

## Gay Men's Chorus, Women's

 Chorus head for Tampa, Fla. Over 5,000 singers set for GALA FestivalBy Susan Jordan The Rochester Gay Men's Chorus and members of Rochester Women's Community Chorus will take part in the world's largest gay and lesbian choral festival this month. The GALA Festival will be heid July $6-13$ in Tampa, Fla. As the latest issue of "Keynotes." the RGMC newsletter, remarks, " 35 groggy members of RGMC will gather at the airport. For a $6: 25$ (a.m.) fight To Florida. For a week. In july.
It takes real dedication to face Fiorida's summer humidity, but the RGMC has been a prominent member of GALA Choruses (Gay and Lesbian Association of Choruses) since is 1986 event in Minneapolis; when RGMC made history by having all members learn to sign their version of "Kumbaya" in ASL, an incident recorded in GALA's official history (and the only mention of a specific chorus in that history.)
The Festival will include a keynote address by author Maya Angelou, with Harvey Fierstein as opening ceremonies m.c.; and appearances by Holly Near, Romanovsky and Phillips, cabaret singer Ann Hampton Callaway, rock trio BETTY, and over 110 choruses and small vocal groups from gay communities all over the country, as well as Europe and Australia.
More than a dozen new choral works will be premiered by approximately 5,000 singers. Estimates of the potential audience run to 30,000 people. "lt's huge," said Jim Clark of the Tampa-Hillsborough Convention and Visitors' Center. "It's one of the biggest meetings we've ever had in Tampa." The event is ex-
pected to generate 10 to 20 million dollars in business for the local community.
Kennech Cole, executive director of GALA Choruses, said, "GALA officials initially considered other locations when Tampa voters in 1992 repealed the city's amendment to its human rights ordinance banning discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation. They decided to remain in Tampa, though, when the city put the law back on the books in October 1993, after the cours determined that 462 signatures that forced
the vote were invalid" the vote were invalid."
Gays and lesbians who attend the Festival will be able to consutt "The Florida Boycott Handbook" which lists local businesses which respect equality and have policies banning anti-gay discrimination, as a guide on where to best spend their money.
Thirty-six concerts will be held in the Tampa Bay Performing Arts Center, and related events will rake place at other sites. including the Busch Gardens theme park, which has been rented for the night of fuly 11 for a concert including gay comics Robin Tyler and John McGivern, and the a cappella group The Flirtations. An all-women concert featuring Ysaye Barnwell of Sweet Honey in the Rock will take place on July 12 . RGMC director Nick Williams said that he is looking forward to a rare musical treat. "What excites me most is the level of musicianship I'm going to hear. All the choruses are amateur, but some of them are among the most-recorded choirs in the U.S. this decade.

Elisha House appeals for volunteers, funds Elisha House is a terminal care home for patients suffering from AIDS. and it is in great need of volunteers. Priority is given to AIDS patients because only two terminal care homes locally accept AIDS patients. The other homes discriminate and do not accept AIDS patiencs," say Elisha House spokespersons. "Ironically, these ocher homes are very well financed, and staffed with a pool of hundreds of volunteers. In the last five years we served 70 patients in their journey toward peace, and 50 of those patients had AIDS. We are in desperate need of volunteers and donations to con tinue to samemeramanmary" Elisha House serves a population
that has litde in financial resources. that has litde in financial resources The project is depleting its resources much faster than it is abie wo secure grant funds. "We do not charge patients for their stay, nor is there any reimbursement from insurances
Elisha House has room for says. patients at any one time. Each papatients at any one time. Each pa-
tienthas their own private bedroom and there are sitting rooms and a kitchen available to family and friends. The house is staffed 24 hours, seven days a week. Currently the organization relies on an aide agency to fill the evening hours due to a lack of volunteers. Each shift is four hours. The day and weekend hours are the most needed hours. Elisha House has training available for interested volunteers.
"Our mission is to provide com fort care to make the patient's last days as joyful and comfortable as possibte.
