Cambodia's Prime Minister - Lom Nol also borrowing a

U.S. helicopter; flying up to the battle zone - to get a first hand look at the situation. Lom Nol apparently hoping to inspire his troops: - to get rolling again.

Turning to the domestic front - New York's big Morgan Guaranty Trust Company today dropped its prime interest rate & half a point, down to seven and a half percent. was This followed by a similar cut 4 on the part of another New York bank - Chemical of New York in a matter of hours - leading to a flood of like reductions from coast to coast. A spokes man for Morgan Guaranty calling its action - a "response to market conditions and monetary policies;" which is merely another way of saying - the money supply is finally loosening up a bit.

The White House again - President Nixon today selected General Benjamin Davis - as the man to head the administration's new airliner anti-hijacking program.

General Davis - at his retirement from the Air Force in Nineteen Sixty-Eight - the highest ranking Negro in the U.S. armed forces, More recently public safety director of his hometown - Cleveland, Ohio. Now to head a vast force of "sky marshals" - drawn from the Federal Aviation Administration as well as several other federal agencies.

At Buffalo, New York - landmark decision today in the first case of mercury polution ever brought to trial. The Olin Corporation agreeing to limit to less than half a pound per day - its future discharge of mercury into the Niagora River. U.S. Attorney Kenneth Schroeder calling this - a "major victory" - one that will serve as a "pacemaker" - said he - in pending mercury polution cases clear across the country. Scientists agreeing that half a pound per day - would pose no imminent danger to drinking water; as opposed to the company's previous mercury discharge up to twenty - four pounds a day.

From Yale University comes a report today - on a recent study of so-called psychosomatic illnesses. Dr.

Chase Kimball coming to the conclusion that all illnesses - are both psychological, meaning the mind - and somatic, meaning the body. The doctor citing as prime examples peptic ulcer, rheumatoid arthritis and bronchial asthma.

All of which "has psychological aspects - said he - "that influence their cause, precipitation, manifestation, course and outcome."

Dr. Kimball adds that the problem becomes even more acute - in the treatment of serious, possibly fatal diseases such as heart trouble, stroke and so on; for here - said he - the doctor's ability to meet his patient's physical and psychological needs - is often the difference between life and death.
