North Carolina Hit By Polio Outbreak

Raleigh, N. C., July 6.—(AP)—The third worst outbreak of infantile paralysis in North Carolina, which showed no signs of abating today.

Through yesterday, the state health department reported 160 cases, the highest number since 1935. Sixteen new cases were reported during the day to the state board of health.

Dr. C. P. Ravich, of the Board of Health reported the polio outbreak still is concentrated in the central portion of the state. The disease already has been classified as epidemic in several central counties.

Officials of the National Association for Infantile Paralysis noted that the current outbreak is the worst in the state's history for this time of year. Outbreaks in 1934, which counted 678 cases, and 1935, with 673 cases, were generally later in the summer.

The announcement said Hurtado had been placed in command of all armed forces, the police and the Republican guard.

Anyone on the streets after midnight must carry a safe conduct pass issued by the Army, the announcement said. Only essential vehicles were allowed on the streets.

The military has been given complete authority over the country.


Close Supervision Given All Roads

The Reputation of Truman

General Dwight D. Eisenhower has had to speak again, and again it may have been in the nick of time. Last winter, when he issued his first statement of refusal to run for office, he was on the verge of sweeping the country as a Republican presidential possibility. He was apparently going to get the Republican nomination by acclamation if he did not refuse it in advance.

For the past few days, however, he was bringing some new development of a similar trend in the Democratic party. Leader after leader was repudiating President Truman and endorsing General Eisenhower. This was going on in spite of the fact that General Eisenhower was already on the record as not choosing to run. And if it had been allowed to go on for a few hours more, Eisenhower would have had the Democratic nomination, whether he wanted it or not.

So, once again General Eisenhower issued a statement. This time, it included the statement that "I will not at this time identify myself with any political party and could not accept nomination for any public office or participate in partisan political contest."

Nothing short of such a statement would completely discourage the Democrats who are still seeking to draft Eisenhower. That is so because they really do not care very much about Eisenhower or what he thinks or wants, they are primarily interested in one thing—the repudiation of Mr. Truman. And the second run of the Eisenhower boom has already been strong enough to constitute such a repudiation of Mr. Truman as most repudiation because they really know that there was anything else really in prospect.

That repudiation is the one thing that both the Southern conservatives and the Northern liberals within the party have agreed upon. Because they really know little or nothing of how General Eisenhower really stands on the issues dividing themselves, because they think he represents, purely through his personal prestige, their one and only chance of winning in 1948, they are also willing to agree on Eisenhower. But that is especially true of their agreement; and if they can't get Eisenhower, they are still likely to fall back upon the man they have known as "Dwain" for years with him to the extent which is guaranteed by their own advance repudiation of him.
