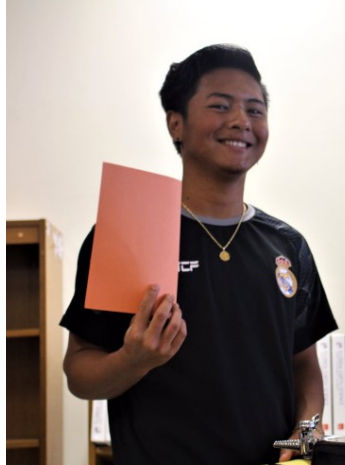


BATTLE OF THE BOULEVARD 2019 FOOTBALL GAME
