

**ROUND 4 INTERVIEW**

**LANTO GRIFFIN (-8)**

**Q. Lanto, how would you assess the day as a whole?**

**LANTO GRIFFIN:** I didn't hit it as good as I did yesterday and it was a grind. I got off to a bad start again, 2 over through six holes and -- or seven holes. I just didn't take advantage of the easy holes again. I rallied nice and shot 2 under on the back nine and so I'm happy with that, but kind of shot myself out of it early.

**Q. You keep putting yourself in great positions in big events on big golf courses. What does that say about where you feel like your game has been the last six, seven, eight months?**

**LANTO GRIFFIN:** I feel like mentally I can play hard golf courses. I like when par is a good score and I like long, hard golf courses, so it's fun for me. It's always a battle, you make a bogey and you make a birdie, you're kind of ahead of the curve, where on an easy golf course, you make a bogey, you've got to make two birdies. I think just mentally I like maybe the U.S. Open style golf courses more than the -- like last week where if you're five yards off, it could be a re-tee and out here you have a little bit of room to be creative. Just fits my eye better than some other golf courses.

**Q. Were you able to see the video of Patrick Reed's situation on 10 yesterday?**

**LANTO GRIFFIN:** I did.

**Q. And just your overall thoughts on that?**

**LANTO GRIFFIN:** I mean, it's tough. Golf's a game of sportsmanship and it's tough to put us in the spot to call him out because we weren't there, but at the end of the day I think 99 percent of the golfers out here, if it's in question one way or the other, they're going to go the other way, not taking a drop, it didn't cross, that type of deal.

So it's tough to see, it's sad, kind of pisses us off, but it's the way it is. Hopefully something changes and come to a conclusion.

**Q. If you were in the same situation, how would you have handled that?**

**LANTO GRIFFIN:** I think the rule is if you're in doubt on something that's going to give you an advantage and it's not 100 percent, you know, then you kind of go the other way. But I wasn't there, I didn't see it, so it's hard for me to really judge, but I don't know.
