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PRESS RELEASE.

Whereas, J&K Pharmacy Act, Samvat 2011 got repealed by the Pharmacy Act, 1948 after the introduction of J&K Re-organization Act, 2019;

Whereas, vide S.O no: 3465E, Dated: 05.10.2020 a provision was carved out in the Central Pharmacy Act, which reads as under:

Section 32(C): "Special provisions regarding persons registered under the Jammu and Kashmir Pharmacy Act, Samvat, 2011 (1955 A.D):- Notwithstanding anything contained in section 32, any person whose name has been entered in the register of pharmacists maintained under the Jammu and Kashmir Pharmacy Act, 2011 (1955 A.D) and possesses qualification prescribed under the said Act shall be deemed to have been entered in the register of pharmacists prepared and maintained under Chapter IV of this Act, subject to an application to be made in this behalf within a period of one year commencing from 31st October, 2020 and payment of such fee as may be prescribed by the Government of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir."

Whereas, representations were received from the stakeholders seeking a review of the above notification to the extent that the left over candidates who were either pursuing course of study in Medical Assistant/Pharmacist at the time of introduction of J&K Re-organization Act, 2019 as also such registered Pharmacists who for one reason or the other failed to apply for re-registration under Section 32C by or before 31st October, 2021;

Whereas, the matter was discussed at various levels by Govt of J&K & referred to the competent authority for consideration;

Whereas, the Ministry of Law & Justice (Legislative Department), Govt of India has now issued another notification bearing no: 31, Dated: 15.08.2023 which reads as under:

“32C, Notwithstanding anything contained in section 32, any person whose name has been entered in the register of pharmacists maintained under the Jammu and Kashmir Pharmacy Act, 2011 or possesses qualification (medical assistant/pharmacists) prescribed under the said Act shall be deemed to have been entered in the register of pharmacists prepared and maintained under Chapter IV of this Act, subject to condition that an application to be made in this behalf within a period of one year from the commencement of the Pharmacy (Amendment) Act, 2023 and on payment of such fee, and in such manner, as may be prescribed by the Government of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir and Administration of Union Territory of Ladakh”.

Now, therefore all such candidates who desire to get themselves registered as Pharmacist under the Pharmacy Act, 1948 (Section 32C) & possess the requisite eligibility (**Medical Assistant/Pharmacist**) in terms of the notification reproduced above are advised to submit their application through Online portal under our official website link: www.jkpc.in **w.e.f 01.09.2023** along with supportive documents as per below checklist:
