(b) the products set out in the schedule hereto shall be the pioneer products of the industry.

## MHNERALS ACT (CAP. 121)

Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Declaration, 1962
Comintencement : 26th Aprit 1962
In exercise of the powers conferined by section 8 oft the Minetat's Act, the Minister of Mines and Power of the Federation has made the following decla-ration-

1. This declaration may be cited as the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Amendment (No. 3) Declaration, 1962, and shall apply throughout the Federation.
2. Paragraph 6 of the Prospecting (Areas and Minerals) Prohibition Declaration (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Declaration") is revoked.
3. Paragraph 30 of the principal Declaration is revoked and the following paragraph is substituted therefor-
"30. The following area is hereby declared to be closed to prospecting for all minerals :-

All that parcel of land known as Shen-Zawan-Du Village Area situated in Jos Division of Plateau Province, consisting of approximately 11,533 Acres, the boundary of which is delineated by a red verge line on plan MISC. 123 and is more particularly described as follows:-

Starting at Survey Trig Point YK. 2477 the Colony Co-ordinates of which are 2,080,659 feet North, and 2,355,884 feet East, the boundary runs from :-

YK. 2477 on a bearing of $265^{\circ} 41^{\prime}$ for a distance of 2665.4 feet to Z. 5 and from Z. 5 on a bearing of $265^{\circ} 30^{\prime}$ for a distance of 9746.0 feetito YK.2478,
from YK. 2478 on a bearing of $276^{\circ} 16^{\prime}$ for a distance of $11,929.0$ feet to Z.6, from Z. 6 on a bearing of $241^{\circ} 03^{\prime}$ for a distance of 2270.7 feet to $\mathrm{Z}$. situated on the eastern side of the Bukuru-Ropp motor road, thence northwards along the eastern side of the Bukuru-Ropp motor road for approximately 20,500 feet to Beacon Z.1, when it runs on a bearing of $94^{\circ} 11^{\prime}$ for a distance of 788.0 feet to Z.1A,
from Z.1A it runs on a bearing of $93^{\circ} 47^{\prime}$ for a distance of $4,144.0$ feet to Z.2,
from Z. 2 it runs on a bearing of $93^{\circ} 50^{\prime}$ for a distance of $13,438.2$ feet to. N.10,
from N. 10 it runs on a bearing of $89^{\circ} 50^{\prime}$ for a distance of $6,916.8$ feet to Z.3,
from Z. 3 it runs on a bearing $177^{\circ} 25^{\prime}$ for a distance of $1,939.1$ feet to Z.4,
from Z.4 it runs on a bearing of $179^{\circ} 39^{\prime}$ for a distance of $7,843.3$ feet to YK. 1454,
from YK. 1454 it runs on a bearing of $185^{\circ} 08^{\prime}$ for a distance of 8,054.1 feet.to YK. 2477 the starting point.

All corners are marked by concrete beacons, all bearings and lengthsare approximate and all bearings are referred to Colony North."
