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STAFF RULES OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Report of the Secretary-General

- 1. In accordance with regulation 12.2 of the staff regulations, the Secretar General calls to the attention of the General Assembly the additions to and the in the staff rules which he has made in 1956.
- 2. Amendments to the staff rules promulgated by the Secretary-General since tenth session of the General Assembly have been those necessary to implement decisions taken by the General Assembly, and a number of other adjustments show to be necessary by the normal operations of the Secretariat.
- 3. A number of amendments to the staff rules governing the career staff, including a new staff rule on education grant designed to implement the decision taken at the tenth session of the General Assembly on this subject, \frac{1}{2} was issued on 13 February 1956 under document number ST/SGB/94/Rev.4/Amend.1. A parallel set on amendments to the staff rules governing persons recruited specifically for service with the Expanded Programme of Technical Assistance was issued on 28 March 1956 under document number ST/SGB/104.
- 4. An adjustment of the salary scales of manual workers at Headquarters was announced by ST/SGB/94/Rev.4/Amend.2, and of the salary scales for the Field Service by ST/SGB/94/Rev.4/Amend.3. A point of modification on time of the first home leave entitlement following adjustment of a Headquarters staff member from United States permanent residence status to international organization status was announced by ST/SGB/105. Salary rates for short-term conference staff at Headquarters were adjusted by ST/SGB/94/Add.2/Amend 5.
- 5. The documents referred to above have been distributed to Member States.
