## 2. Reaction Force:

In general this will encompass three (3) types of activities:

- a. Direct assistance in communicable disease control by the emergency deployment to areas where a health problem has overwhelmed the capacity of the provincial public health staff.
- b. General consultation in problem areas of public health by demonstrating to provincial PH staff the application of simple epidemiological techniques to define the problem adequately and to direct the way toward a reasonable solution.
- c. Short term consultation in specialized areas of sanitation and health aducation. While some assignments may be for straightforward training projects, the team may also be called upon to observe, analyze, and evaluate environmental or human behaviorial components of a particular situation, such as the Sanitary Hamlet.

## 3. Public Wealth Laboratory:

- a. Work to strengthen the utility of the existing hospital laboratory network in the support of local public health activities and demonstrate ways that provincial public health services may benefit by their use.
- b. Add to the definitive understanding of disease occurrence by appropriate specimen sampling in connection with surveillance artivities and making use of reference laboratories as a field extension of provincial and regional laboratories. In this way the full potential of on-the-spot investigations and laboratory centers can be realized.
- c. Enter into the activities of regional health laboratories where specialized ex minations are required to support specific survey projects (e.g., flea sensitivity studies).

## PROJECT AGREEMENT

A. As used herein, the term calle refers to the Agency for International Development, any component agency, or any successor agency. References to athis Project Agreement shall mean the original Project Agreement as modified by any revisions which have entered into offect.

- B. (1) AID will make available the amounts specified in Block 8 of this Project Agreement, as necessary for the project, for use for the designated purposes and as may be further described in Annex A, as required by Block 5 hereof. In addition, as may be further specified in Annex A, AID will, subject to the availability of funds and (where coquired by AID procedures) as provided for in Project Implementation Orders (PIOs) issued by AID in accordance with its procedures, make available funds (a) to pay costs of furnishing technical sarvices to be performed by United States Government employees in connection with the project, (b) to pay a share of the costs of providing training outside the cooperating country in connection with the project for qualified persons from the cooperating country, and (c) to pay such additional costs as may be specified.
- (a) The Cooperating Government Agency will make available the amounts specified in Block 9 of this Project Agreement, as necessary for the project, for use for the designated purposes and as may further be described in Asnex A. The Cooperating Government Agency will also make, or arrange to have made, additional contributions of property, services, facilities and funds required for carrying out the project as may be specified in Annex A, or as may subsequently be agreed upon by the two parties.
- C. AID and the Cooperating Agency may obtain the assistance of other public and private agencies in carrying out their respective obligations under this Project Agreement. The two parties may agree to accept contributions of property. Services, facilities and funds for purposes of this Project Agreement from other public and private agencies, and may agree upon the participation of any such third party in carrying out activities under this Project Agreement.
- D. AID shall not be required to make any contribution after the expiration of six months following the etimated final contribution date (Block 13 of the Project Agreement form AID 1330-1) or any amended final contribution data specified herein. Except as otherwise specified herein or subsequently

agreed by the parties, all contributions of the Cooperating Against pursuant to this Project Agreement shall be unde on or before said estimated termination date, or assended date. A contribution of goods or services while he considered to have been made when the goods or services, provided or financed by the contributing party, are delivered in accordance with commercial practice.

- B. The propagament of commodities and contract services to he financed in whole or in part by AID may (where so required by AID procedures) be undertaken only presuant to PIOs issued by AID in accordance with its procedure.
- P. Unless otherwise specified in the applicable PIO, the procurement of commodities financed with the AID contribution refused to in Block 8 of this Project Assument shall his subject to the provisions of AID Regulation z.
- G. Duiess otherwise specified in the applicable PPO, title to all property procured through financing by AID pursuant to Block 8 (c) of this Project Agreement shall be in the Cooperating Agency, or such public or private agency as it may authorize. This provision is inapplicable to any property which may be used in connection with the project but is not financed pursuant to said Block 8 (c).
- II. Any property Inmished to either party through financing by the other party pursuant to this Project Agreement shall, unless otherwise agreed by the party which financed the procurement, but devoted to the project until completion of the project, and thereafter shall be used so as to further the objectives sought in carrying out the project. Hither party shall offer to return to the other, or to reimburse the other for, any property which it obtains through financing by the other party purtuant to this Project Agreement which is not used in accordance with the preceding sentence.
- I. (1) If AID and any public or private organitation furnishing commodities through AID financing for operations hereunder in the cooperating country, is, under the laws, regulations or administrative procedures of the cooperating country, liable for customs duties and import taxes on commodities imported into the cooperating country for purposes of carrying out this Project Agreement, the Cooperating Agency will pay such duties and taxes unless exemption is otherwise provided by any applicable international agreement.
- (a) If any personnel (other than citizens and residents of the cooperating country), whether United

States Government employees, or employees of sublic or private organizations under contract with, or individuals under contract with, AID, the Cooperating Agency or any agency authorized by the Cooperating Agency, who are present in the cooparating country to provide rervices which AID I'as agreed to furnish or finance under this Project Agreement, are, under the laws, regulations or administrative procedures of the cooperating country, liable for income and social security taxes with respect to income upon which they are obligated to pay income or social security taxes to the Government of the United States of America, for property taxes on personal property intended for their own use, or for the payment of any tariff or duty upon personal or household goods brought into the cooperating country for the personal use of themselves and members of their families (not including such personal or household goods as may be sold by any such personnel in the cooperating country), the Cooperating Agency will pay such taxes, tariff, or duty tipless exemption is otherwise provided by any applicable international agreement.

J. Any personnel (other than citizens and rasidents of the cooperating country), whether United States Government employees, or employees of public or private organizations under contract with or individuals under contract with, AID, the Cooperating Agency or any agency authorized by the Cooperating Agency, who are present in the cooperating country to provide services which AID has agreed to furnish or finance under this Project Agreement shall be subject to the approval of the Cooperating Agency and AID, and shall be under the general direction of the Director of the Mission to the cooperating country.

K. If any commodity is furnished to the Cooperating Agency, or any public or private agency authorized by the Cooperating Agency, on a grant basis through fixancing by AID pursuant to this Project Agreement under arrangements which will result in the accrual of proceeds to the Cooperating Agency or any authorized agency and if the applicable agreement between the two governments referred to on the first page of this Project Agreement does not provide for the establishment of a Special Account and the deposit therein of currency of the cooperating country, the Cooperating Agency will make such arrangements as may be necessary to establish a Special Account and to deposit therein currency of the cooperating country in amounts equal to such proceeds, in accordance with such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon. Funds in the Special Account may be used only as agreed upon by AID and the Cooperating Agency; provided, that such portion of the funds in the Special Account as may be designated by AiD shell be made available to AID to Leet the requirements of the United States,

L. The Cooperating Agency will make such ercangements as may be necessary so that funds introduced into the cooperating country by AID or any public or private agency for purposes of carrying out obligations of AID hereunder shall be convertible into currency of the cooperating country at the highest rate which, at the time the conversion is made, is not unlawful in the cooperating country.

Il. AtD shall expend funds and carry on operations pursuent to this Project Agreement only in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations of the United States Government.

N. The two pirties sight have the right at any time to observe operations carried out under this Project Agreement. Either party during the term of the Project and three years after the completion of the project, shall further have the right (1) to exalmine any property procured through financing by that party under this Project Agreement, wherever tuch property is located, and (2) to inspect and audit any records and accounts with respect to funds provided by, or any properties and contract services procured through financing by, that party under this Project Agreement, wherever such records may be located and maintained. Each party, in arranging for any disposition of any property procured through financing by the other party under this Project Agreement, shall assure that the rights of exemination, inspection and audit described in the preceding sentence are reserved to the party which did the financing.

O. Upon completion of the preject, a Completion Report shall be drawn up, signed by appropriate representatives of AID and the Cooperating Agency, and submitted to AID and the Cooperating Agency. The Completion Report shall include a summary of the actual contributions by both AID and the Cooperating Agency to the project, and shall provide a record of the activities carried out, the objectives achieved, and related basic data. AID and the Cooperating Agency shall each furnish the other with such information as may be needed to determine the nature and scope of operations under this Agreement and to evaluate the effectiveness of such operations.

P. The present Agreement shall enter into force when signed. Either party may terminate this Project Agreement by giving the other party 30 days written notice of intention to terminate it. Termination of this Project Agreement shall terminate any obligations of the two parties to make contributions pursuant to Blocks 8 and 9 of this Project Agreement, except for payments which they are committed to make pursuant to noncancellable commitments entered into with third parties prior to the termination of the Project Agreement. It is expressly understood that the obligations under paragraph H relating to the use of property shall remain in force after such termination,

This project includes a national advisory effort in health education, sanitation, public health nursing, and preventive medicine. The FY 73 malaria PASA was scheduled to phase down during FY 73 and terminate by the end of December 1973, with only one advisor on board from June 30 through December. This arrangement was to allow an overlap with WHO personnel expected to arrive by the end of the calendar year.

AID/W's State 012081 of January 20, however, alerted USAID/Vietnam to the fact that the Department of Health, Education and Welfare planned to terminate all malaria PASA's by the end of FY 73, precluding any possibility of retaining one advisor on board through December 1973. Following receipt of this message, USAID/PH reviewed the malaria activity to determine the best course of action to follow and decided all malaria personnel should stay on board through June 30 (end of FY 73) to orderly and expeditiously phase out PASA malaria activities and phase over to the Vietnamese as many responsibilities as possible to carry on until WHO personnel arrive later in the year.

The funds obligated by this Revision will enable the retention of all the advisors until June 30 and also provide funds for the Federal pay increase effected in January, 1973.

# 2. The United States Government agrees to provide:

Subject to the availability of funds and personnel, the United States Government, through the Agency for International Development, will provide the following:

- a. <u>Personnel</u>: 5 Public Health Physician Direct-Hire Advisors specializing in Public Health, Preventive Medicine, Child Health and Nutrition, Refugee Health and Manpower Development. DH advisors will also be provided in PH nursing and sanitation during FY 74.
- b. Participant Training: Funds for eight new scholarships and six extensions. Of the new scholarship, three will be at the masters level beginning in Sept 74. Of the remaining five, four will be for a 2-month observation of sanitation programs in Taiwan and one will be for a one-month course in Epidemiology in the US. They are scheduled to begin in late Spring.
- c. <u>Commodities</u>: Those required will be provided for under Project 730-11-590-350 at a value of approximately \$58,000 and will be used for rural water, health education and plague control activities.

## G. DESIGNATION

## 1. Government of Vietnam

The Director, Public Health Directorate, MOH, is hereby designated GVN Project Manager. In this capacity, he will be primarily responsible for the program. It is understood and agreed that he will work closely with the US Project Manager and will seek and utilize the latter's technical knowledge, advice and counsel to the maximum degree practicable to obtain project objectives.

The Public Health Branch Chief is hereby designated the US Project Manager. In this capacity, he will act as technical advisor, coordinate
