






## Little Gestalten's first board book brings toddlers joy. This is our debut for fans aged 0-3.

# In *Great Numbers* introduces children to the fascinating world of numbers and explains how they help us in our daily life.

Imagine a world without numbers. How would we ask for three scoops of ice cream? Or know whether we have 60 minutes left to play with our friends rather than 60 seconds? 
