AN IMPORTANT LAW RELATING TO CORPORATIONS IN KENTUCKY. The following act of the Kentucky Legislature, approved June 1, 1865...

SECTION 1. That every corporation in this State shall have capital stock, and the amount of such stock shall be stated in the charter of the corporation...

SECTION 2. That every corporation in this State shall have a board of directors, and the number of such directors shall be stated in the charter of the corporation...

SECTION 3. That every corporation in this State shall have a president, and the name of such president shall be stated in the charter of the corporation...

SECTION 4. That every corporation in this State shall have a secretary, and the name of such secretary shall be stated in the charter of the corporation...

SECTION 5. That every corporation in this State shall have a treasurer, and the name of such treasurer shall be stated in the charter of the corporation...
