EVENTS AND PLACES VISITED

Date March 27 1957

Ted

Place

Weather Rain

Left Waltham at 4:30 AM. Chauffeur, eight Sisters and baggage. Reached Hartford at 6:30. Mass., Holy Communion and breakfast. Set out again at 7:30. Arrived at pier 10:15. Found Cabin #166. Mercam K. came to see me off. Boat left promptly at 12M amid waving of hands, shakers & throwing of colored streamers. Stayed on deck till Statue of Liberty was passed. Dinner at 1:00. Spent the afternoon reading telegrams, letters, etc. Trust from students, flowers from Walsh Bros. and Mrs. S. books from Gertrude Curry. Supper 6 PM. Released immediately after.

EVENTS AND PLACES VISITED

Date March 28 Thu.

Place At sea

Weather Cold and damp

Did not awake until 7:30 Mass at 7:30 in auditorium. Made it, though a little late. Breakfast 8

Spent the day on deck wrapped in blankets - prayed and dozed. St. E. J. begged off from supper. Sea very rough. Early to bed. Racked all night.

EVENTS AND PLACES VISITED

Date March 29 Fri.

Place

Weather Damp, cold, windy

Unable to go to Mass. Cold, much worse - weather not helping. Breakfast in bed. St. E. J. also unable to get up.

Dinner in cabins for both. Got up at 4 P.M. and went on deck. At supper birthday cake with one candle for "Sister Gertrude". Orchestra played "Happy Birthday" and all song.

Bed right after supper. Sea very rough. Could hardly stay in bed.

Date March 31
 Place At sea
 Weather Sunny D G

Almost ready to say "never again" to a sea voyage - still very rough waves tremendous, but the sun is glorious and the sea is an expanse of silver. "Hope springs eternal in the human breast" All is bright again. All day on deck. Summer temperature in the afternoon.

Boat rocked terribly all night

Altar nearly fell over during Mass.
 Mass daily at 7:30. My D. new from Harlem

EVENTS AND PLACES VISITED

Date March 31. Sunday
 Place
 Weather Glorious

The first calm day at sea. Mass at 8 o'clock. Gospel and short sermon on "Lactate Sunday". Sun lured us to the outer deck. Sighted the Azores at 10 A.M. All recalled Columbus and his "Sail on". Had tour of the kitchen and first class dining room at 11 A.M. Spent most of the afternoon on sun deck - delightful but quite windy. Toured the last of the Azores, San Miguel from four till six P.M. The island seemed interminable. Supper and a walk on upper deck before retiring.

Elevator boys - one evidently a Porto Rican beams as he says "Good morning Sisters" - the other very serious, told us he knew - we would be glad to know that he has a Sister - "in God's service".

EVENTS AND PLACES VISITED

Date April 1 Mon
 Place At sea - seventh day out
 Weather Warm, sunny - calm sea

The nicest day yet. The sea just slightly rippled sparkling in the sunlight. At eleven we were jostled to the Bridge Deck where two officers explained for us the steering apparatus, radar, fire - locating system, etc.

The ship travels - at the rate of 27 knots an hour or about 29 miles, by automatic steering. However there is a hand steering wheel which can be used in case of necessity. In order not to add to yesterday's punishment I sat on the outer deck with back to the sun. After supper I.S.P. and I went to the very top deck to view the sunset.

EVENTS AND PLACES VISITED

Date April 2 Tues
 Place Nearing Gibraltar
 Weather Sunny and cool.

Sent off a home letter from Algeciras. Morning uneventful but great excitement on board as we neared Spain and North Africa about two o'clock. On the left was (Tarifa), Spain, on the right Tangier, Africa. The former, even from the ship, seemed a real Moorish city. At three o'clock we passed the Rock of Gibraltar which looks just like its picture in the Prudential Life Insurance ads. Beyond it lies Algeciras - at which port the boat stopped to let off passengers. A little woman who has been speaking to me since the first day, a Chech who speaks seven languages came to say "Good-bye" and to wish me good health. Many interesting characters on board - one man going to Italy to wed his girl for whom he has waited 40 yrs until her mother died.

 Weather Sunny and cool

Morning on sun deck. Breezy.
 Wrote a number of cards which I shall mail
 in Genoa. Passed Ibiza the first of
 the Balearic Islands this morning.
 Music over loud-speaker after dinner
 3:20 another fire-drill. Next on
 deck after supper. A beautiful
 sunset and a pale new moon.
 Ship rocked forward and back during
 the night - quite distressing

EVENTS AND PLACES VISITED

Date April 4 Thu
 Place Off the coast of France
 Weather Sunny, breezy

At 7:00 boat stopped at Cannes!
 Even from a distance the place looks
 "fabulous" - hotels, buildings all
 white, some all windows! After
 breakfast on deck again. Passed
 Nice and Monaco. View of Maritime
 Alps, snow-capped and cloud-
 crowned - breath-taking.

Packed bags to be ready for
 departure. All two landed at Genoa. Took
 a Cook's Bus for tour of town. All uphill
 old town, new town - elevators from lower
 to higher town. Visited cemetery - tombs,
 marble slabs, monuments - all designed
 to perpetuate the memory of the departed -
 statue of woman who sold beads (story)
 Returned to boat at 5.

EVENTS AND PLACES VISITED

Date April 5
 Place Cloudy Leaving Naples
 Weather Naples to Rome. Via Paociotto

On deck after breakfast to view
 Lake of Capri, Mt. Vesuvius - Naples.
 Reached port at 10:30. St. Th M and three Ls
 came on board. Took till 2:30 to clear customs.
 Bus took us the six-hour ride to Rome.
 Ate lunch on way. Hwy took us by, through
 and up the Apennines, winding in and out.
 Every inch of land cultivated. Poor homes
 and better stone ones. Mostly pink and yellow.
 Drove along the Appian Hwy and past
 Lake Albano, Aricci Beach etc. Reached
 convent at 8:30. Sisters wanted to greet us.
 Supper, Night Prayer, bed.

EVENTS AND PLACES VISITED

Date April 6
 Place Rome
 Weather

Mass at 6:30. At 8:30 started off in bus.
 First visit - Scala Santa on knees - great privilege.
 Then - St. John Lateran - beautiful mosaics,
 sculpture (Old & New Test.) Ordination going on.
 Visited the Gesù - rooms of St. Ignatius,
 room in which he died. Colosseum visited.
 St. Peter's - thrill of a life-time. Looked
 at everything but saw little. It would take
 years to really know its treasures. Prayed
 at Tomb, touched toe of statue, visited
 side chapels and altars. Special
 interest in tomb of Pius-X.
 St. Mary Major - beautiful. Picture of
 Our Lady said to be painted by St. Luke.
 In P.M. went to Trinita dei Monti - Picture
 of Mater Admirabilis.
 Dropped for religious articles - to bring
 for Lopez's blessing tomorrow.

EVENTS AND PLACES VISITED

Date April 7 Sun
 Place Rome
 Weather Cloudy - Fair

Received tickets for a public audience in St Peter's given to Salesians in honor of centenary of Dominus Savius death 27,000 boys from Salesian schools present with 20,000 others in the basilica. He had excellent seats directly opposite the platform of Our Holy Father. ^{Pius XII} At 12, he entered on the sedia gestatoria and was carried around the altar of the confession. He leaned far over to give his hand to the people, to bless little children held up to him, to bless all. He ran up the steps to the platform and from his chair spoke to the various groups - in Italian, in French, in English, in German, in Spanish blessing us and all our dear ones, praying for our departed. Afterwards he hurried down from the platform and walked from group to group, talking, blessing etc. while cries of *Coram il Papa* rent the air. It was a never-to-be-forgotten morning. I had seen Christ's Vicar and all the dear ones I carried in my heart were blessed by him.

Sang Mass of Blessed Mother Julia. At nine off in bus to Catacombs of St Callistus. Guide led us through and explained symbols. Christians did not live in catacombs but buried their dead there and came to visit graves.

St Paul Outside the Walls is a magnificent basilica. Ceilings are beautiful. On walls pictures (in color) of all the Popes (262) including Pope Pius XII. Benedictines in charge. Visited cloistral garden - prayed at tomb of St Paul in basilica. Architecture Romanesque.

Church of St Cecilia - home of the Saint. Visited her room and her oratory. Resembles a palace much more than a church. Prayed at her tomb.

Stayed home this P.M. Made a tour of the house.

Weather Rain, sun, rain, cloudy

This morning we visited the Church of Our Lady of Perpetual Help and met Father Gondreau, the General. From there we went to the Church of Santa Suzanna. A Paulist Father whom the Sr from California knew, took us through the church and two stories under, where we saw the ruins of the Santi home - 3d Century. After stop at the Regina Mundi College and then a visit to the Jesuit Generalate where we were cordially received by Fr. Vincent McCormack. Met Fr. Lannon & Fr. Dolan, former Provincial & A.B.C. In P.M. under wing of Bro. Kalk went through Justice Chapel, Nat. Society, Refs. Room, Audience Rooms, Pope's Garden - a three-hour tour.

Twisted ankle in morning. Very painful after tour of afternoon.

Early start after Mass and breakfast for Colli. At 10:15 reached Monte Cassino. Bus wound round and round, up and up. Brother showed us around New buildings magnificent - church being restored - to be just like old one - marble, gold, sculpture, etc. Prayed at shrine of St Benedict and St Scholasticus. On to Colli which we reached at 1:40. Entertained by Kindergarten children. School, convent, children - poorest of the poor. United Church (improvements) & public school classroom (awful). Narrow stone streets, mules, hens etc. close to house. No water - girl carried water from fountain - kept in a tub - & used for day. Electric rods to heat water for baths. We had a delicious dinner, another entertainment by older children ("When you're Young") etc. Left at 5. Home 9.

7:00 Great privilege of Mass and Holy Communion in room where St. Ignatius died. Fr. McCormack said Mass and afterwards told us about the house. Present house of planks built around original home of saint. At 9:30 started off again to pay a visit to our Cardinal Protector, Card. Trecora. Very gracious - spoke in francis, blessed us & promised prayers for Chapter. Then we visited our cousins at their Mother House - a beautiful place! Chapel lovely, garden with its shrine of Marie Julie, a thing of beauty. Sisters - most hospitable. So go there for their 6mo tertianship just before final vows - special house with sleeping room & lecture room - quarters for priest for retreat. Afternoon spent sending post. cards.

Began the day at 5:30 A.M. when train stopped at Miam. Ate breakfast from box provided by our Roman Sisters. Ride through Switzerland was magnificent. and ciborium - cellar chapel - Our Lady of Refuge - corridor
Had dinner here and saw grounds & Bending garden. Slid
back at 2:30 Reached Junet at 4. Novas 4 Post. 5
Beautiful chapel - gold ^{traces of} altar with statues of saints. Saw
B.M.J.'s well & place in wall where gate used to be.
Large house - no school - kindergarden, few novices,
numbers of old Sisters. Saw 2 of Resurrection Sr's. Home
in time for supper.

 Weather

Off to an early start Ride north, beautiful country. In Flanders all signs in French: Flemish. Tulips everywhere. Bokkuden at 11. Had 10 o'clock and visited garden - lovely, quiet spot. Five healthy, happy postulants. Did not stay long as we were expected in Berchem for dinner. Reached B. at 12:10. Very fine dinner and then saw the place. Most beautiful and flourishing of all the Belgian houses. All in neat - classes from pre-primary through Normal School. Fr. Teresia de SC Sup. newly-elected Gen. Treas. showed us house and grounds. The chapel is beautiful - most unusual - sanctuary floor marble; altar gray marble with silver tabernacle, etc. white metal rail; panels in ceiling S. S. & N. G. Stations gray stone, benches with seats that close when we stand. Saw children perform in gym. Home for puppets

Stayed home this morning. Began to pack. At one, bus came to take us to Beauvaing - route south-west along the Meuse, through Dinant. Near B. we were able to look across into France. Shrine at Beauvaing right off the start. Very devotional - altar + statue, encircled by iron rail, benches in open. In chapel, assisted at Benediction with a group of German pilgrims. From there went to Maredsous. Saw only the chapel which is in process of being enlarged and redecorated. Went to Maredret also - abbey of ruins. Bought holy cards - after our visit to the chapel

May 12. Sunday - Home
 Last day in Namur. Visited garden chapel for last time. Visit with Ma Mère.

English countryside delightful - sheep & lambs everywhere - homes, barns, neat with curtains drawn aside. Could see interior from the bus. Signs quaint, some cottages - old style, also shops, inns etc. Sun came up just before time to set - rose & gray sunset - gorgeous & full moon. 8:40 before it got dark. Reached A. at 9:30. Had lunch & retired to our rooms. Every comfort even a hot-water bottle between the sheets.

This is the most beautiful N.D. convent in the world. The grounds are magnificent with trees of every variety, rhododendron bushes as large as trees, velvet lawns, formal gardens with flowers of every hue. "The birds make music all the day." Infant Jesus garden a thing of beauty - little pond bordered with azaleas, white, pink, salmon, rose, etc. Cemetery - large crucifixes forget-me-nots covering each grave. Visited farm. Cows stalls marked with their names - Bullerup, Kathleen, etc. Baby calf one week old - two others Snow White & Premou a little older. House - original part in center - novitiate wing, Chapel and visitors' wing added. Chapel is like a church. Marble altar green onyx tab with gold door. Two transepts with altars. Memorial in back to St. M de St. Anges. Carved altar from her home - scenes of Passion - her tomb. Bl. Ed. Campion's said Mass on that altar.
