This list is organized by **Accent** type. For the Template, the **symbol "V" means any vowel**. The format is to hold the first two keys down simultaneously, release, then type the letter you wish to be accented.

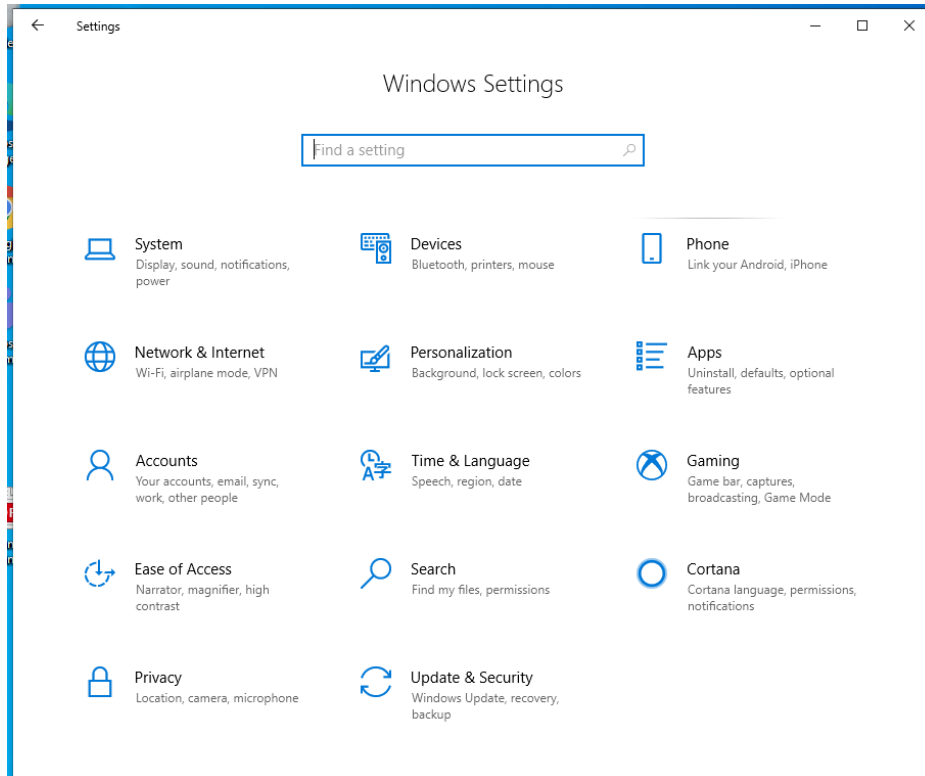

How to add a Japanese or Chinese keyboard

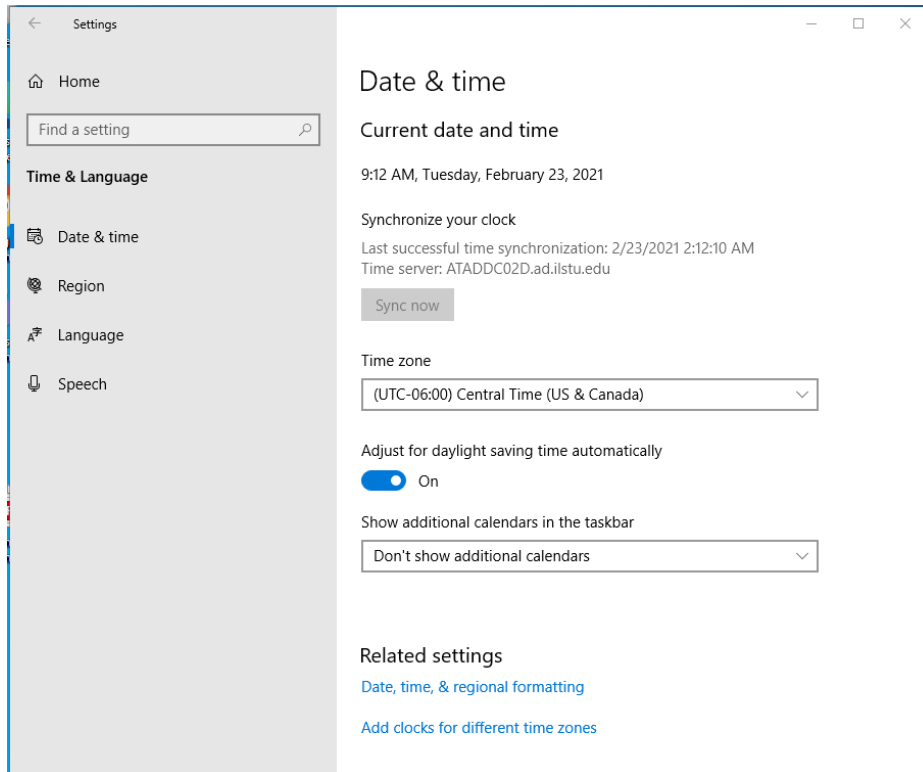

1. Open Settings



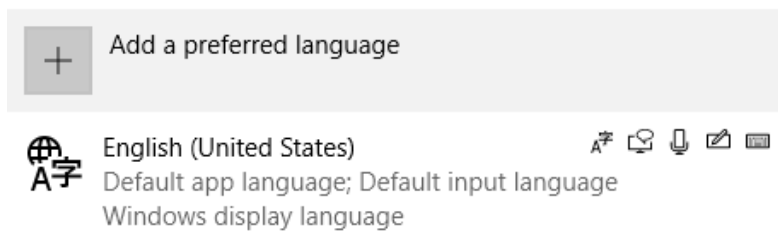
2. Click "Time and Language"



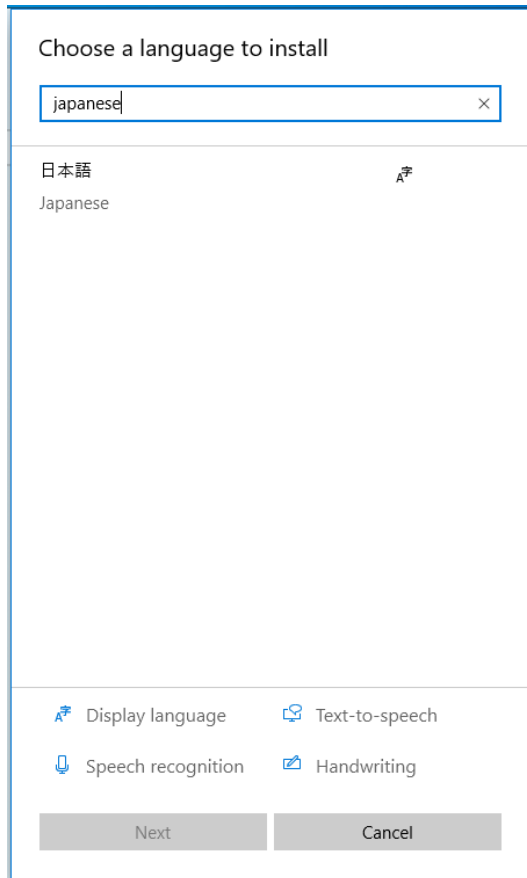
3. Navigate to the “Language” option on the left-hand side
4. Click “Add a preferred language”

Apps and websites will appear in the first language in the list that they support. Select a language and then select Options to configure keyboards and other features.



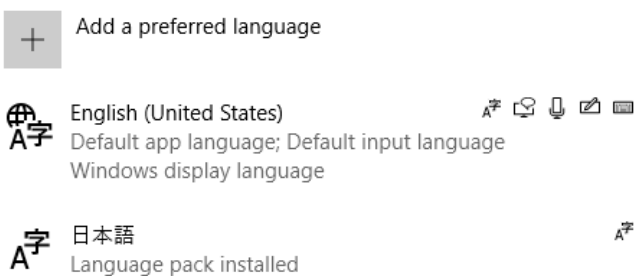
5. Type the language you wish to install

7. Your keyboard should now be installed!

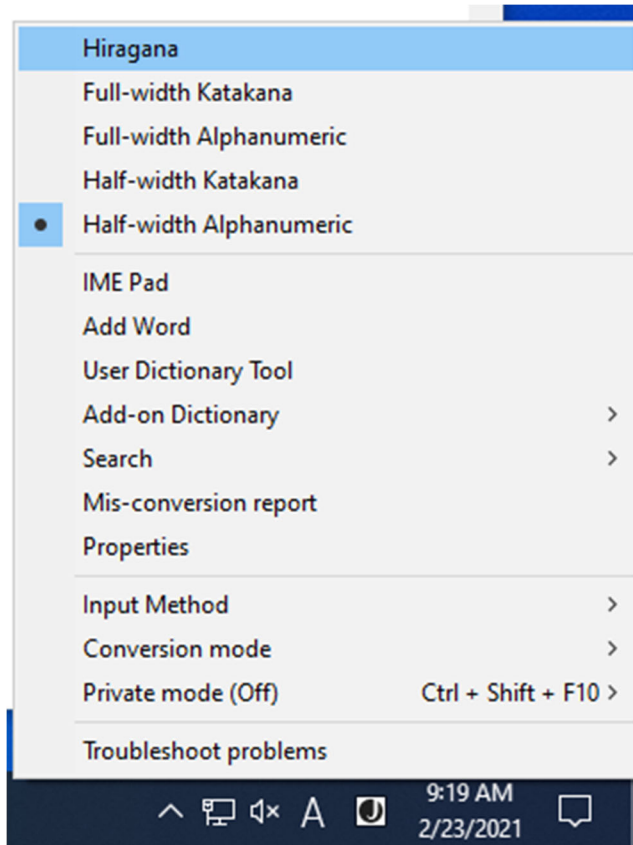

2. Click the Add button , select “Chinese, Traditional,” “Chinese, Simplified,” or “Cantonese, Traditional” (on the left), then select an input source in the list on the right.
3. Click Add.
