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LabSolue: Blend of Beauty

LABSOLUE: FROM LABORATORY AND ABSOLUTE. A PERFUMERY BRAND BORN FROM A CONNECTION OF DEEP FAMILY ROOTS, THREE EXPERT GENERATIONS OF PERFUMERS

LabSolue is a combination of Laboratory and the French word, Absolue – Absolute. These two words are two fundamental aspects to the art of perfume production blended in order to create the brand name.

The Absolute is the most prized extraction of perfumery ingredients: a rich and noble natural raw material, obtained with the technique of extraction with volatile solvents, from the alcohol treatment of concretes. The Laboratory is where ideas are born, the hub of innovation and creation — this is where the know-how of making perfumes grew over decades is put into practice. From the emphasis on expertise, to the use of pure extractions from natures garden, works of beauty and excellence are presented and preserved.

Artistic perfumery brand LabSolue was created by the Martone sisters, Giorgia and Ambra in 2007, in Milan. Nearly a century of experience and know-how: it all began in 1945, with the historic family pharmaceutical and cosmetic brand, Marvin, founded by grandfather Vincenzo Martone. The factory expanded and evolved with ICR (Industrie Cosmetiche Riunite), a world-renowned cosmetic company producer of luxury perfumes, under the guidance of father Roberto Martone. A bond of deep family roots, handed down from generation to generation, which continues to embrace the values of artistry, high quality and craftsmanship.

Our senses become heightened in moments of pleasure, creating an archive of memories stimulated by fragrances. LabSolue is an expert in the formulation of scents, from the fruity to the floral to the woody; their assistance is fundamental in the search for that perfect combination, a balance between natural essences and chemical interactions to arouse that particular emotion.

There are three olfactory sections to the laboratory: Fruits and Aromatics, Flowers, Woods and Resins

The tree is a constant, always the focus of inspiration and olfactory reference for LabSolue. Roots, trunk, branches, resins, leaves, flowers, fruits: the plant is considered in its totality and complexity when deciding to create a perfume. It is a process of glorification of its essence. But the tree is also the symbol that represents the Martone family history, from grandfather's perfume factory to today's reality — successive generations who have passed on and sublimated the art of perfumery. Finally, the tree becomes a graphic sign to identify Magna Pars, the Hotel à Parfum of the family, which stands on the site of the former perfume factory of the family.

THE ARCHITECTURE OF LABSOLUE PERFUME LABORATORY IS REFLECTIVE OF THE TALENT, SENSIBILITY AND PRECISION THAT IS USED IN THE FRAGRANCE PRODUCTION

Located in the design district of Milan, between Via Tortona and Via Forcella, the Marvin ex-factory turned LabSolue sensorial laboratory has been re-imagined to reflect both historical and present-day influences. This is achieved through the use of original industrial architecture materials, iron and glass, contemporarily recalling a strong connection with nature, with the use of wood. There is a retro feel with a modern touch.

The Laboratory is reminiscent of the creative and rigorous design of the perfumes. The original Marvin pharmacy can be felt in LabSolue's bones with references to archival objects from the fifties and sixties stored in wooden cabinets with drawers and showcases inspired by the pharmaceutical laboratory and the characteristic apothecary amber-glass jars. These become identifying codes, providing strength and stability to the ever-growing collection, a reminder of the brand's history and future.

LabSolue's space in Milan is a part of the Magna Pars hotel, making it the first Hotel à Parfum worldwide. The Laboratory is divided into olfactory islands, each one dedicated to an olfactive family and a library of scents. Each one is as attractive as the next, entrancing all senses. The three sections distinguish Perfume Laboratory: Fruit and Aromatic scents to fly, Floral shrubs to delight, and Wood and Resinous essences to remain. There is also the island of Handcrafted Candles.

On the lab work counter, stage of emotions aroused by essences of evocative strength and deep familial value, you discover the fragrances of the mysteriously dated Aqua Adornationis line, perfumes to adorn the spirit, whose roots go back to the family tree and are enriched over time with new dates. A celebration of tastes, textures, and tales.

Everything can be traced back to the pharmaceutical tradition. To smell the perfumes, glass funnels are used. The essences are kept in steel refrigerators, in the dark, at five degrees. The perfumes are freshly filled, packed and labeled on the spot: an expert Lab Tender delves the perfume lover into an olfactive memory to find a particular fragrance and recollection and make it one's own.

THE LABORATORY WELCOMES PERFUME LOVERS WITH ITS CURATED AND SLEEK DESIGN OF WOODEN DRAWERS OF THE ORIGINAL MARVIN PHARMACY AND OLFACTORY ISLANDS

LabSolue Perfume Laboratory can also be found in the Italian capital, Rome. A short distance from Campo de' Fiori, LabSolue's second Italian home is situated among the art galleries and unique boutiques of Via di Monserrato. This is one of the most intriguing Roman streets known for its intertwinement between past and present, between tradition and modernity — the ethos of LabSolue echoes that of the historical city.

Via di Monserrato is dedicated to artistic shopping and genuine lifestyle. It is located in the center, yet it is a quiet escape. Here, people live at a slower pace while reveling in the arty pieces on offer. LabSolue's location here makes sense as you appreciate the made in Italy and the hand-crafted spirit. From flower stores to special jewelry and accessory boutiques, tourists and locals alike visit this place in Rome and leave with a true taste of Italian artisanship.

The interior details of the Roman olfactory Laboratory remain true to that of the original Milanese one. Stylish wooden cabinets and shelves are seen around, inspired by the pharmaceutical laboratory of Marvin. Wood combined with iron and steel is used for the structure of the olfactory islands. Reminiscent of the hub in Milan, there is an island for the Wood Essences, the Floral Shrubs and the Fruit and Aromatic olfactive libraries. The Aqua Adornationis line also has its own dedicated island in the Roman store.

Everything comes back the family tradition and the pharmaceutical roots of the business. Perfumes are evaluated through glass funnels. The essences are kept in steel refrigerators, in the dark, at five degrees. The perfumes are freshly filled, packed and labeled on the spot: an expert Lab Tender delves the perfume lover into an olfactive memory to find a particular fragrance and recollection and make it one's own.

The olfactive journey reigns throughout the Laboratory, with the nods to the tree, its roots and the familial values always interlinked.

LOCATED IN THE FORMER PERFUME FACTORY OF THE MARTONE FAMILY, MAGNA PARS IS A FIVE-STAR HOTEL À PARFUM – THE ONLY ONE OF ITS KIND WORLDWIDE

LabSolue Perfume Laboratory is located inside the five-star Hotel à Parfum Magna Pars — the only one of its kind in the world. The unique space brings scent to the forefront, dedicating an Essence to each one of the Suites — each one as personal as the next. The number associated with the name of each Essence actually represents the number of the Suite, while the name is that of the main raw material or olfactory note within the composition. Perfume becomes the undisputed protagonist. Throughout the hotel olfactive culture reigns supreme, interpreting multiple expressions.

The structure reflects past and present, with elements of the original build and function — a modern and minimalist design encouraging the senses to admire and preserve the scents created and presented in the LabSolue Perfume Laboratory. Guests are welcomed with an OLFACTORY CHECK-IN: invited to choose a particular fragrance from a personal choice or curiosity. There are sixty-eight Essences - the same number of Suites. Therefore, guests can enjoy the stay in a suite dedicated to their particular scent of choice.

Each Suite is inspired by a fruity, aromatic, floral, woody or resinous scent, according to the history of the family perfume factory. Guests are invited to breathe in Exclusive Olfactive Journeys delving into art, literature, culture and the roots of essences to understand their uniqueness, properties, and curiosities. Wellness and relaxation are enhanced with Essential Oil Massages which have been perfected with the ancient principles of AROMATHERAPY.

There is also a private Library in the hotel and guests can find a selection of books on perfumery dedicated to both the technical and narrative aspects of the trade. Every suite in the hotel is enhanced with Giorgia Martone's book *The grammar of perfumes*, open on the page dedicated to the raw material which served as an inspiration for that particular room.

An OLFACTIVE APERITIF and MENU À PARFUM await the guests: a balanced taste of Italian ingredients is accompanied by an olfactory accent and a distinctive laboratory aesthetic. Dishes are presented with elements of the workshop - the dropper is used to add scented oils on the food; the funnel is turned upside down like a cloche, smoking from the various woods, the beaker serves as sauce boat, a celebration of perfumery and a sensorial experience.

Liquidambar is a red thread between nature, perfume and cuisine. It derives from one of the best-selling fragrances, 207 Liquidambar, an American tree that is also present within the hotel garden and gives the name to the lounge bar. The bar is connected to the restaurant, Da Noi In, which uses local and organic ingredients. It is a seasonal Italian menu.

Magna Pars is also in partnership with MUDEC, the nearby Museum of Cultures of Milan. Guests have the option of attending a private, guided tour at night. They are served a dinner in the hotel restaurant, inspired by the current exhibition at MUDEC, and then see the exhibition with their senses still enlightened.

From the visual to the olfactory, Magna Pars the Hotel à Parfum smells like no other.

ALL LABSOLUE PRODUCTS, HAND-CRAFTED IN ITALY, ARE MADE WITH RESPONSIBLY SOURCED, RECYCLED OR RECYCLABLE MATERIALS AND ARE DESIGNED TO BE REFILLABLE AND REUSABLE

Together with the values of high quality and artisan crafting, the Martone family has always been committed to affirming an authentic, honest and responsible lifestyle. LabSolue Perfume Laboratory creations are the synthesis of Italian craftsmanship and essential beauty, an expression of sustainable elegance.

The Made in Italy is not only a choice of excellence, but also a commitment towards the community.

LabSolue promotes social and environmental principles, aiming to advance wellbeing, limit waste, and carefully manage resources. All LabSolue products are hand-crafted in Italy, made with responsibly sourced, recycled and/or recyclable materials, and designed to be refillable and reusable over time.

Fragrance lovers can purchase their favorite Essence to refill their home diffuser infinitely. All diffuser bottles and candle jars are intended to be reused as original flower vases, adding to the decor of the home long after the scent has run its course. All bottles have been developed with a screw neck, to facilitate both refilling and recycling.

LabSolue respects the use of natural ingredients, their richness, and their genuine qualities.

Entire trees, from leaves to roots, are at the base of the creative work. LabSolue didn't want to produce soliflores - that is, perfumes that try to recreate the scent of the raw material in an aseptic environment. The compositions are born from the plant and the territory the plant comes from. The dominant raw material — that gives its name to each LabSolue Essence - is recognizable, but there are other elements that clarify it.

The alcohol that we select and use for our essences derives from cereals of European origin only, and this applies both to the personal and to the home fragrances.

LabSolue trusts and follows the European legislation, which requires strict control and testing on each cosmetic product before authorising it for sale. True to the commitment that has distinguished it since its inception, the brand has a formulation charter that excludes also certain ingredients that are authorized but raise concerns — in particular parabens, TEA/DEA, silicones, aluminum, mineral oils, synthetic dyes, and sulfates – and continually evolves formulas to replace controversial ingredients.

The reeds chosen to diffuse the Essences are made of natural untreated rattan.

The candles are hand-poured in Italy, uncolored and color of the wax is only due to the natural ingredients contained. The wick is made of pure and untreated cotton braids, free from a metal core.

Each box, including the outer and the inner parts, is completely made of paper, ensuring for simple and proficient recycling. For this same reason, we have decided not to protect it with cellophane. All our paper is certified by the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC), to assure that it comes from forests that are responsibly managed.

This is in order to meet the social and ecological needs of the present and future generations.

"MARVIN is an industry specialized in pharmaceutical production that has made a name for itself for its work over the years. Its medicinal specialties, known in Italy and abroad, include a wide range of the most important active ingredients used in modern therapy. Taking advantage of these factors and making the most of its highly scientific technological experience, which is an essential aspect of its organization, MARVIN decided approximately ten years ago to devote part of its energies to a new area: cosmetology. Obviously, these considerations only regard cosmetic formulas that, like those of MARVIN, are not produced according to empirical bases but especially take into account their purity and safety in all cases and in all subjects, particularly regarding allergies and skin intolerance. Before launching the MARVIN cosmetic line on Italian and foreign markets, the talented technicians of MARVIN's research laboratories performed tests for several years, supervised by internationally renowned medical experts. After a long series of experiences, it was possible to prepare a vast range of products with a sure eudermic effect that was absolutely safe, even for the most delicate skin. Chemical-physical, biological and clinical tests, which are at the basis of every MARVIN formula, are a guarantee of safety."

VINCENZO MARTONE FOUNDED MARVIN IN THE FORTIES IN MILAN: THE COMPANY SPECIALIZED IN PHARMACEUTICALS AND COSMETICS THAT GREW INTO ICR AND LABSOLUE

From grandfather to granddaughters. A passion for perfumes, knowledge of perfumery, and a dedication to quality have been passed on through the years, opening ways for new ideas and new formulas, yet never forgetting the roots.

The Martone family tree grew from Vincenzo Martone, the founder of Marvin Pharmacy and Cosmetics, followed by the son, Roberto Martone, the name behind ICR Industrie Cosmetiche Riunite, world-renowned luxury perfume manufacturer. Then, it arrived at the branches of today, the granddaughters, Giorgia and Ambra Martone, creators of LabSolue.

Vincenzo Martone founded Marvin in Milan at the start of the Forties. The company specialized in pharmaceuticals and antibiotics. As the business grew, they expanded into fragrance and skincare product development. In 1969 he won the Oscars of cosmetics, for his invention of a hypoallergenic moisturizing cream. Roberto Martone, the son of Vincenzo, took over and started creating perfumes for Italian brands and thus in 1975 ICR was born. From the Eighties, prominent figures within luxury Italian industries started working with ICR: Renato Balestra, Gianni Versace, Nazareno Gabrielli, Nicola Trussardi, Romeo Gigli, Bulgari, Salvatore Ferragamo, Emanuel Ungaro, Roberto Cavalli, to name a few.

LabSolue began to take shape in 2007, evolving from Marvin, due to Giorgia's interest in the family archive and history. Coming across past delightful fragrances, interesting old formulas, and an attention to detail in the original packaging, the family business was reignited with a will to revitalize a beloved heritage. The present family perfume factory ICR was able to incorporate the origins into the products of today, bringing the creativity and determination of a certain moment in time into the arms of the next generation.



AQUA ADORNATIONIS IS A GLIMPSE INTO THE FAMILY ROOTS, CORE AND VALUES, WITH THE AIM OF GENERATING THE SAME EMOTIONS IN EACH AND EVERY PERFUME LOVER.

Aqua Adornationis is a glimpse into the Martone family roots, core and values - art, quality and craftsmanship - from the historic pharmaceutical and cosmetic brand Marvin created by grandfather Vincenzo, to the luxury perfume manufacturer ICR founded by father Roberto, to the artistic perfumery brand LabSolue developed by Giorgia and Ambra sisters.

The old pharmacy design and formulations and other details has led to the revival of a family project inspired by past traditions and a deep love for one's work and now made with the same love, innovation and originality. A legal label UTIF (which stands for Italian Production Tax Technical Offices) - mandatory at the time and almost hidden on the bottom of the original Marvin bottle yet still firmly glued to glass - gave the line its name.

This name, no longer used, once had a great symbolic significance and today it returns as a line of fragrances that adorn the spirit with new olfactory emotions. One can travel through time and arrive at the modern interpretations of the artisanal in the world of perfumery.

The Latin name Aqua Adornationis was 'found' by Giorgia Martone on the bottom label of an old perfume in the archives of Marvin, the company founded by her grandfather Vincenzo in 1940. By doing research herself, she discovered that it was the legal definition for fragrances in Italy at that time, and consequently written on the label, as today we use the French names eau de toilette, eau de cologne, eau de parfum and so on. In literal terms this refers to water to adorn — an explanation of the practical use of perfumes, but also a declaration of their beauty within simplicity. LabSolue believes in preserving the original name; a reminder of the past generations, Aqua Adornationis is perfume-making at its purest.

LabSolue is an artisan in the world of perfumery; pushing boundaries with innovative and explorative Aqua Adornationis scents and their combinations, to create works of art and encapsulate intense emotions. Contemporary style, elegantly minimalistic, with a vintage touch, the glass bottles are reminiscent of the original Marvin pharmaceutical design as are the decorations that embellish labels and caps — an ode to the celebration of history, family, and dedication, from a passion that has its roots in the past, but which reaches out to the future.

AQUA ADORNATIONIS TRANSPORTS THE SENSES TO OLFACTORY ROOTS BOTH NEAR AND FAR, TO THE PAST AND PRESENT. INSPIRED BY MYSTERIOUS BIRTH DATES, EACH ESSENCE BREATHES OUT A PERSONALITY OF ITS OWN.

From the experienced nose of the Perfumers, adorn the spirit with fusions of precious ingredients. One can feel the nostalgia for a new scent. These fragrances require no introduction; the harmonies speak for themselves. A vintage feel with an updated touch, each volume presents tastes, textures, and tales unique. Expertise and curiosity come together to discover combinations of olfactory roots.

Associated with the name is a date, important and mysterious, which concerns a member or a friend of the family and refers to an event. Each fragrance wants to crystallize that moment, and propose an olfactory portrait of the person who refers to it. Each Aqua Adornationis creation is a heartbeat - it aims to arouse emotions in perfume lovers.

The line currently consists of eight perfumes created with the aid of only Master Perfumers.

Dominique Ropion is the artist of *Vertigo 1973*: celestial attraction of woods, leather and spices, to let senses fall free, and feel the head spin. For vanilla lovers, Aurelien Guichard created *Heroine 1980*: impossible to let go, igniting the confidence within. Daphné Bugey's *Honorable 1947* reawakens the senses, it is an invitation to feel nature's pulse like the scent of the winter sea warmed by the first rays of the spring sun.

Sophie Labbé, has signed two masterpieces: Alpha 1977 which is to experience summer's long gaze, the simplicity of the stories that begin, a seduction nobody can resist, and Bohemian Spirit 1979 that is inspired by Giorgia Martone, founder of LabSolue. Over the course of almost fifteen years Giorgia has perfected with Sophie this original creation which refers to the year of her birth, and describes the feeling of a first encounter, flowing and memorable - that of Giorgia with perfume, the brief moment that passes between being unknown and getting to know each other, the synthesis of her lightness and depth, of her child's heart and woman's soul. Today it is the Essence that brings Giorgia back to us in her absence.

Combustion 1978 by Alexandra Carlin is the scent of the senses on fire, on the verge of catching fire. With Sable Blanc 1950, Nathalie Lorson olfactorily portrayed Mother Nature, the beauty of white sands kissed by the sun. As a hymn to the volatility and allure of the stormy seascape in summer, Yann Vasnier created Salty Rock 1982.

THE DETAILS - AND THE ATTENTION TO DETAIL:

Aqua Adornationis fragrances are formulated exclusively as perfumes for person - Eaux de Parfum - available in 120 ml and 20 ml formats, with Natural Spray.

They are enclosed in transparent-glass bottles with a contemporary, elegantly minimalistic design - inspired by the original design of Marvin perfume bottles - designed and built to last, refillable and recyclable. All rigorously silk-screened.

The pump is screw type and can be easily opened, both for refill and for recycling purpose.

The cap is made in Italy, from a high quality recyclable metal alloy. It is engraved on the top with the historical Marvin brand symbol: a tiny alembic with the letter m.

The final touch is a refined colorful label made with old artisan plates. It features heat-embossed leaves — framed decorations inspired by the original design of grandfather Vincenzo.

Each and every Aqua Adornationis detail is a tribute to the origins and history of the family.

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



The Amenities Aqua Adornationis 1947

ROOTED WITHIN THE ORIGINS OF THE FAMILY TREE, THE FRAGRANCE AQUA ADORNATIONIS 1947 GIVES LIFE TO THE ICONIC AMENITIES, DESIGNED FOR MAGNA PARS THE HOTEL À PARFUM, FORMER PERFUME FACTORY OF THE MARTONE FAMILY

Reawaken the senses. Aqua Adornationis 1947 is an invitation to feel nature's pulse, the pull of the winter sea as it moves in unison with the first spring sun's rays. A harmonious blend of Neroli, Cedarwood, and Sandalwood combined with hints of Musk. A vibrant perfume that is transportive to a day in late February when winter has broken and the promise of spring is looming.

Neroli, Cedarwood, Sandalwood, and Musk enchant the senses and bring radiance to body and spirit, while the bath & body formulations are created for the pleasure of pampering.

Calming, balancing and rejuvenating, Neroli Essentila Oil is extracted by distillation from Bitter Orange Blossoms. It takes its name from Anna Maria de la Tremoïlle de Noirmoutier, wife of Flavio Orsini duke of Bracciano and prince of Nerola, who adored its fresh perfume of petals so much to introduce it to France in the late 17th century.

There are three families of Essence at LabSolue: Fruits and Aromatics, Flowers, and Woods and Resins. Each Essence evokes an emotion, a sensation, a moment that needs to be experienced firsthand. The fragrance of fresh Fruit, the delights of a Flower, and the aroma of warm Woods come together as unified entities, waiting to be savored and rejoiced. The artisanal art of perfume-making, hand in hand with nature's finest ingredients, unite within these essences to create products of beauty.

Perfumery is an art form that, thanks to Master Perfumers and collaborators, transforms natural ingredients and high-tech molecules into perfumes. The world of fragrances that LabSolue presents is the result of enchantment and passion enclosed within each creation.

The scents are so divine that the Fruits, Flowers, and Woods transform the inner souls of the perfumed journey. Memories are meant to be made, savored, and remembered. LabSolue perfumes generate moods, moments, and emotions, each olfactive blend as unique as the next.

LabSolue's foundation is built on Absolute. The Absolute, derivative from the French word Absolue refers to a fragrant substance that is obtained by extraction from various parts of plants with volatile solvents; to obtain it, concretes are purified. Concretes effectively are a semisolid paste resulting from the primary extraction of fragrant principles from fresh plant matter. Resinoid is a substance obtained from the primary solvent extraction of dry plant biomass.

The tree is a constant, always the focus of inspiration and olfactory reference for LabSolue. Roots, trunk, resins, branches, leaves, flowers, fruits: the plant is considered in its totality and complexity when deciding to create a perfume. It is a process of glorification of its essence. But the tree is also the symbol that represents a family history — the Martone family – from grandfather Vincenzo's perfume factory to father Roberto's ICR to today's reality wanted by Giorgia and Ambra — successive generations who have passed on and sublimated the art of perfumery. Finally, the tree becomes a graphic sign to identify Magna Pars l'Hotel à Parfum of the family which stands on the site of the former perfume factory of the family.

Entire trees, from leaves to roots, are at the base of the creative work. LabSolue didn't want to produce soliflores — that is, perfumes that try to recreate the scent of the raw material in an aseptic environment. The compositions are born from the plant and the territory the plant comes from. The dominant raw material — that gives its name to each LabSolue Essence — is recognizable, but there are other elements that clarify it.

The ode to nature is always present in the LabSolue Essences and the commitment towards raw, clean materials carry over the olfactive library.







LabSolue's foundation is built on Laboratory and Absolute. The Absolute, derivative from the French word Absolue refers to a fragrant substance that is obtained by extraction from various parts of plants with volatile solvents; to obtain it, concretes are purified. Concretes effectively are a semisolid paste resulting from the primary extraction of fragrant principles from plant matter.

The tree is a constant, always the focus of inspiration and olfactory reference for LabSolue. Roots, trunk, resins, branches, leaves, flowers, fruits: the plant is considered in its totality and complexity when deciding to create a perfume. It is a process of glorification of its essence. But the tree is also the symbol that represents a family history, from grandfather's perfume factory to today's reality – successive generations who have passed on and sublimated the art of perfumery. Finally, the tree becomes a graphic sign to identify Magna Pars l'Hotel à Parfum, which stands on the site of the former perfume factory of the family.

LabSolue Essences are divided into three different olfactory groups which always return to the tree structure: Fruits and Aromatics, Flowers, Woods and Resins.

Nathalie Lorson is the creator of 7 Sandalo (Sandalwood), 14 Angelica and 21 Gelsomino (Jasmine). Oliver Cresp has developed 12 Fresia (Freesia), 23 Neroli, 25 Fiore d'Arancio (Orange Blossom) and 306 Salvia Bianca. Aurélien Guichard is the nose for 304 Vaniglia (Vanilla) as well as for 34 Ylang Ylang. Emilie Copperman realized 305 Mentha Aquatica (Water Mint); Veronique Nyberg is the Perfumer behind 312 Petitgrain and 16 Oud was created by Luca Maffei.

Each candle requires meticulous work to balance the perfume concentrate with a high concentration of natural essences, blend of waxes, shape and size of glass container, diameter and weaving of cotton wick. All to ensure exceptional olfactory qualities and optimal burning.

Each candle container is made of glass in Italy, designed to last, reusable and recyclable. It comes in different colors according to the olfactive family of the Essence. Green is used for Fruits and Aromatics, while a transparent container is reserved for Flowers, and amber for Woods. The Resin candles are encapsulated in a blue glass container. All rigorously silk-screened on the back.

The wax is hand-poured in Italy and does not contain any artificial colorants, its color is exclusively due to the natural ingredients of the essence. The wick is made of pure and untreated cotton braids, free from metal core.





Roberto Martone was born in Milan on February 28, 1947.

After graduating with a degree in Pharmacy, he immediately began working in his family's pharmaceutical industry.

Roberto inherited his father's passion for industry and entrepreneurial intuition, which led him to establish ICR Industrie Cosmetiche Riunite in 1975 with the ambitious goal of creating lines of deluxe Italian perfumes for prestigious Italian fashion designers. Thus, Renato Balestra perfumes were born and followed a few years later by the Trussardi fragrances that determined an authentic turning point in the Italian perfumery market due to their worldwide success, thanks to the extraordinary quality of the products with innovative packaging and modern bouquets.

In 1988 Roberto Martone signed a joint-venture agreement with Gianni Versace for the worldwide license of fragrances and cosmetics, founding Versace Profumi, which was later sold in 2004.

In 1991 the subsidiary Pardis GmbH was opened in Munich for the direct management of the German and Austrian markets. To facilitate the continuous growth of the company, a new project was launched in 2002 that separated industrial and distribution activities. Roberto Martone established ITF, an acronym for Italian Fragrances, with the mission of managing licenses with designers such as Blumarine, Cavalli, Dsquared2, Gianfranco Ferré and Trussardi.

When ITF was sold to the Angelini pharmaceutical group in 2013, the company changed its name to Angelini Beauty. Today ICR confirms its industrial and logistics mission through its R&D laboratories and the production, packaging and shipping of perfumes and cosmetics on an international level. It is one of the most important Italian companies in the sector and produces products, through exclusive worldwide rights, for prestigious brands such as Bulgari, Salvatore Ferragamo, and Emanuel Ungaro and for all Angelini Beauty brands, including Blumarine, Dsquared2, Gianfranco Ferré, Trussardi and Laura Biagiotti.

Today the ICR headquarters and plant in Lodi covers a surface area of 52,000 square meters, employs more than 600 people, and produces 85 million units per year.

Roberto Martone's entrepreneurial activities also include the congress sector with the Magna Pars multi-purpose complex designed and built in the former ICR factory on Via Tortona in Milan. In this area dedicated to fashion and design and adjacent to Magna Pars on Via Forcella, he also launched a new project: the Magna Pars Suites Milano five-star hotel with 39 suites, restaurant, wine bar, roof terrace and garage.

Thanks to her intuition, she defines the original positioning of Magna Pars, the Hotel à Parfum, the first Parfum Hotel in the world, located in Milan in the original family perfume factory. There, together with her beloved sister Ambra, she founds LabSolue: the artistic and artisanal perfumery laboratory, a collection of precious perfumes inspired by the Italian territory, its flowering, woody, fruity and aromatic shrubs, where Marvin, the historic cosmetic brand founded in 1945 by grandfather Vincenzo, is celebrated and Aqua Adornationis, a tribute to the roots and family history, is born. A place where to get intoxicated with emotions browsing through ingredients and essential oils, where to select ones favorite Essence enclosed in an eau de parfum, a home perfume, a handmade candle. With the same passion and intensity she opens LabSolue in Rome and creates special collaborations for the expansion in prestigious realities around the world.

Her creativity knows no bounds: she travels, photographs, paints, reads and writes ideas, suggestions and projects. In 2019 her book "La Grammatica dei Profumi" is released for Gribaudo, becoming a reference in the perfume sector that came to its fifth edition.


