## FOREWORD

**T**HIS REPORT presents information regarding the staff, students, degrees conferred, income, expenditures, endowment, and physical plant facilities of the land-grant colleges and universities, for the academic year 1950-51. The facts are presented both for the individual institutions, and for the Nation as a whole. The present report, required by law, continues the series of annual reports which had their beginning with the establishment of the land-grant colleges in 1862. Through this series of annual reports, the reader is provided with factual information on the growth and progress of the land-grant institutions of the Nation.

The land-grant institutions occupy a significant place in American higher education, both from the point of view of cultural influence and of number of students served. In the academic year 1950-51, the land-grant colleges and universities enrolled 18 percent of all students attending institutions of higher education, and 35 percent of the students in publicly controlled institutions. The land-grant institutions conferred nearly 25 percent of all earned degrees. Clearly, the Federal-State partnership in higher education through the land-grant colleges has yielded rich and abundant fruit.

# STATISTICS OF LAND-GRANT COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES, YEAR ENDED JUNE 30, 1951

**T**HIS IS the final annual report of the 69 land-grant institutions for the year ended June 30, 1951. A preliminary report giving selected data was prepared for and distributed at the meeting of the Association of Land-Grant Colleges and Universities in Houston, Tex., November 13-17, 1951.

The institutions here reported are called land-grant colleges and universities because public lands were granted to the States for their establishment or support. They are "a system of colleges and universities managed by each State, but conforming to certain broad policy stipulations of Federal law. . . . A few States, notably New York, New Jersey, Delaware, and Pennsylvania, utilize as land-grant institutions, universities with varying degrees of private control." They are operated by each of the 48 States and Alaska, Hawaii, and Puerto Rico. In States maintaining segregated school systems, separate land-grant colleges have been established for Negro students.

**CHANGES AND ADDITIONS.**—During this reporting period the Rhode Island State College changed its name and organization to the "University of Rhode Island," and is so listed in this report.

For the first time, the University of Georgia at Athens reported its Atlanta Division with the parent institution. Enrollment in the Atlanta Division was 5,615 students in the fall of 1950. In any comparison of figures for previous years this should be taken into account.

Table 8, showing the annual income received by the land-grant institutions through the First Morrill Act of 1862 and later Supplementary Acts, has been added. The dates covered are from 1872-73, when the interest from the 1862 Land-Grant Fund began to be realized, through 1951, the year for which this report is made.

**THE QUESTIONNAIRES.**—The questionnaires sent annually to each land-grant college and university are in three parts. Part I is a report by the president of the institution regarding staff and students; Part II is a report on the finances of the institution; Part III is a detailed statement of Federal endowment funds and interest from these funds received through the original Act of 1862, and of Federal appropriations received through the Morrill and Supplementary Acts.

The data on the number of freshman students, and the number of students enrolled in the fall term were taken from the fall survey of enrollments in all institutions of higher education in 1950.<sup>2</sup>

**STAFF.**—There was an increase in 1950-51 over 1949-50 of 5.5 percent in the number of staff members (full-time equivalent basis) in the 52 "white" <sup>3</sup> institutions. Broken down as to sex, the increase was 6.4 percent for men and 1.7 percent for women. Classified by function, the following increases in staff (both full-time and part-time) took place: Resident instruction, 4.2 percent; organized research, 16.7 percent; extension, 3.3 percent; general administration, 13.4 percent.

In the 17 Negro institutions, the full-time staff equivalent shows a small increase of 43 members, 13 of these being men, and 30 women.

**STUDENTS** (undergraduate, graduate, and special).—Comparing enrollments in the 52 white institutions in 1950-51 with those of 1949-50 in the regular session, the total enrollment for 1950-51 shows a decrease of 8.5 percent, which occurred entirely in the undergraduate men enrollment. In fact, this decrease is cut down by a small increase in the enrollment of women. Occurring where it does—among the men students at the undergraduate level—the decrease may be accounted for by two factors: (1) the large decline in the number of veteran students attending college; (2) the decline in the size of the freshman class, due to the low birth rate of the 30's and the calling of young men to active duty in the military service.

Graduate enrollments of both men and women increased, as well as the number of special students.

Of the 17 institutions for Negroes there was a net decrease of only 13 students in the total enrollment. There were 1,048 fewer men and 1,035 more women students in 1950-51 than in 1949-50.

**UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS, BY FIELD.**—In the 52 white institutions the decrease in total undergraduate enrollment was 10.6 percent. Small increases occurred in commerce, dentistry, education, medicine, and nursing. All the increases, except in one instance, occurred in those fields generally classified as "service professions." Enrollments in arts and sciences dropped 12.2 percent; in agriculture, 14.7 percent; and in engineering 26.3 percent. Lesser decreases occurred in architecture, home economics, law, pharmacy, and fields classified as "other professional."

In the 17 institutions for Negroes, decreases occurred in arts and sciences, commerce, engineering, and law.

**DEGREES.**—The percentage change in the degrees conferred by 52 white institutions in 1950-51 from 1949-50 was as follows: The number of men's bachelor's and first professional degrees decreased 19.3 percent; women's 4.7 percent. Master's degrees, both men and women, increased 14.2 percent; doctor's degrees, both men and women increased 5.0 percent.

**INCOME.**—The total educational and general income of the 52 white institutions increased 6.2 percent in 1950-51 over the income of 1949-50. The exception to increases in all categories is the decrease of 32.9 percent in veterans' tuition and fees. Broken down by items, the increases were as follows: Student fees, 6.7 percent; Federal appropriations for instruction, research of experiment stations, and extension, 1.6 percent; contractual research and other grants, 26.2 percent; State governments, 10.0 percent; local governments, 13.5 percent; endowment earnings, 1.5 percent; private benefactions, 11.0 percent; sales and services, 15.6 percent; miscellaneous sources, 6.9 percent.

The total educational and general income of the 17 institutions for Negroes increased 1.4 percent. As in the white institutions, the most notable decrease (59.0 percent) was in the veterans' tuition and fees. Smaller decreases occurred in other Federal appropriations for instruction, and in contractual research. Increases occurred only in amounts received from student fees, from sales and services, and from miscellaneous sources.

**EXPENDITURES.**—Total expenditures for educational and general expenses in 52 white institutions, 1950-51, increased 8.8 percent over 1949-50. Increases occurred in all categories. The most notable increase (19.7 percent) was, understandably, in organized research, separately budgeted, where United States contracts and grants for research were reported.

## LAND-GRANT COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

In the 17 institutions for Negroes, the total educational and general expenditures increased 10.7 percent. Increases occurred in all categories.

**FEDERAL FUNDS.**—The total income from Federal funds in the 52 white institutions decreased 2.3 percent, accounted for entirely by the decrease in veterans' fees. All other funds showed increases.

Federal funds for the 17 institutions for Negroes decreased 28.1 percent.

Decreases in Federal funds for veterans' tuition and fees amounted to 32.9 percent in the 52 white institutions, and 37.3 percent in the 17 institutions for Negroes. Contracts and grants for research increased about 10.3 percent in the white institutions, and decreased 6.0 percent in the 17 institutions for Negroes.
