For a time, money was just about as tight Oason and in Lext. as the conditions that gave rise to the panic and its consequent as the conditions that gave rise to the panic and its consequent America, the countries on the other side of the Atlantic recovered their com-
mercial equillbrium much more quickly than we dld over here. Stll, there is left some reason for wondering why the Paris theatrical season went ahead of previous years. From the grand opera to the llttle Grand Guiginol, where over every other season since the Exposition. And this gives rise to the to the result in Paris. As soon as industrial condlitons became bad over here there was an exodus of wealthy and money-spending Amerlcans to the French capital. They were essentially theatre-goers and patrons of the opera. Theing advantage of dull times in the Unlted States they went to Europe with pleasing holiday. They have now returned, or are returning, and it ls quite
probable that the coming theatrical season in the United States will be as much better than the recently preceding ones, as was the past Paris season Everyone of experlence in the amusement field; everyone whose authorlty
in forecasting conditions is recognized, is making statements to the effect that, with the moving of this year's crops, our industrial status will soon be in its pristine prosperity and there will be an end to hard times. The crops
are good. In fact, the prospect for the farmer has not been better in many seasons than lt is this year. The unsanguine reports that emanate from isolated sections are not to be taken into account as having any bearing on the west are not ruined, or the grain fields in Kansas and Missouri are not inundated by floods, or the tobacco is not eaten up by bugs or something of that
sort. But these conditlons are essentially local. If they were general it would be more serious. Thls year the prospect for the crops being generally good. is extremely briliant. Wessarily destructlve of all hopes even for a bountlful crop in that sectlon, Everywhere else, condltlons are excellent, and just as soon as the
crops are on the move, the factories will open and the many thousands of people who have been idle wlll be re-employed. During the perlod of thelr
idleness they have been foregolng amusements. Luxuries were necessarily elimlnated, and wlth the salaried classes amusements stand at the head of people will be avid for the entertainment afforded them at the theatre. They will flock to the play and to the musical comedy with a hunger for it that they have not felt when conditions were normal, and they could go whenfor a doubt that our next theatrical season will rank in relative proportion to
those that have recently preceded it about the same as the last paris season compared with lts predecessors.

The rapid growth of the film business in the ligger cities of America gives birth to speculation as to whether it will not in the near future become
