What We Really Fear
The fourth anniversary of the dropping of the first atomic bomb has passed quietly. Those of the surviving remnants of Hiroshima addressed a petition to President Truman urging him to promote a world government before other cities should suffer their fate. But the main object seemed to be among those who received the bomb, not among those who delivered it. If we should think about it, what would the bomb signify to us, four years later?

One thing, we think, is becoming clearer with time. It was suggested from the first, but was not mixed with elemental reactions to the physical properties of the bomb itself. Then we marvelled at what the bomb could do, how widely its destruction could travel, how many people it could kill, what after-effects it left. And then, for a long time, our fear was of the terrible properties of the bomb, and the fear that we ourselves might some day have to suffer them.

Will He Too Honor Facts?
President Truman, in asking the present assembly had one complaint: the facts that had at that time become public. He has apparently determined, once more, to break his way through the maze of the world's opinion, to counteract it and shatter it before it is too late.

The lesson of the atomic bomb, the thing that really strikes fear into the hearts of thinking men, is the fact that civilization has so developed itself as to consider the planning, production and use of this weapon, and therefore of any other means of destruction, plausible, forgivable, and routine.
