Gentlemen:

The attached information regarding the captioned matter is submitted in response to your letter dated January 13, 1987 which was received on January 20, 1987. Pursuant to an understanding reached between Mr. Bradley Wise representing PP&L and Ms. Humane Zia representing Region III, the period of time in which to complete submission was extended through February 20, 1987.

The attached material is submitted in response to the inquiries set forth within your letter. Each of the attached folders, as applicable, includes documents in reply to the numbered inquiry of your letter and is marked accordingly. Additional information is included herein in like order.

1. PP&L contracted with Valley Disposal, Inc. during the period September 1975 through 1985, at which time the then current contract was assumed by another company. The contracts provided for the disposal of "trash" and "rubbish"; neither term is defined.

(The principal owner of Valley Disposal, Inc. and the Novak Sanitary Landfill is believed to be Mr. Louis Novak.)

On the basis of available information and recollection, rubbish included utility pole butts, paper goods,

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cafeteria wastes, scrap wood, porcelain (in the form of electrical insulators), various scrap metals, tree limbs, empty oil and paint cans, cleaning rags, oil filters, etc.

During the period from 1975 to 1977 PP&L may have disposed of capacitors at this site. If so, the capacitors originally contained PCBs. However, PP&L has no record of PCBs being disposed of at the Novak Sanitary Landfill because it was the practice of PP&L to drain capacitors prior to disposal. Capacitors which failed due to leaking or rupturing would not have contained PCBs at the time of their disposal; similarly, those which were taken out of service because they had "bulged" were routinely punctured in order to permit them to drain, a practice which normally occurred at PP&L's substation facilities. Accordingly, while PP&L has no records to demonstrate where the drained carcasses may have been shipped for disposal, it is believed all would have been thoroughly drained.

A review of existing records indicates that no hazardous waste had been placed for disposal in any of the containers furnished by Valley Disposal, Inc.

PP&L cannot accurately determine the quantities of the waste materials accepted by Valley Disposal, Inc. during the contract period. However, the contracts themselves provide some basis for the determination of reasonable estimates, as follows:

- 2. A review of existing files indicates that waste materials removed by Valley Disposal, Inc. during the period September 1975 through September 1984 presumably were removed to the Novak Sanitary Landfill. However, PP&L was informed during early 1985 by Valley Disposal, Inc., and subsequently by its successor, Hoch Sanitation Company, that waste materials from PP&L were being transported by them to the Berks Landfill. PP&L has been advised by DER the Novak Sanitary Landfill was officially closed in December 1985.
- 3. It is believed any materials accepted by Valley Disposal, Inc. at PP&L's facilities and disposed of at the Novak Sanitary Landfill were such as would be generated by the normal operations of the facilities described, namely,

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service centers and crew quarters. In further explanation of the description furnished in response to inquiry no. 1, above, it is believed that all wastes in question were solids which were delivered to Valley Disposal, Inc. in the containers, namely, open top and spring loaded lid containers and compactors, provided by it for ultimate landfill purposes.

- 4. PP&L's file search has not disclosed the existence of any correspondence with any regulatory agency regarding substances which may have been landfilled at this site.
- 5. With the exception of various items of correspondence which comprise a portion of the bidding and contract documents furnished in response to inquiry no. 1, PP&L has not been able to locate any other correspondence with any party regarding the material in question.
- 6. Attached are various documents in the form of invoices, pick-up slips, etc. relating to the transportation and disposal of materials described in paragraph 1 in the form issued by Valley Disposal, Inc. and its successor, Hoch Sanitation Company. Similar material for the period 1975 through 1979 is manually retrievable from PP&L's corporate files. However, in view of the expenditure of time and money which would be required, PP&L suggests that EPA accept PP&L's stipulation that it dealt with Valley Disposal, Inc. during this period in accordance with contracts described in paragraph 1, above. However, the stipulation, if accepted, could not be interpreted as an assurance that any such refuse and trash were actually disposed of at the Novak Sanitary Landfill.
- 7. PP&L does not own nor has it previously owned any of the property identified as the Novak Sanitary Landfill site. PP&L does have transmission line easements across the property together with tree trimming rights, both of which are described in agreements included in the attached folder. Real estate map no. 600-476-S8 is also enclosed to indicate the location of the transmission line easement.
- 8. Original materials relating to contracts and invoices submitted herewith are maintained at PP&L's Lehigh Division Service Center, Routes 309 & 22, Allentown, PA 18106, attention: Mr. Charles Braxmeier, Manager-Division Services. Invoices and related material covering the period 1975 through 1979, as described in PP&L's response to

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inquiry no. 6, are maintained at PP&L's General Office, Two North Ninth Street, Allentown, PA 18101, attention: General Accounting Department.

PP&L has excess liability insurance through Associated Electric & Gas Insurance Services, Ltd. for claims based on occurrences during the period 1977 through 1985. PP&L has excess liability insurance through Lloyd's for claims based on occurrences during the period 1975 through 1977. Since PP&L is unaware of any claims or potential claims arising out of the release of substances at the Novak Sanitary Landfill, we cannot determine at this time whether or not such insurance would apply. Therefore, we have not enclosed copies of these policies.

PP&L believes the enclosed material is fully responsive to all of the inquiries made by EPA. I would appreciate if you would acknowledge receipt of this material in the manner provided below and return your executed copy to my attention.

1. Contractor shall at <sup>1ts</sup> own cost and expense furnish and provide all material and labor necessary for the completion, within the time and on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth, of the following described work:

Supply steel containers of various sizes, for the disposal of rubbish, at locations within the Company's Lehigh Division as specified in Company's Bid letter dated August 4, 1975 which is attached hereto and made a part of this contract as Exhibit "A".

l a. For the purpose of the Penna. Sales and Use Tax Law, this contract shall be considered to be a contract for the rendering of a serivce on tangible personal property. Since direct pay permit No. 132 is in effect for the Company, Contractor shall not bill sales or use taxes.

Such work shall be performed and completed in a good, substantial and workmanlike manner in strict conformity with such plans and specifications as may be attached hereto, which when so attached and identified, shall be a part of this contract, and also in strict accordance with the requirements of all municipal, state or federal authorities having jurisdiction in the premises.

2. Time is of the essence of this contract and Contractor shall commence said works within on September 29, 1975

Contractor hereby agrees to indemnify and save harmless Company from and against all liability for injuries and damages to person or property at any time sustained by any person or corporation, including the Company, whatsoever arising out of, resulting from or in any manner caused by or in connection with Contractor's performance of this contract.
- 8. Contractor represents that Contractor is financially responsible and competent to perform the work covered by this contract.
- 9. Upon any violation by Contractor of any of the provisions of this contract, Company may forthwith cancel same and make such other arrangements as it may see fit for the completion of said work without incurring any liability to Contractor except to pay to the latter the fair value to Company of labor already done and materials already furnished.
- 10. This contract shall bind the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the parties, but Contractor shall not assign the same or sub-let the whole or any part of said work without the written consent of Company having been first obtained.
- 11. Contractor represents and warrants that all articles and services covered by this Contract meet or exceed the safety standards established and promulgated under the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Law (Public Law 91-956) and its regulations in effect or proposed as of the date hereof.



# EXECUTIVE ORDER 11246 Part II, Subport B, Sec. 202



During the performance of this contract (Purchase Order) the contractor agrees as follows:

- (1) The contractor will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, creed, color, or national origin. The contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their race, creed, color, or national origin. Such action shall include, but not be limited to the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticesnip. The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the contracting officer setting forth the provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.
- (2) The contractor will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, creed, color, or national origin.
- (3) The contractor will send to each labor union or representative of workers with which he has a collective targaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a notice to be provided by the agency contracting officer, advising the labor union or workers' representative of the contractor's commitments under Section 202 of Executive Order 11245 of September 24, 1965, and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.
- (4) The contractor will comply with all provisions of Executive Order 11246 of September 24, 1965, and of the rules, regulations, and relevant orders of the Secretary of Labor.
- (5) The contractor will furnish all information and reports required by Executive Order 11246 of September 24, 1965, and by the rules, regulations, and orders of the Secretary of Labor, or pursuant thereto, and will permit access to his books, records, and accounts by the contracting agency and the Secretary of Labor for purposes of investigation to ascertain compliance with such rules, regulations, and orders.
- (6) In the event of the contractor's noncompliance with the nondiscrimination clauses of this contract or with any of such rules, regulations, or orders, this contract may be cancelled, terminated or suspended in whole or in part and the contractor may be declared ineligible for further Government contracts in accordance with procedures authorized in Executive Order 11246 of September 24, 1965, and such other sanctions may be imposed and remedies invoked as provided in Executive Order 11246 of September 24, 1965, or by rule, regulation, or order of the Secretary of Labor, or as otherwise provided by law.
- (7) The Contractor will include the provisions of Paragraphs (1) through (7) in every subcontract or purchase order unless exempted by rules, regulations or orders of the Secretary of Labor issued pursuant to Section 204 of Executive Order 11246 of September 24, 1965, so that such provisions will be binding upon each subcontractor or vendor. The contractor will take such action with respect to any subcontract or purchase order as the contracting agency may direct as a means of enforcing such provisions including sanctions for noncompliance: Provided, however, that in the event the contractor becomes involved in, or is treatened with, litigation with a subcontractor or vendor as a result of such direction by the contracting agency, the contractor may respect the United States to enter into such litigation to protect the interests of the United States.

There is one serious feature in the Chain of Title to this property. It will be noticed that Link No. 5, consists of a deed in the name of "Mary Ann Hoffman, Executrix, of John Peters." As set forth in Link No. 4, she conveys it away signing it individually, without the addition of words indicating that she is acting as Executrix. Under Link No. 5, a note has been included, setting forth the chief particulars of the Estate of John Peters, in which we become interested by reason of this peculiar manner of conveyancing. It appears that under John Peters will, all real and personal estate was given to Mary Ann Hoffman for her life. She was further given authority to invest whatever money came to her "on substantial land or Real Estate security." At the termination of her life estate, the property was to be divided among certain children. To this Real Estate it certainly appears that she took in a Executrix. The question then arrises whether she had the power to buy Real Estate outright with moneys of the Estate. The further question than arrises whether after taking title to Real Estate in the name of herself as Executrix, she had the power the convey it away without the order of court, or even with one. It is also a question whether moneys or personal estate can be given to a person for life, directly in the hands of the donee with the intervention of a trustee.

The partition proceeding in the Orphan's Court set forth in Link No. 7 appears to be in proper form, except that there is no formal exceptance filed by Calvin Guth, although there is a formal offer on his part, dated July 3, 1865, of \$138.05 per acre. This defect would be serious if it. were not so far back, and it would seem that a long acquiescence in the transaction by the other parties to the partition proceedings would have quieted their claims, if any there be.

/ It will be noted under the name of Fleiretta Scherer that she gave a mortgage of \$6500, covering this property on March 30, 1922 to John W. Eckert, Subsequently there are judgments against the property, to the Allentown Industrial Loan Co., Dime Savings and Trust Co., Financial Credit Association, Inc. respectively. Then on February 2, 1926, Mr. Eckert issued a Fi Fa on his first mortgage bond, and the property was sold by the Sheriff, December 3, 1926. The Sheriff's deed was executed in favor of Mr. Eckert January 12, 1927, but has not yet been delivered or recorded, because Mr. Eckert has not yet paid any of his costs. This places the title to the property somewhat in a peculiar condition at the present time, in as much as the transactions of the Sheriff has not yet

been entirely completed. The interest of Fleiretta Scherer and of the subsequent judgment holders is therefore not yet entirely divested. As soon as this Sheriff's deed goes on record the lien and all the judgments behind the first mortgage is discharged, but until that time a result is not reached.

John W. Bokert made one Adverse Conveyance, coming out of this property to the Lehigh Valley Transit Company. The description to this appears under his name in the abstract, and should be checked to see that it does not encroach.

A full copy of the Will of John Peters has been annexed and made a part of this abstract.

Mary Ann Hoffman died November 6, 1917, Intestate, see Register of Will's Office File No. 15835. She left one son Francis P. Hoffman, her husband having preceded her in death.

Francis P. Hoffman died June 28, 1922, his will is found in File No. 18094, dated April 5, 1891 and probated July 6, 1922. It contains the following Item; - Item II. The Estate realized through my grandfather John Peter, as shown by the account filed by the executor of my grandfather's estate, and the amount realized from the sale of the real estate of which he died seized and since sold by myself, I direct shall be disposed of in accordance with the directions as contained in the will of John Peter, Deceased.

It therefore follows that if Mary Ann Hoffman bought Real Estate with estate funds as is indicated by her appearance in a deed in a Fiduciary capacity, and conveyed it away without proper authority there is still a claim of title outstanding in the persons entitled under the will of John Peter after the death of his daughter and grandson.


With regard to the partition proceedings, particular to the lack of the former acceptance on the part of Calvin Guth no further evidence of the actual acceptance can be found of record. 




