The Energy Resources Department is requesting to make the following utility truck purchases based on a bid awarded by the National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA). The National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) is a municipal contracting government agency that serves education and government agencies nationally through competitively bid and awarded contract purchasing solutions.

The Energy Resources Department is requesting to purchase the following two utility trucks from NJPA contract #031014-ALT-Public Utility Equipment with Related Accessories and Supplies:

- 1. One (1) Altec Model DT65, 65' Digger Derrick, and
- 2. One (1) Altec Model AN67-E100-AWD Non-Overcenter Aerial Device with Elevator (Insulated)

ATTACHMENT C is the "Regular Meeting & Retreat Minutes of the National Joint Powers Alliance" for the Board of Directors held on Wednesday & Thursday, April 9 & 10, 2014 approving award on RFP #031014 for Public Utility Equipment with Related Accessories, Supplies and Services to multiple vendors. This contract includes the Altec Model DT65, 65' Digger Derrick and the Altec Model AN67-E100-AWD Non-Overcenter Aerial Device with Elevator (Insulated) that the Energy Resources Department is requesting to purchase.

ATTACHMENT D-1 is the "Contract Acceptance and Award Agreement" between Altec Industries, Incorporated and NJPA showing that the contract starts on April 10, 2014 and continues for four (4) years through April 10, 2018.

ATTACHMENT D-2 the "Letter of Agreement to Extend the Contract" shows that the agreement between Altec Industries, Incorporated and NJPA has been extended for one additional year through April 10, 2019.

ATTACHMENT E-1 is a copy of the price quote submitted by Altec Industries, Incorporated for the Altec Model DT65, 65' Digger Derrick at a base cost of \$298,698.00. "NJPA options" for the truck are provided at a cost of \$19,137.00 and "Open Market Items requested by the City" are provided at a cost of \$11,283.00. The total cost of the Altec Model DT65 is \$329,574.00, which includes the "NJPA option" cost, the "Open Market Items requested by the City" cost and a delivery cost of \$456.00.

ATTACHMENT E-2 is a copy of the price quote submitted by Altec Industries, Incorporated for the Altec Model AN67-E100-AWD, Non-Overcenter Aerial Device with Elevator (Insulated) at a base cost of \$341,635.00. "NJPA options on Contract (Unit)" for All Wheel Drive is provided at a cost of \$20,665.00 and "NJPA options on contract (General)" is provided at a cost of \$18,140.00. The "Open Market Items requested by the customer" is provided at a cost of \$3,508.00 and delivery of the truck at a cost of \$2,400.00. The total cost of the Altec Model AN67-E100 is \$386,348.00, which includes the "NJPA options on contract (Unit)", the "NJPA options on contract (General)", the "Open Market Items requested by the customer" and delivery.

Based on the request from the Energy Resources Department, the above information and the attachments, it is our recommendation to make bid awards to Altec Industries, Incorporated per NJPA contract #031014-ALT as follow:

- 1. Purchase of one (1) Altec Model DT65, 65' Digger Derrick at a total cost of \$329,574.00.
- 2. Purchase of one (1) Altec Model AN67-E100, Non-Overcenter Aerial Device with Elevator (Insulated) at a total cost of \$386,348.00.

The total cost of the bid award to Altec Industries, Incorporated for both trucks is \$715,922.00.

The purchase will be paid for out of fund account number(s) 60090609-554200 - (HEAVY MOTORIZED EQUIPMENT), which has a balance of \$697,650.00 and 60090602-435300-(REPAIRS-VEHICLE), which has a balance of \$65,604.07.
