Become an Explorer

It can be tricky making a highlights package out of a region already crammed full of top adventures and experiences. But we've done it and you're welcome. Please enjoy your list of Wollongong MUST DO's...

Royal National Park & Illawarra Escarpment Trails

Your adventure starts here – and by here, we mean **The Royal National Park**. It's over 100 years old (the 2nd oldest national park in the world, in fact) and boasts over 100km of walking tracks – with the jewel in its leafy crown being the 26km Coast Track. It's here, and in the hiking trails that continue south along our 30-million-year-old **Illawarra escarpment**, that you'll get your fix of jawdropping clifftop views, cool rainforest valleys and much more!

Symbio Wildlife Park

With an eclectic mix of Australia's favourite native animals as well as rare and endangered exotics, **Symbio Wildlife Park** offers one of the most diverse line ups of any zoo or wildlife park in NSW. Come and meet your new best friends up close, including koalas, kangaroos, echidnas, wombats and dingoes – plus an impressive collection of reptiles, red pandas, cheetahs, ring-tailed lenurs, meerlats and mankeys



Darkes Glenbernie Orchard

Winning multiple gold awards in Australia and backed up by GOLD at the World Cider Awards two years in a row a visit to **Darkes Glenbernie Orchard** is a must! This fifth-generation family farm is set on 100 acres, and you can fill your boots with fresh and dried fruits, juice, apple cider, honey and preserves (they'd prefer you use a bag though). And hey, while you're nearby, why not check out the bush walks through the Dharawal National Park.

Sea Cliff Bridge

As seen on countless car ads, now you get to star in your own commercial – cruising along the iconic and ridiculously photogenic 665-metre

Sea Cliff Bridge. For a slower pace, the shared walking path offers magnificent views over the South Pacific Ocean and maybe even a migrating whale or two between May and November. This curvy beauty looks great from any angle – from the back of a Harley-Davidson with Just Cruisin'

Motorcycle Tours or even from up above with Touchdown Helicopters.

Skydive Australia

The next time someone tells you to go jump, that's your cue to take in the breathtaking views over Wollongong and beyond with a tandem jump from **Skydive Australia**.

This is real bucket list stuff, so mark it off right here at up to 15,000 feet and experience true exhilaration!

Flagstaff Hill

We liked our lighthouse so much that we ordered another one – and you'll see them both at Flagstaff Hill and Wollongong Harbour. Enjoy lunch in one of the many cafés or restaurants along the Blue Mile as you also eat up those sweeping ocean views... delicious!

Explore by cycle

From an easy coastal ride to rugged mountainous terrain, you'll find a path to suit your expertise or itinerary. Our seaside "spine" runs from Sandon Point to City Beach and on to Lake Illawarra – mostly flat and super scenic. And if you need some wheels or simply want some expert guidance, ring your bell for **Cycle Tours NSW.**



Wollongong Botanic Garden

A visit to **Wollongong Botanic Garden** will bring you face-to-leaf with a range of exotic and indigenous native plants – woven throughout this wonderful network of paths filled with hidden treasures. There's always something happening in the not-so-secret

Garden, including garden tours, community workshops, plays, live music, a wellness trail, an all-abilities playground and maze, plus outdoor cinema screenings through summer. And if you find yourself one sandwich short of a picnic, the onsite coffee van does tasty treats daily from 9 till 2.



Nan Tien Temple

Offering you enlightenment, peace and serenity, Nan Tien Temple is the largest Buddhist Temple in the Southern Hemisphere Its name translates as "southern paradise" – and it will be easy to see why, as you explore picturesque gardens and intricate architecture. Be sure to drop in to the Dew Drop Inn – a relaxing, earthy teahouse that offers a blissful range of teas and light vegetarian meals.

Historical Aircraft Restoration Museum

Put your seatbelts on, fold your tray tables away and head to the Shellharbour Airport site of HARS (Historical Aircraft Restoration Society) museum – a treasure trove of Australian aviation history. There's nothing plain about this place, which includes the **Boeing 747 Wing Walk** – a unique opportunity to stroll out along the right wing of an iconic QANTAS jumbo jet, which was delivered to the museum in March 2015.

Nature's best on show

Nestled between the mountains and the sea, Wollongong is a unique destination for enjoying the great outdoors. Whether you're exploring the coast or the escarpment, spectacular lofty lookouts or sea-level rock pools, pristine gardens or rugged bushland, the perfect adventure is always within easy reach...

If sand and surf are what you love, you've come to the right place. With Wollongong's world-class surf breaks, stunning views and soft, soft sand, you can't go wrong.

There are a whopping 17 patrolled beaches in Wollongong, plus a stack of other coastal areas to suit all your splashy needs. Here's a quick round up of our top picks.

CITY CENTRE

You can't get more central than **Belmore Basin** – a fantastic family-friendly area
that's great for paddling toddlers and laidback gatherings. It's here, between the two
lighthouses, that you'll find plenty of tables
and picnic facilities, restaurants, cafes and a
playground all within close proximity.

Nearby, the city's two main beaches, **North Beach** (patrolled year round) and **City Beach** (patrolled between the September and April school holidays) are a short stroll to the north and south respectively – as is the Continental Pools and rock pools.

NORTH

Check out **Stanwell Park**, cradled by a large reserve and ideal for family picnics thanks to its BBQ facilities, kiosk and playground.


Meanwhile, **Austinmer** is one of the region's most popular beaches, drawing happy splashers to its shores and two large rock pools. Just up the coast, you can pitch a tent beachside at **Coledale** while **Thirroul** and **Bulli** are home to plenty of facilities.

SOUTH

You simply must get to **Killalea Beach** (or The Farm as it is known locally) – a National Surfing Reserve and one of the most popular surfing beaches on the South Coast. North of here, **Windang Beach** is located at the entrance to **Lake Illawarra** which is popular for water sports like kayaking, skiing, stand up paddle boarding and fishing.

We can safely say that we have a beach to suit everyone. And speaking of safe, remember to swim between the red and yellow flags and ask a lifeguard if you have any questions.





THE ROYAL NATIONAL PARK

The world's second-oldest national park is perched right on our northern doorstep – how good is that? The Royal National Park features a multitude of landscapes from open grassland to dramatic cliffs and secluded beaches that are definitely worth the walk. In Dharawal National Park take the Maddens Falls walk to the lookout for a view of the waterfall dropping from Maddens Creek to the pools below. The short and easy walking track is a great one for walking with children. It's also ideal for birdwatchers so don't forget your binoculars.

As you'd expect, the scenery is sublime, and everyone is catered for – from accessible short strolls through to a two-day excursion for the super keen. The annual MS Gong bike ride also takes in part of the park, emerging at **Bald Hill** for a mesmerising first view of the Illawarra coastline.

Fast facts

THE ILLAWARRA ESCARPMENT

You can't miss it – forming our region's entire western boundary and rising vertically several hundreds of metres above sea level. The Illawarra Escarpment State

Conservation Area is a treasure trove for walkers and a bountiful home to many bird species, sub-tropical rainforest, eucalypts, cedars and more.

Excellent tracks include the ultimate "short cut" in **Sublime Point Track** (a 1km steep descent to Austinmer with ladders near the summit), the more sedate 5km **Maddens Track**, the undulating 6km **Forest Walk**, **Brokers Nose**, **Wodi Wodi Track** and the **Mt Keira Ring Track**.

Trail conditions

GRAND PACIFIC WALK

The Grand Pacific Drive (GPD) through the Wollongong region is one of the most scenic drives in the world. But why should vehicles have all the fun, right? Recently, work has started on the **Grand Pacific Walk** – a 60km pathway running parallel to the GPD route and linking Royal National Park with Wollongong CBD, and on to Lake Illawarra.

Stage one of this project (from Stanwell Park to Coalcliff) is already complete, following our magnificent coastline over the famous Sea Cliff Bridge and on through picturesque towns, headlands and natural reserves. Prefer two wheels? No problem – it's also suitable for cyclists.

DHARAWAL NATIONAL PARK

Walking and bike tracks, waterfalls and rock pools; **Dharawal National Park** has it all! Check out the **O'Hares Creek Lookout** (2.8km return) for an easy adventure or the **Jingga Walking Track** (2.4km return) for something a little more challenging.

As you explore these beautiful areas please be mindful that sacred sites, significant biodiversity and ecosystems that hold great value to the Dharawal people stretch throughout the national parks and escarpment.







Lookouts

Getting your bearings is easy when you know where to look. And looking has never looked better at these signature spots, perfect for seeing far and wide...

BALD HILL

This spectacular northern lookout is a must-stop viewing point for the Illawarra. Sitting high above Stanwell Park, **Bald Hill** offers super impressive views south as far as Wollongong and the absurdly photogenic **Sea Cliff Bridge.**

When the winds are right, you can enjoy the colour and grace of hang gliders taking off and soaring through the air. In fact, it was on the beach below that Australia's pioneer of flight Lawrence Hargrave made one of the world's first successful flights way back in 1894.



SOUTHERN GATEWAY CENTRE LOOKOUT, BULLI TOPS

The Southern Gateway Centre is perfectly perched on the Illawarra Escarpment at Bulli Tops with magnificent views over the Wollongong coastline. The Centre marks the main gateway to Wollongong & the South Coast – you definitely won't want to miss the unique and stunning 180 degree ocean and escarpment views from the viewing platform. Drop into the Visitor Information Centre for some expert local knowledge, enjoy a meal at the adjoining restaurant/cafe Altitude 1148 or a freshly made Gelato at the Gelato Emporium.



MOUNT KEIRA SUMMIT PARK

This is another site that takes full advantage of the escarpment's altitude, home to a bunch of great walking tracks plus **Mount Keira Lookout** – with its stunning views across the entire Wollongong region.

HILL 60 LOOKOUT, PORT KEMBLA

Sitting prominently at one end of Wollongong's main port suburb, **Hill 60 lookout** is a local favourite – offering spectacular views up and down the coastline including Port Kembla beach. The shores around here are rich in history – fished commercially by local indigenous fishermen up until the 1940s and still loaded with shell middens and artefacts. Hill 60 was also a strategic site during World War II, with a series of fortifications located beneath the lookout that once housed large guns to protect the vital industrial port nearby.





A Delicious Destination

Exploring this region sure does build up an appetite. Thankfully, Wollongong's food and entertainment scene steps up to the plate (pun definitely intended) and knocks it out of the park all year round. In fact, it's been quietly growing into quite the place, matching the industry's best with unique venues in which to sip, savour and celebrate with friends!

FOOD & ENTERTAINMENT

Wollongong is a city that refuses to sit still – and nowhere is this reflected more than in our dining and entertainment scene. In recent years, an influx of eclectic small bars and eateries, along with the arrival of new flavours, new clubs, intimate venues, quirky fun and more, has changed the landscape for the better.

Within the city and along the coast, you're guaranteed to find something to suit any palate – from sophisticated wine and whiskey bars to award-winning restaurants, creative cuisines and relaxed pub grub. Add in the fact that most of these tasty delights are within easy reach of our stunning beaches, parks and cycleways and you'll start realising why this truly is the lifestyle capital of the universe.

Worldwide, the foodie scene continues to diversify and grow – and Wollongong's exciting blend of nationalities and creative energy puts it right at the front of this wave (we like waves). You may not have time to explore them all but hey, you'll have fun trying!

THE SMALL BAR SCENE

Okay, so a rabbi, a bank manager and a surfer all walk into a bar. No, it's not a joke – it's a reflection of the wide appeal that Wollongong's exciting small bar scene has. These are the secret-handshake, knock-threetimes, local knowledge gems that make you

feel instantly welcome – and rival some of Melbourne's best graffiti-covered, laneway-lurking secret spots. Where you can enjoy a quiet drink over a shared plate or kick back with a tight group of friends to catch up on old times

Maybe you like a specific tipple. Or perhaps you're thirsting to indulge in a range of boutique beers and local wines. Either way, we have the venues to suit. Here are just a few to get you started:

Resin Brewing Microbrewery is where you go if you are looking for a contemporary family-friendly brewpub with natural hand-crafted beers worthy of frothing over.

Only a stone's throw from the beach,

Towradgi Beach Hotel is the go-to spot in

Wollongong for great food, cold beers, live
music, and sporting events on a big screen.

If it's a relaxing sea breeze and uninterrupted
ocean views you are after then the laid back
vibe at Pepe's on the Beach is where you need
to be seen sipping delicious cocktails and
listening to the sound of the waves crashing.
Perfect!

And if you like to drink and think, try **Breakout Bar and Escape Rooms** – mixing a touch of
adventure into their menu by offering a game
of puzzle solving and strategy to go with their
cocktails, wine and beer list.







A taste of the region

Considering our thin slice of geography so close to the ocean, delicious seafood will always be a staple on the menu here in Wollongong. But this region has plenty more fresh bounty to offer – with many restaurants proudly sharing their love of sustainable practices, local and organic produce or sourcing premium produce from respected Australian organisations. Here are just a few, to whet your appetite:

Restaurant Santino is quietly nestled in a corner of Globe Lane, Wollongong. This Italian bistro transports you into a bygone era while serving up classic Italian favourites with a truist

Just 150 metres from Thirroul Beach, **South Sailor** offers casual fresh seafood meals; a fitting spot to settle back after a day on the sand.

If it's a view you are after you can't go
past The Imperial at Clifton, Steamers Bar
and Grill, Palisade Kitchen & Bar and the
Harbourfront Seafood Restaurant

The Imperial at Clifton is an iconic venue steeped in history which started way back in the 1900s with a sizeable mining community looking for a drinking hole... from there an iconic venue was born, known for its clifftop location and dynamic history. Sitting idle for almost 20 years, the venue was reinvented and is now a bespoke all-day dining venue.

Located in the Novotel Wollongong
Northbeach, the **Palisade Kitchen & Bar**, provides a dining experience that
encapsulates Wollongong's lifestyle, offering
panoramic views of the Pacific Ocean and the
freshest Australian produce.

Meanwhile, beachside **Steamers Bar and Grill** mixes modern surrounds with colonial history – where the wood-smoked organic OBE beef is dry-aged, the produce home-grown and the wines organic. If its 'on the beach' style food, you are after take your pick at North Wollongong Beach – **Diggies** or **North Beach Kiosk** or further along the Blue Mile **Levendi Fish and Chippery** nestled in the iconic harbour.

For over 30 years the **Harbourfront Seafood Restaurant** has been positioned overlooking

the iconic Belmore Basin offering their diners the finest food and wine in a stunning location. For something a little more central, why not pair your meal with a barista coffee at **Lux Bistro Bar**.

The Swallowed Anchor in the Crown Street Mall with its leafy green balcony offers the perfect spot to settle down with a cocktail in hand on a sunny afternoon with a tapas share plate or two.

And world-class mountain bike trails are on the horizon, literally, with a network due for launch on the Illawarra Escarpment in 2023.

MOUNTAIN BIKE PARKS

Cringila Hills Community Park – Let the good times roll at Wollongong's newest bike park, 10 minutes south of the CBD, boasting 11km of beginner and intermediate trails. A pump track and skills track have been added, so you can hone your skills at the precinct, which includes an interactive playground.

Helensburgh Off Road Cycle Club – This community club maintains a bike park in the northern suburbs, which is surrounded by several informal trails.

CELEBRATING CYCLING

Attracting 300,000 spectators and a global TV audience of 300 million viewers, the 2022 UCI Road World Championships is Wollongong's Olympic moment.

Complementary events include the national road championships for Juniors and Masters, along with the Australian Cyclo-Cross

Championships. Each November, 10,000 riders experience our beautiful coastline in the iconic MS Gong Ride, while the Illawarra Cycle Club hosts a diverse calendar of events.

Destination Wollongong shares the love of the land in which it operates, with this nation's First People. It is our sincere hope that together we can work to communicate the beauty of the land and the ocean in our region and encourage all people to value and respect our roles in caring for and promoting to others, why they should come and see what we have to offer.

The area we know today as Wollongong originated from the Aboriginal word 'Woolyungah' meaning 'Five Islands'. The local Traditional people of Dharawal Country, were the first people to occupy these lands, waterways, and coastlines. The traditional Aboriginal people of the area still maintain a deep cultural connection to the surrounding landscapes and ocean. Their history, heritage

and stories will continue to be an integral part of our community.

It is estimated that the traditional clan groups had some 1,000 square miles of country in the area north of the Shoalhaven River and reaching to Wollongong.

WOLLONGONG ART GALLERY

Wollongong Art Gallery is one of the largest regional art museums in Australia. Their aim is to enhance the understanding and enjoyment of the visual arts for the people of the Illawarra and visitors to the region. Wollongong Art Gallery has an important and extensive collection of Aboriginal art. The Gallery is open Tues - Fri 10am - 5pm and Sat and Sun - 12noon - 4pm (closed Public Holidays). Entry is Free.

COOMADITCHIE

The Coomaditchie Artists' Co-operative comprises 4 generations of Aboriginal artists, who love to express their culture, local coastal upbringing, Dreaming stories, significant sites and themes – through art. Located adjacent to the Coomaditchy Lagoon in Port Kembla, Coomaditchie welcomes visitors to meet and engage with them and to view and purchase their authentic art works and products.



WOLLONGONG BOTANIC GARDEN

The Towri Bush Tucker Garden contains predominantly local Illawarra native plants that would have been used by Aboriginal people for food, medicine, and shelter. The Garden also provides habitat for native animals and birds.

It was named by the Traditional Custodians of the land and means 'learning place bounded by flowers and trees'.

Wollongong Botanic Garden is open from 7am daily, with many special events staged throughout the year. Entry is free.

From lookouts to blowholes, quiet bays to lush rainforests, wineries to shopping or just a great cup of coffee, the best way to get from point A to B (as well as C, D and E) is behind the wheel – exploring the Grand Pacific Drive at your own pace...

Once in the city, you'll be able to easily soak up a few hours at **Flagstaff Hill** and **Wollongong Harbour**, including a walk along the Blue Mile, swim at the beach or **Continental Pools** and lunch by the sea or in **Puckeys Estate** nature reserve.

Explore the shops of the city centre and stroke your chin thoughtfully at **Wollongong Art Gallery**, before continuing on to the peace and serenity and tea drinking at **Nan Tien Temple** – which we love reminding people is the largest Buddhist Temple in the southern hemisphere.

Freshly centred and calm, your day is complete.

THE FAMILY WEEKEND OR WEEK LONG ADVENTURE

Family road trip time and this one has something for everyone. Are we there yet? Actually YES – we ARE – because both **Hangdog Climbing Gym** and **Science Space** are right on the city's doorstep – and fun for all ages. The climbing gym delivers 140 different climbs and 40 ropes so no one's getting bored today.

Meanwhile, **Science Space** is the proud home of the DIGISTAR 6, Australia's #1 most digitally advanced Planetarium with their 4k laser projection system, a first for Australia.

Wow, all this active fun really gets the heart pounding. But if you really want to see it skyrocket, go skydiving with **Skydive Australia**. On the way down, you'll get amazing coastal views – in fact, you'll be able to see where we're heading to next. It's south along the Grand Pacific Drive to the famous **Kiama Blowhole** and on to **Treetops Adventure at Nowra** – where you can monkey about on six courses and more than 80 challenges.



Darkes Glenbernie Orchard - Enjoy and create memories at this 6th Generation Family Orchard, located amongst the pristine Northern Illawarra mountain top, and Dharawal National Park bushland. Discover stories behind growing fruit or go on your own Darkes Cider tasting adventure.

Finally, if the view from a parachute wasn't enough, you'll enjoy stunning panoramic views with your feet on the ground at the cantilevered **Illawarra Fly Treetop Adventures** before dangling and wahoooing your way through the native forest on Australia's highest zipline tour.

After all that, if somehow, inexplicably, you STILL have time up your sleeve, go and get cosy with the wide range of animals at **Symbio Wildlife Park** or ride the world-class water slides of **Jamberoo Action Park** between September and April. Boredom officially busted!



Blue Mile

History Tour

Stretching from WIN Stadium in the south, to Stuart Park and the Lagoon northward, 'The Blue Mile' – is named from the ocean it skirts.

The area was well-used by people of the Dharawal Nation – from at least 22,000 years ago. They worked the coastline, with middens still evident everywhere – showing their healthy diet of sea bounty. They fished with lines and nets spun from plant fibres and hooks from shells.

The Blue Mile tells stories about:

- Our First People's relationship to this land and ocean
- Wollongong's colonial history
- · Wartime defences from the Crimean War to WW2
- The creation of Wollongong's first harbour the predecessor to Port Kembla
- · Early coal mining and export
- Sea bathing and its development from segregated to 'continental' sea bathing
- · Salt production

The Blue Mile Walking Tour is an enlightening experience that starts at Flagstaff Hill, through Wollongong Harbour, follows the old tramway to Northbeach and returns along Cliff Road to the old Courthouse at Belmore Basin.

You can be guided by booking into a tour via **www.insideindustry.org.au** or wander yourself – taking in the various interpretive signs.



Stop 1 -New Lighthouse & Flagstaff Hill Fort

Start at Flagstaff Hill where the coloured ensigns of the 'Flag Alphabet' were hoisted to send messages to visiting ships. Under this hill is The Flagstaff Hill Fort, that was built in 1890 to address the local's fear of attack from the Russian navy.

Wollongong Harbour's second lighthouse was built in 1936 from reinforced concrete. It stands 25.3 metres and was the first new lighthouse built to be fully automatic.

Stop 2 -Ladies Pool

In the past, you would attract the wrong kind of attention for standing here! Look down past Pulpit Rock and imagine the 'ladies' apparently 'modestly' bathing in the 1830s – getting down a ladder to swim.

Stop 3 -Breakwater & Old Lighthouse

The Breakwater created the first harbour in Wollongong. It was designed by Colonial Engineer George Barney who supervised construction from 1837 to 1844. He went on to also design Circular Quay in Sydney. The breakwater lighthouse was opened in 1871, stands 12 metres tall and was designed by engineer Edward Moriarty. It was pre-fabricated and built of wrought iron with a ferro-concrete base to survive any gale-force weather.

Stop 4 The Harbour

Wollongong lighthouse is built on Flagstaff Hill near disused fortifications. Along with the Breakwater lighthouse, we have become the only point on the eastern coast of Australia which has two lighthouses.

Stop 5 -Brighton Beach

Brighton Beach (sometimes known as Brighton Lawn) is located in Belmore Basin. Here was where the original travellers to Wollongong would wade ashore from the ship's boats. Have a good look at the mural that includes much of the history of the Blue Mile.

Stop 6 -Mining Tramway

In 1848 Shoobert's Mine at Mt
Keira was the first mine opened
in the new 'southern coalfields'.
A tramway was built when the
Mount Pleasant mine opened in
1862. It was horse-powered until
1878, when steam locos took over
- through what is now Stuart Park
and following the walking path
route we now call The Blue Mile.
Some of the old tramway route is
marked on the pavement.

Stop 7 -Wollongong's First Peoples

It is possible to look at these worn old rocks and visualise how it might have been before 1816, when the Aboriginal communities lived well, for thousands and thousands of years, with the riches of the land, abundant wildlife, good rainfall and of course, the ocean. There is also remarkable evidence of them carving out pools in the rocks, creating large, shallow fish traps.

Stop 8 -The Low Salt SaltWorks

Here you can see evidence of salt channels carved into the rock – to enable sea water to enter at high tide – and then allowing the water to evaporate – leaving salt, for the early colonials.

Stop 9 -Beach Life Now & Then

Take a break for refreshments Walk to the right of the Kiosk, past the Surf Club to the street and turn left up the Hill to Cliff Drive, walking past the Novotel. Turn left at the Smiths Hill Fort and stop with a view of the three guns and the emplacement.

Stop 10 -Smith's Hill Fort

Built in 1892–93 the Smith's Hill Fort was a three-gun emplacement with a battery of two 80-pound rifled muzzle loader guns. The two larger northern emplacements contain the 2 x 80-pounder, rifled, muzzle-loader guns that had been manufactured at the Royal Gun Factory at Woolwich UK in 1872.



Stop 11 -Osborne Park

This area completes the picture of the working harbour and its connection to the mines, through the tramway. You can see here how the tramway came from the escarpment to the harbour and the gauge of the tram tracks.

Have a good look at the artefacts and artworks here, which will further explain the trades of the day and the interaction with our First Peoples and also includes some artistically preserved historical tools and building materials, including the last remaining timber bridge from the line over Smith's Creek.

Stop 12 -Courthouse

The Old Courthouse was built in 1858 and is the oldest existing public building in Wollongong. It had a lock-up and 3 cells. It replaced a canvas tent erected in 1829, a weatherboard courthouse erected in 1834 (which apparently fell down) and a red-brick courthouse erected in 1835.







Wollongong region map






GRAND PACIFIC DRIVE DISTANCE CHART
