

#### Readings for March 27, 2022 Fourth Sunday of Lent

#### Joshua 5:9a, 10-12

The people of God entered the promised land and there kept the Passover.

#### Psalm 34:2-3, 4-5, 6-7

Taste and see the goodness of the Lord.

#### Corinthians 5:17-21

God reconciled us to himself through Christ.

#### Luke 15:1-3, 11-32

Your brother was dead and has come to life again.

#### Reflection

When we read the Old Testament, we are reading the same literature that the Jews read in Jesus's time and that the first Christians read after Jesus's resurrection. There is a direct through line in our experience of salvation history, because every community's chapter is aware of the chapter before. When Paul is telling the Corinthians about Moses and the Israelites, he says, "These things happened to them as an example, and they have been written down as a warning to us, upon whom the end of the ages has come. Therefore, whoever thinks he is standing secure should take care not to fall." Paul may as well be speaking to twenty-first-century Christians. In fact, he is.

#### **Gentle in Our Lives**

The Lord is kind and merciful.

My brothers and sisters, I urge you, I beseech you by the Lord and his gentleness, be gentle in your lives, be peaceful in your lives. Peacefully permit the authorities to do what pertains to them, of which they will have to render an account to God and to their superiors. As often as you have to petition them, make your petitions in an honorable and quiet manner. Do not mix with those who do evil and rampage in a rough and disorderly manner; do not desire to be present at such goings-on even as spectators.

But as far as you can, let each of you in [your] own house and [your] own neighborhood deal with the one with whom you have ties of kinship and charity, by warning, persuading, teaching, correcting; also by restraining him from such seriously evil activities by any kind of threats, so that God may eventually have mercy, and put an end to human evils and "may not deal with us according to our sins or requite us according to our iniquities, but as far as the east is from the west may cast our sins for away from us" [Ps 103:10, 12] and that he "may be gracious to our sins, lest the nations perhaps should say, Where is their God?" [Ps 79:9-10].

St. Augustine, Sermon 302

St. Augustine (354–430) experienced a pivotal conversion as an adult. In 395, within eight years of his baptism, he became bishop of Hippo. One of the early Church Fathers, he is also a Doctor of the Church.


