I'm pleased to introduce you our dRural project, a project aiming to exploit the benefits offered by digitalization to spur, development and wellbeing in rural areas. They represent around 20% of the population and recording lower incomes and fewer opportunities for people and businesses compared to urban zones.

dRural aims to co-develop and roll up a digital service marketplace that delivers valuable services to rural citizens while creating opportunities economic growth and quality of life improvement. The ambition of dRural is to become the service marketplace of reference for European rural areas.

The marketplace will be tested in 4 EU regions: Extremadura, in Spain; Gelderland Midden, in the Netherlands; Dubrovnik-Neretva, in Croatia; and in Jämtland Härjedalen, in Sweden. We will also look at other regions to replicate our model.

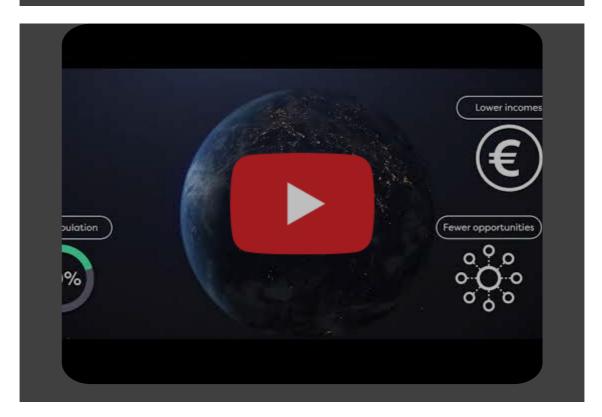
With dRural, a digital dawn will rise over rural communities in Europe.

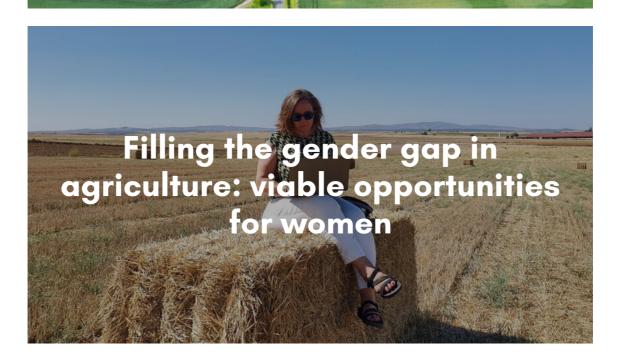
