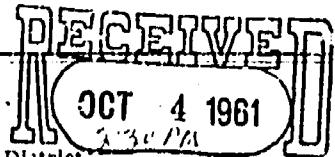

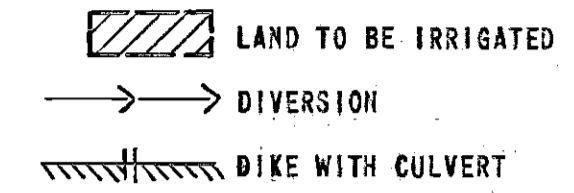

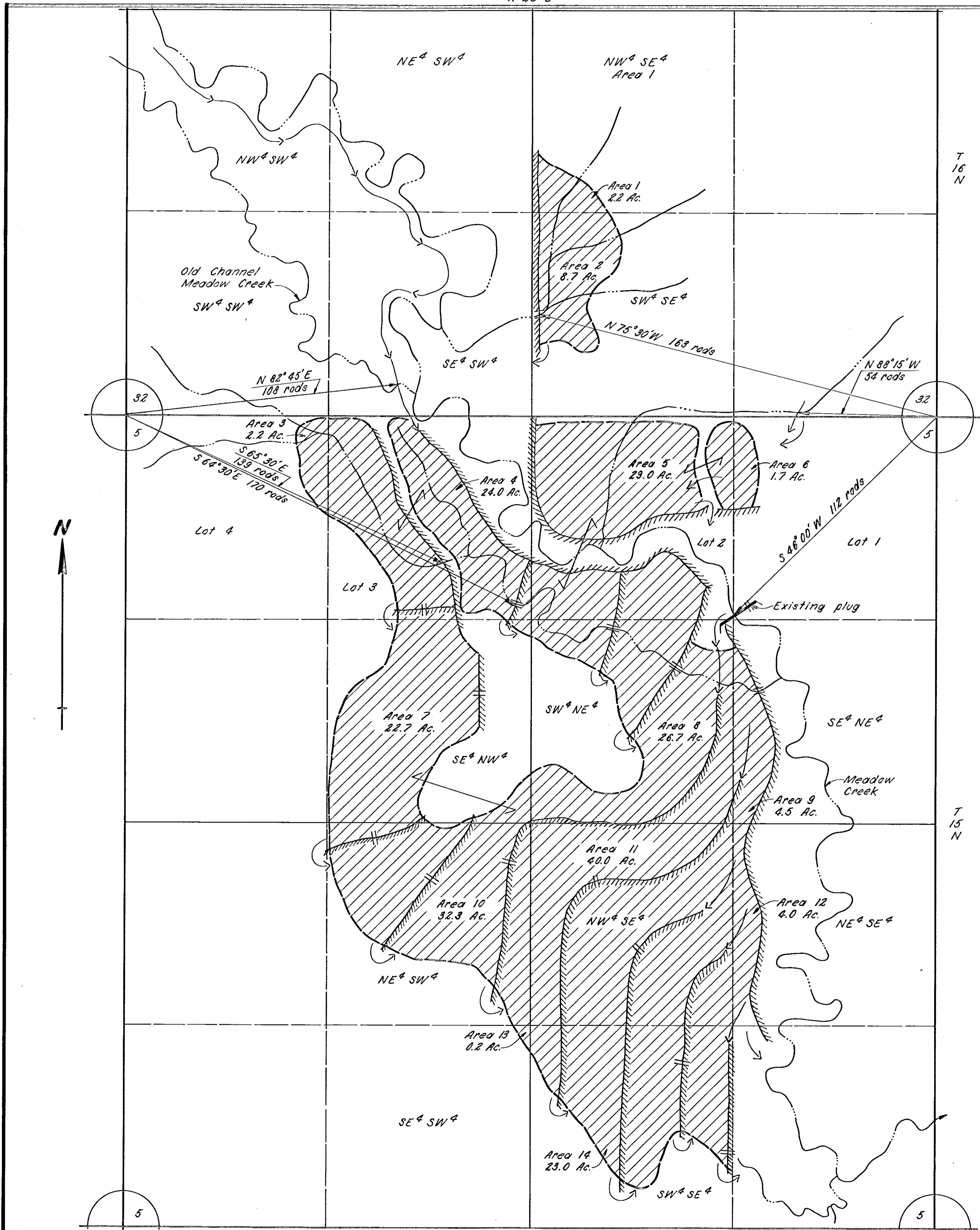

Remarks by State Water Resources Commission:

Diversion structures built under this permit in the main branch of Meadow Creek must incorporate an uncontrolled by-pass tube not smaller than 10 inches in diameter to allow passage of low stream flows for downstream domestic use and prior water rights. The top of these outlet tubes must be located at least one foot below that elevation at which water would be diverted from the watercourse.
