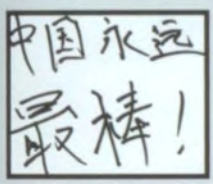


Sophie Schauer

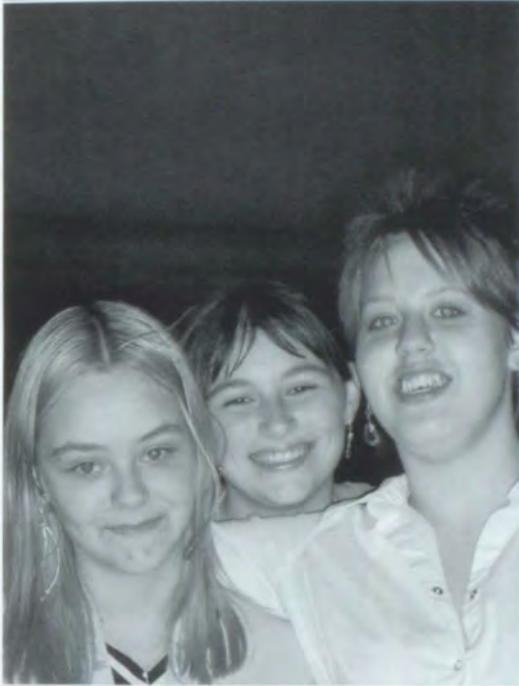

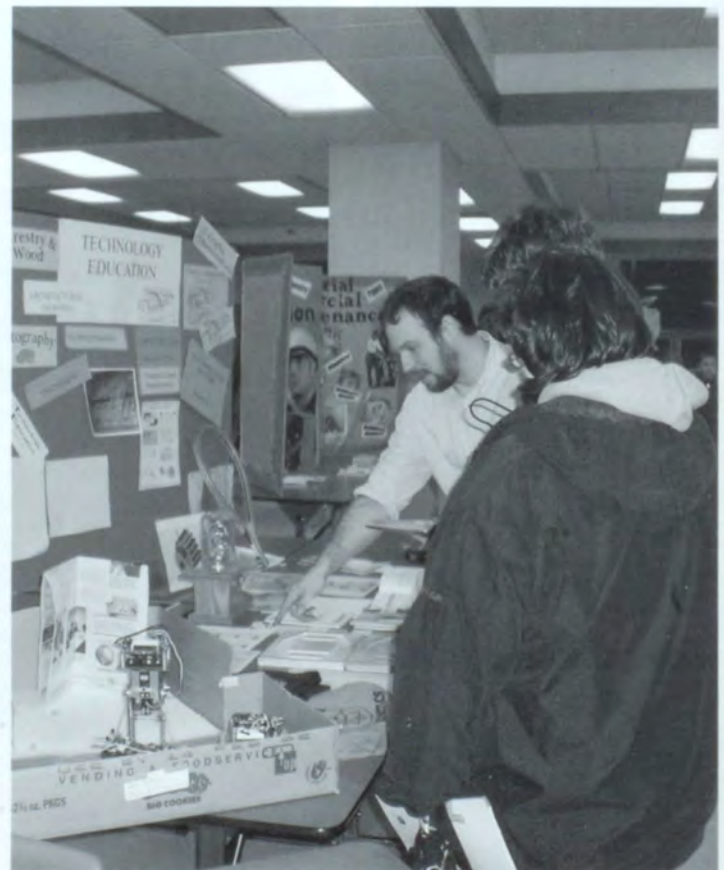
Three nights of excitement!

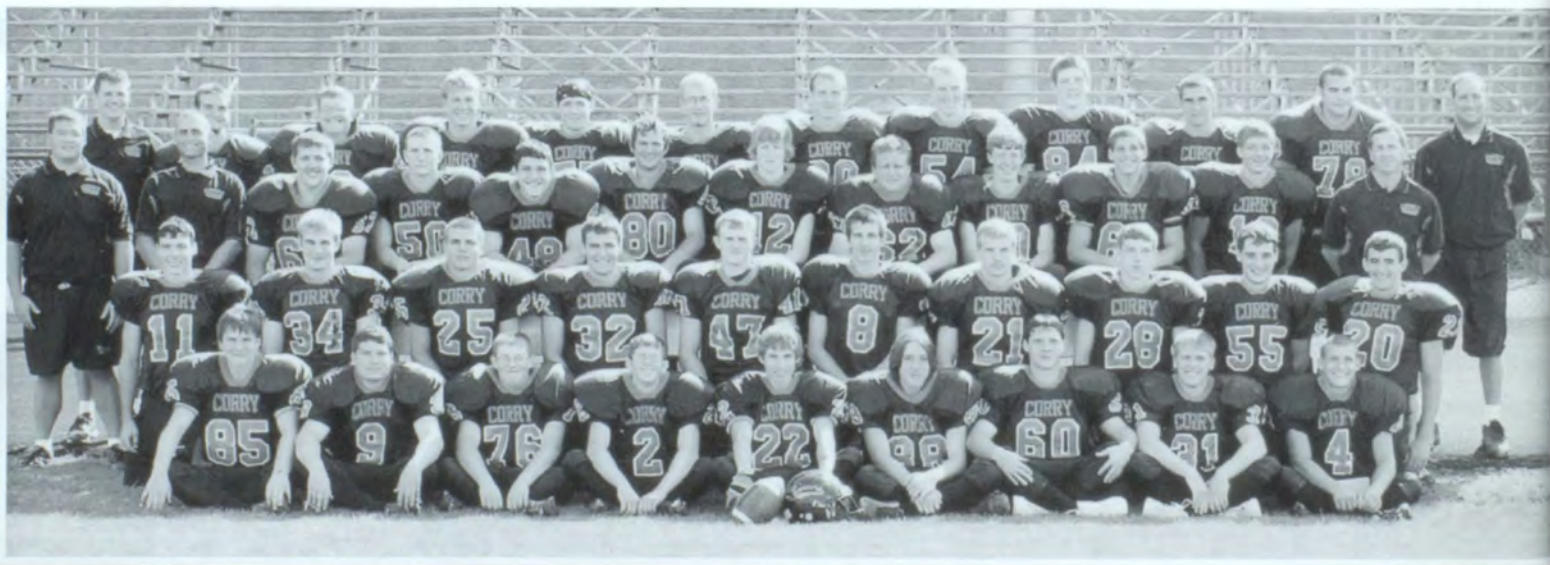

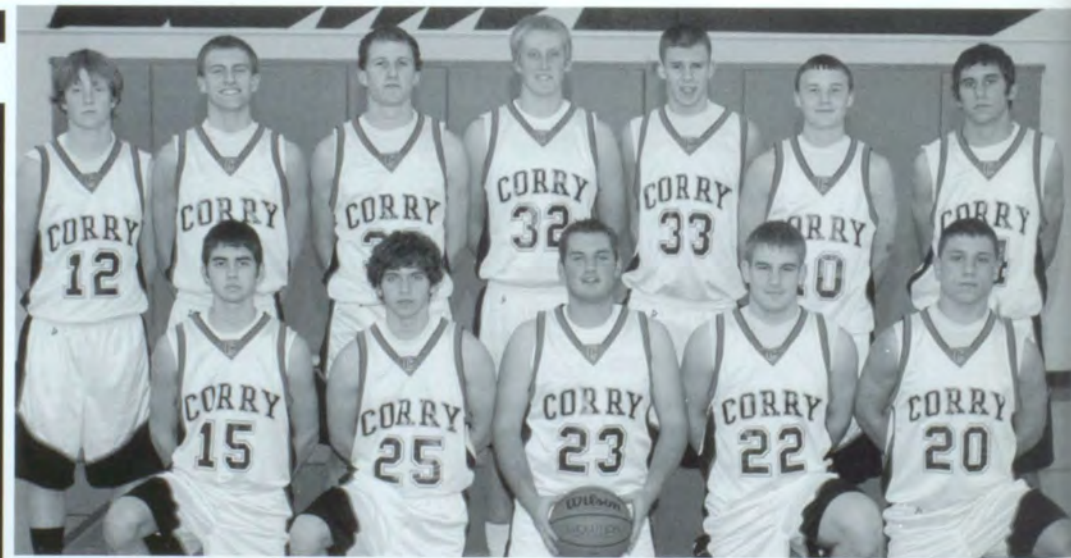
