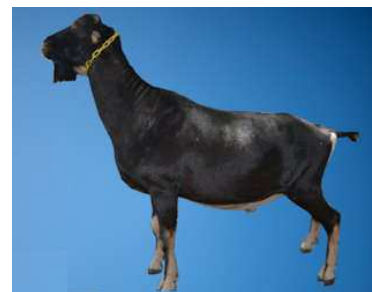

Recipe Corner

Green Goddess, Pistachio and Goat Cheese Ball

4 oz cream cheese, room temp 2 Tbsp fresh chives
4 oz goat cheese, room temp Kosher salt
2 tbsp. unsalted butter, room temp
4 anchovy fillets 3/4 cu. Pistachios, toasted, chopped
1 cup watercress leaves Crackers, for serving
1/4 cup mixed tender herb leaves such as mint, parsley, tarragon or



Process cream cheese, goat cheese and butter in a food processor until smooth. Pulse in anchovies, watercress, herbs and chives; season with salt. Scrape mixture into a small plastic wrap-lined bowl; gather plastic around cheese, using your hands to shape into a ball. Chill until firm, 3-12 hours.

Just before serving, unwrap cheese ball and roll in pistachios. Serve with crackers. Serves 8.

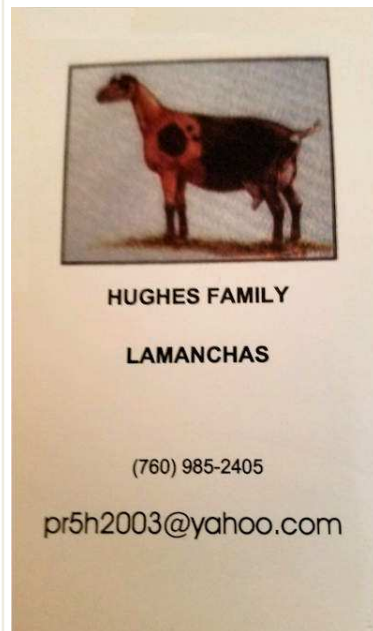

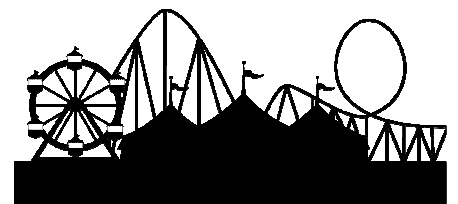
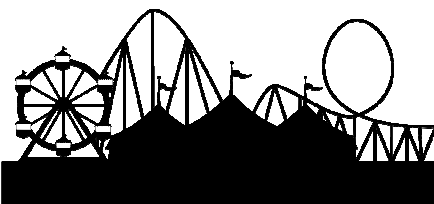
Hannah Shilts, RPS Acres, Orfordville, WI

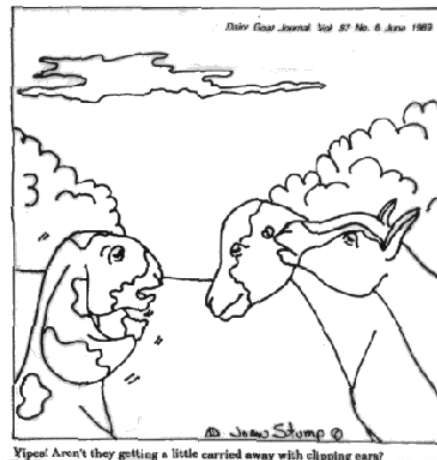

ALBA Specialty Rules

1. The AMERICAN LAMANCHA BREEDERS ASSOCIATION authorizes one LaMancha Specialty show per year per ADGA district for a total of 8 shows per year. If there are no applicants from a district by the deadline, the number of shows awarded may be reduced or a second specialty may be awarded in a district. All applications must be postmarked by **December 31** of the current year to be considered.
2. The show must be an ADGA Sanctioned show and open to all members. If your show restricts by location you will not be awarded a specialty.
3. In order to receive a refund, show results (**3 placings per class as well as champions**) and **pictures of all first place winners as well as all champions, reserves and best of breeds as well as best udder and outstanding youth winner and showmanship winners** must be sent to the Specialty Chairman within **30 days of the show**. Photos MUST be sent in ELECTRONIC format only (CD, DVD, email)
4. **NEW** In accordance with our 2019 goal of promoting youth, our club requires that a younger and older outstanding youth and 2 showmanship winners are recognized at each specialty show. You do not have to hold special showmanship classes but must recognize both a younger and older youth showman. If you do not feel you can fulfill these requirements, please don't apply for a specialty. Preference will be given to shows that recognize youth participation and have returned their results at previous shows in a timely manner.
5. The ALBA will furnish awards for all GCH and RGCH winners and Best of Breed in does and bucks. We will also furnish a Best Udder medal and an outstanding youth award as well as showmanship awards. Certificates for winners will be furnished if requested on your application.
6. If your show has split dates, (does on one date, bucks at a later time/location) it will be considered 2 separate shows. Please include both a regular deposit and a buck show deposit (\$150). If applying for a buck show only specialty, the deposit is \$50. Deposit for a regular show is \$100 with a refund of \$ 50 if all requirements are met. Refund for a single buck show is \$ 20 and for a split show is \$70.
7. Please include the name of your contracted judge prior to submitting your application. We will not award a specialty without that information.
8. Applications are accepted from October 1 to December 31. Any application received prior to October 1 will be credited as arriving on October 1. No applications will be considered if postmarked after January 1.
9. These rules and application can be changed at any time at the discretion of the ALBA President, Board of Directors and Specialty Chair.
