





#### **Quinceañera Policy**

Quinceañeras need to be scheduled within six months in advance. In order to schedule a Mass the quinceañera must have already received their First Holy Communion before the celebration and be registered in the Confirmation program or already be confirmed. If the sacraments have not been received, we would celebrate the Liturgy of the Word. First Communion or Confirmation preparation will NOT be rushed to accommodate the quinceañera Mass.

When we're scheduling a quinceañera Mass, wedding takes precedence over quinceañera masses. Christian simplicity needs to be observed; dresses must be modest and flowers will be limited to a bouquet to present to the statue of the Virgin of Guadalupe.

Instructions of the theology, meaning and importance of the quinceañera celebration must be completed before the ceremony by the girl, and the parents are strongly encouraged to be part of the preparation process. Rehearsals will be held the Friday before the scheduled Mass. The family needs to be confessed before the celebration. Failure to complete this preparation will cancel the ceremony and refunds will not be granted. Family must arrive on time, at least 30 minutes before Mass begins. Thank you.

#### Política de Quinceañera

Las quinceañeras deben programarse con seis meses de anticipación. Para programar una Misa la quinceañera ya debe haber recibido su Primera Comunión antes de la celebración y estar registrada en el programa de Confirmación o estar ya confirmada. Si no se hubieran recibido los sacramentos, celebraríamos la Liturgia de la Palabra.

La preparación para la Primera Comunión o Confirmación NO será apresurada para acomodar la Misa de la Quinceañera. Cuando estamos programando una misa de quinceañera, la boda tiene prioridad sobre las misas de quinceañera. Es necesario observar la sencillez cristiana; Los vestidos deben ser modestos y las flores se limitarán a un ramo para regalar a la estatua de la Virgen de Guadalupe.

Las instrucciones de la teología, el significado y la importancia de la celebración de la quinceañera deben ser completadas antes de la ceremonia por la niña, y los padres se les recomienda encarecidamente que sean parte del proceso de preparación. Los ensayos se llevarán a cabo el viernes antes de la misa programada. La familia debe confesarse antes de la celebración. No completar esta preparación cancelará la ceremonia y no se otorgarán reembolsos. La familia debe llegar a tiempo, al menos 30 minutos antes que empieza la misa. Gracias.
