

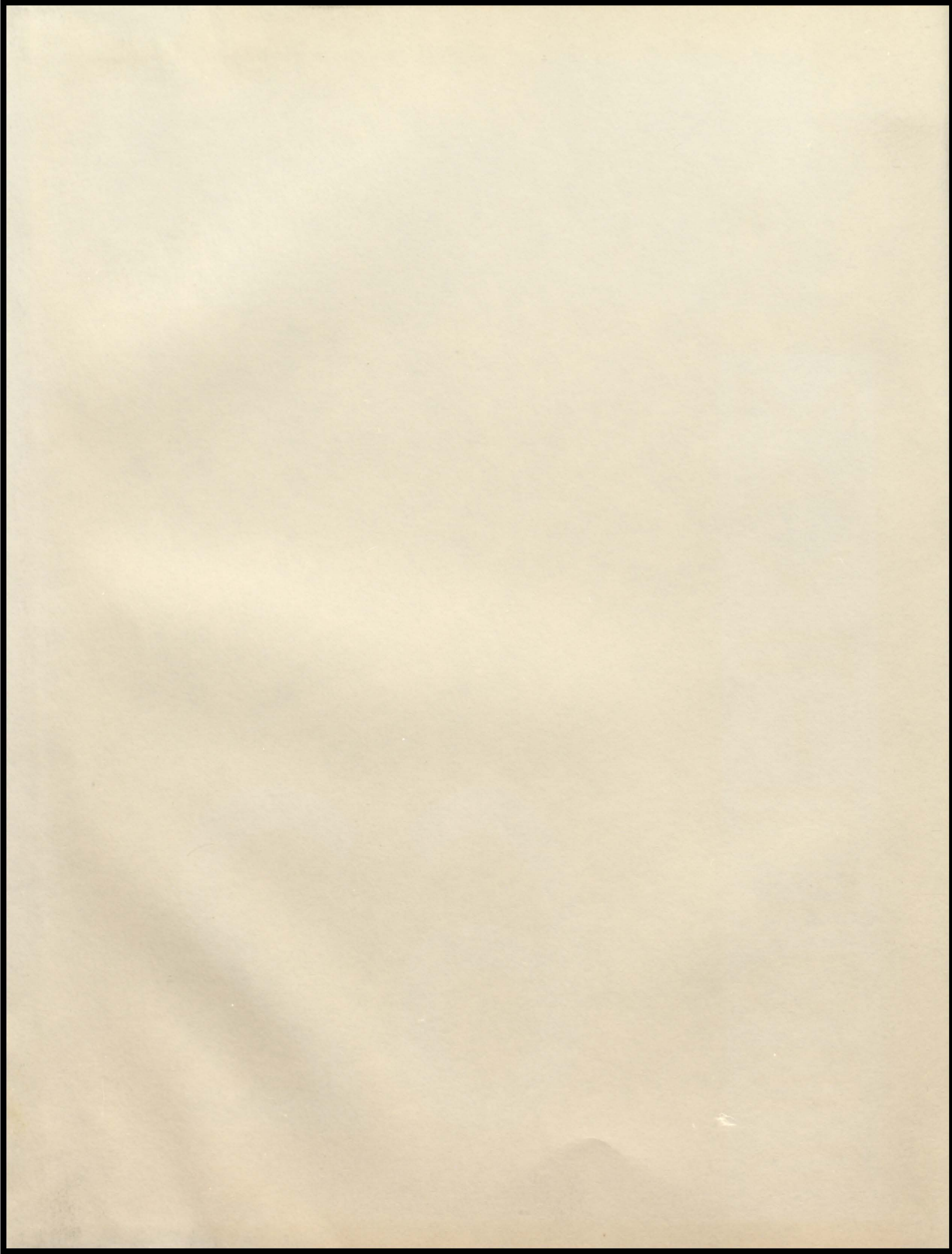

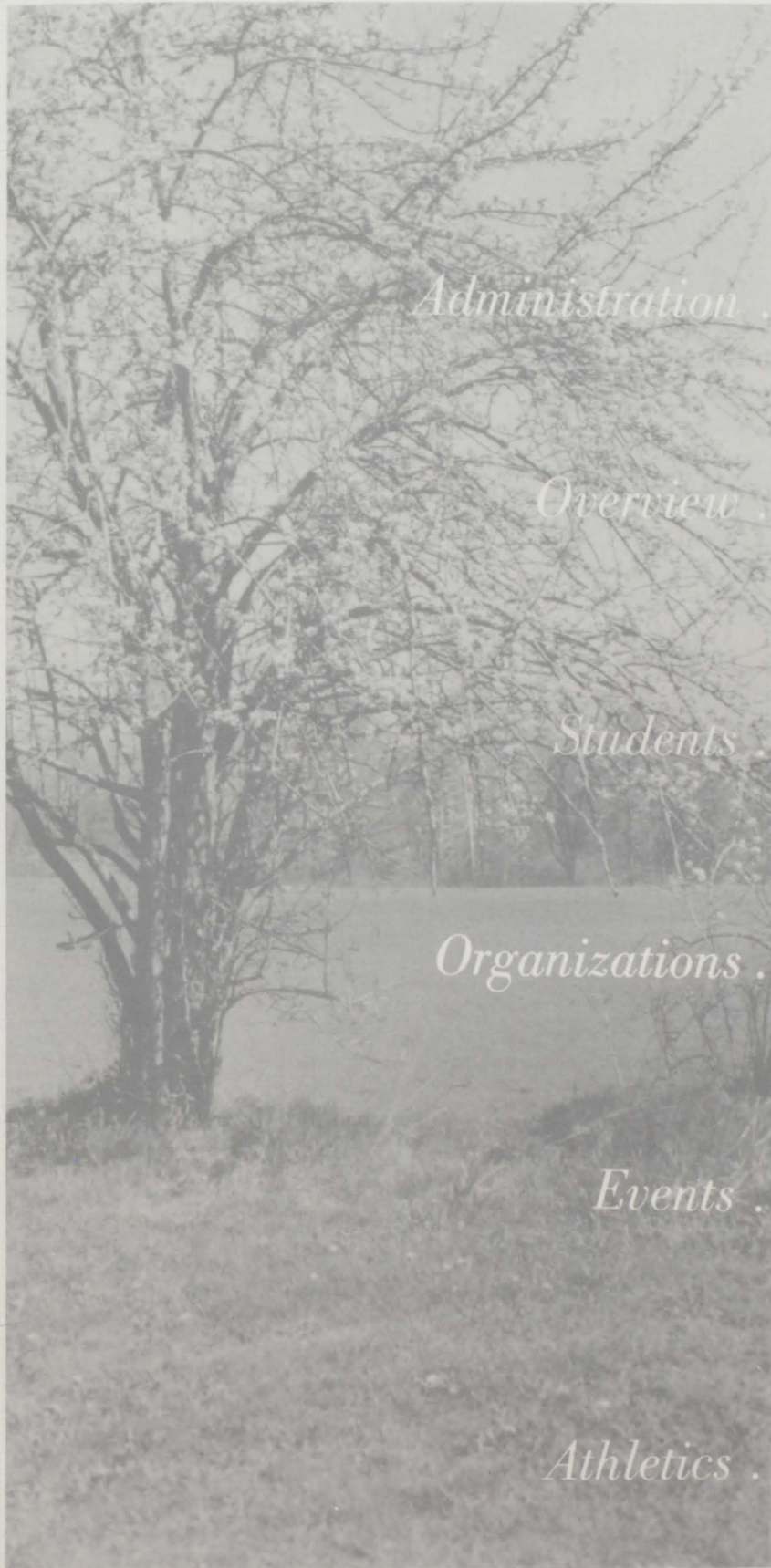

tired —

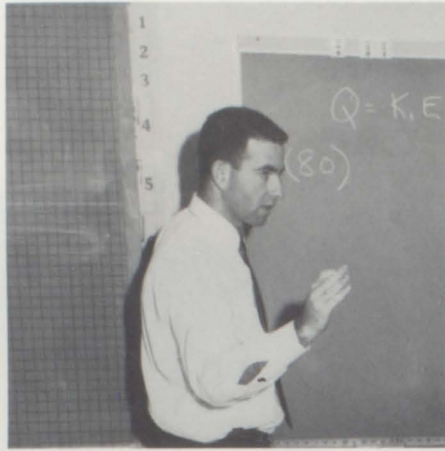
angry.

or anxiety.

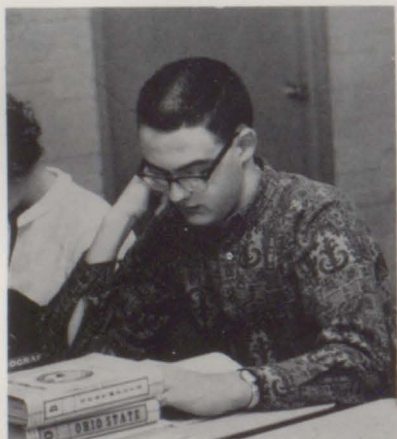
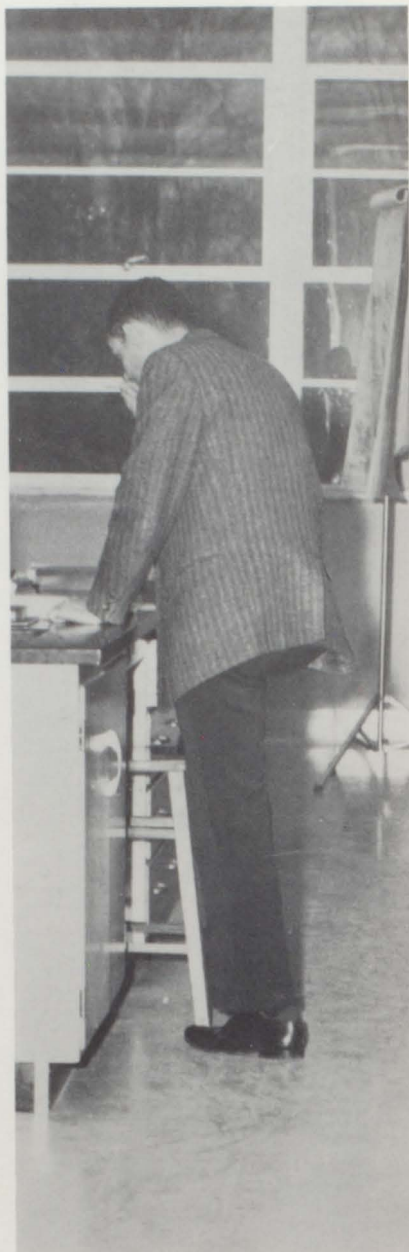


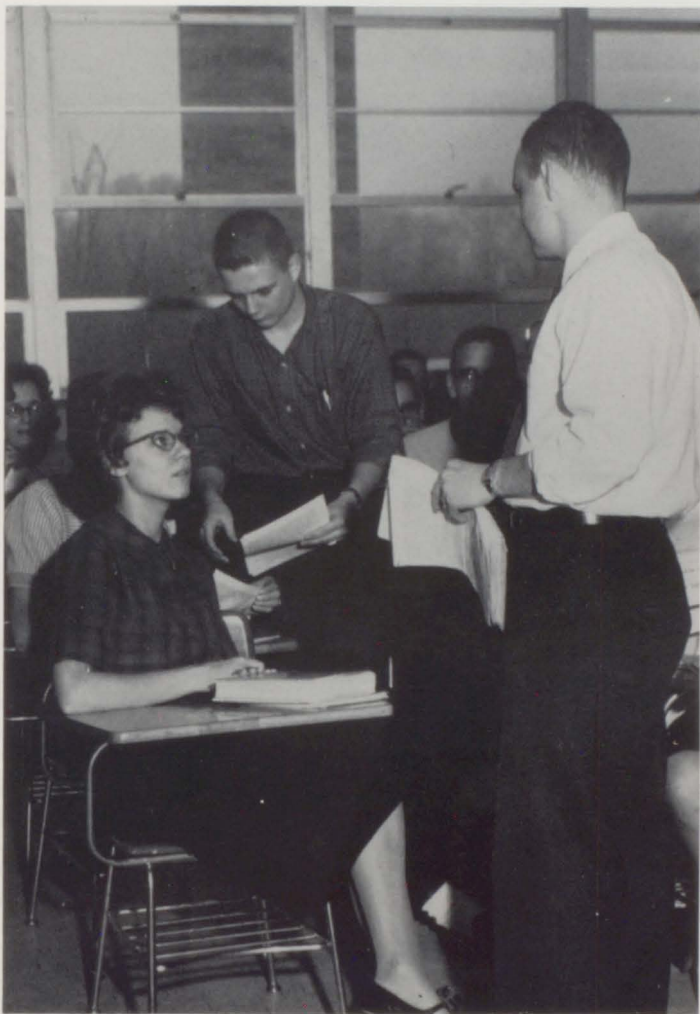

unkind.



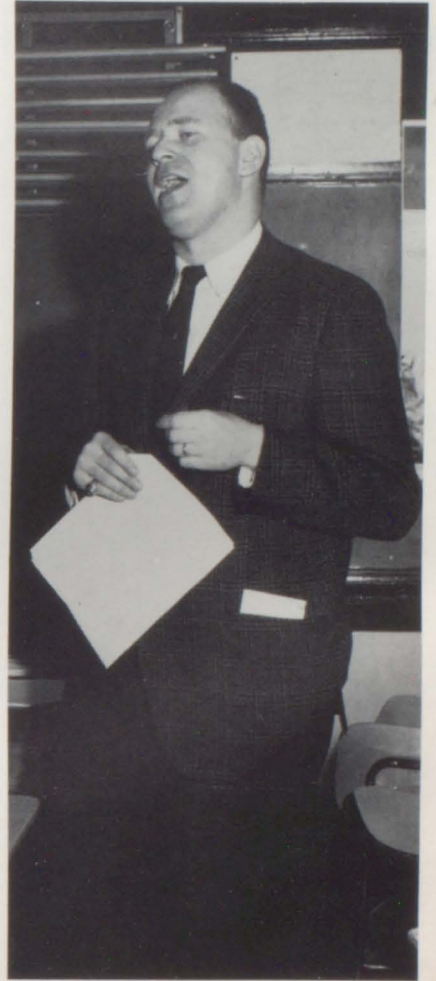


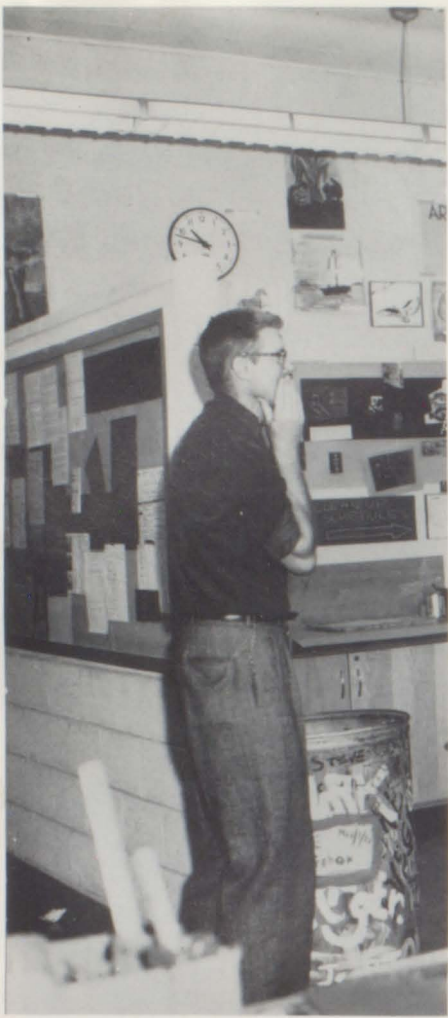
