendar). There are at least three schools of thought concerning his parents. One is that he may have been the son of a John and Elizabeth Alford who are reported to have immigrated to Maryland in 1665, and that he was probably born about 1676 in Maryland. Another holds to the idea that he was born in England in 1718 or before and was brought to America by a Joist Hite. (See ABOUT ALFORDS Issue 45, Oct 83, p. 3 for more on this theory) Either of these seems plausible, but the majority seem to lean towards the Maryland birth. A third comes from the mistaken impression that nearly three fourths of the Alfords in America come from Benedict Alford, one of the two brothers who migrated to Boston about 1634. We expect to eventually prove that most of the Alfords in America came from immigrants to the middle Atlantic states. Some folks apparently feel there is some connection between this branch and the New England families. This latter possibility seems least likely to the editor.

There is no proof that Mary Dawson is the wife or the mother in the family below. There is a record of a marriage between John Alford and Mary Dawson in Dorchester County, Maryland in 1717. Time and place fits and family tradition seems to accept her as the spouse in this case.

PLEASE NOTE:

We have emphasized that information is not proven in this first entry as we wanted to insure that our data was not misrepresented concerning the progenitor of this line. The many family researchers who have contributed to this compilation probably have proof on much of the information that follows, however, your editor has very little proving evidence.
