GENERAL EARLY DEAD. Killed by a Mine Victim. Desperate Attempt to Escape from State Prison. Shot a Keeper in the Effort.

Lynchburg, Va., March 3.—United States Senator John W. Daniel is said to have been in the city last night in a visit to the late General Early, who died at 10:35. He passed away quietly, in the presence of his family and physician, his mind and faculties clear to the end.

General Early's Career. The pug pug plays in making or marriage. His fortune is illustrated in General Early's career. More than once during the Civil War he was captured and turned the scale as important crimes in favor of his people, yet he emerged from the conflict with a reputation which enabled him to live the last thirty years of his life.

Early was a Virginian. He was born in Front Royal, Va., in 1824. He served with the regulars in Mexico and with the regulars in the Mexican war. He was captured at the battle of Bull Run, and was taken to the rear. He was wounded, and did not resume his command until the battle of Cedar Mountain, Sept. 9, 1862. He fought at the battles of Bull Run and Antietam, and had the good fortune to command the Union advance at Fredericksburg in May, 1863.

At Gettysburg he commanded a division in Ewell's corps and led the same troops in the battle of the Wagon Road, and the battle of Cold Harbor. After that battle he was sent to Lynchburg to oppose General Robert E. Lee's advance on the city. He was captured at the battle of Petersburg, and was taken to the rear. He was wounded, and did not resume his command until the battle of Cedar Mountain, Sept. 9, 1862.
