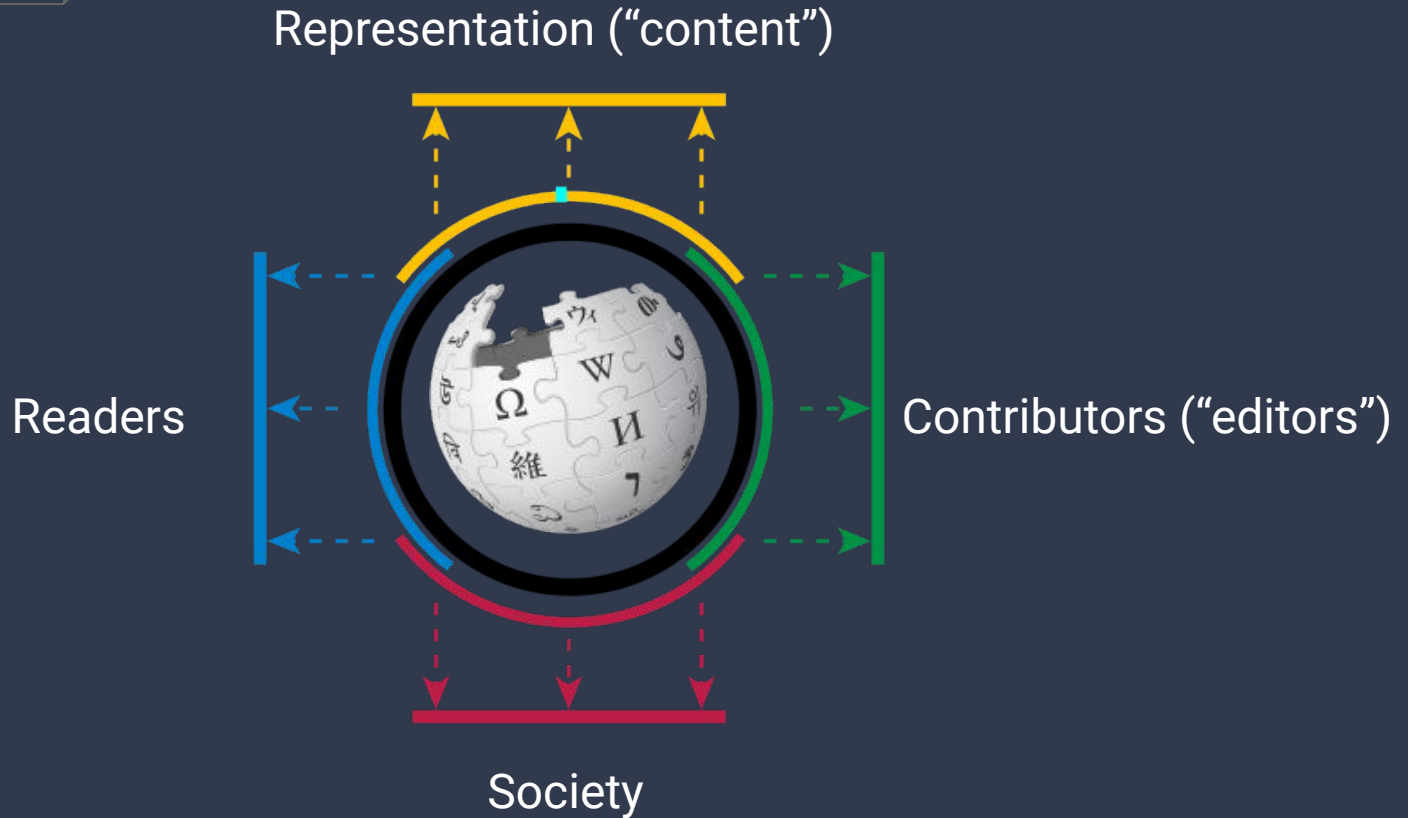

Readers



Reader survey

- March 2019, English Wikipedia, small-scale pilot of the WMF survey
- Survey respondents skewed heavily young and male.
 - 70% of respondents were under the age of 30.
 - 76% identified as male.

Contributors (“editors”)



- “... 77 percent of Wikipedia articles are written by just one percent of Wikipedia editors...” (Daniel Oberhaus, "Motherboard, Tech by Vice", 7 Nov 2017)
- “Just 3,541 Wikipedia editors are considered ‘very active’, and very few of them are female.” (“New Statesman”, 8 Jan 2019)

Women's biographies

“First Women, Second Sex”, by Graells-Garrido, Lalmas, and Menczer in 2015 (<https://dl.acm.org/doi/10.1145/2700171.2791036>):

Differences in meta-data are similar to results noted in previous work, where women biographies contain more marriage-related events than men’s. Sex-related content is more frequent in women biographies than men’s, while cognition-related content is more frequent in men biographies than women’s. A strong bias in the linking patterns results in a network structure in which articles about men are disproportionately more central than articles about women.

Internal comparison	There are more biographies of men than women on English Wikipedia (Klein et al. 2016)	Biographies of women scientists are lower quality, on average, than Wikipedia articles as a whole (Halfaker 2017)	The lead sections of biographies of women use terms like “divorce”, “family” and “spouse” more than biographies of men (Wagner et al. 2016)
External comparison	Women scholars with high h-index are less likely to have Wikipedia articles compared to men scholars with comparable h-index (Schellekens et al. 2019)	Wikipedia biographies of notable men and women are both longer and more equal in length, on average, than biographies of those same people in <i>Encyclopedia Britannica</i> . (Reagle and Rhou 2011)*	Articles about professions on German Wikipedia are substantially more likely to include pictures of men than women, regardless of the relative proportion of men and women in that profession according to labor statistics. (Zagovora et al. 2017)
Reader needs	<i>Hypothetical: Wikipedia articles are less likely to show up in the first page of results of Google searches by women vs. searches by men.</i>	Top hits from Wikipedia’s internal search for topic keywords related to women’s interest (sourced from a magazine corpus) were more likely to be redirects than keywords sourced from mens’ magazines (Menking et al. 2017)	<i>Hypothetical: Women seeking health information on Wikipedia are less satisfied with the way medical information is presented than are men seeking health information on Wikipedia.</i>

Welcome to **Women in Red** (WiR)! We are a group of editors of all genders living around the world focused on improving content systemic bias in the wiki movement. We recognized a need for this work as, in October 2014, only 15.53% of English Wikipedia's biographies were about women.^[1] Founded in July 2015, WiR strives to increase the percentage, which has reached **18.34%** as of 8 April 2020. But that means, according to [WHGI](#), only 311,862 of our 1,700,506 biographies are about women. Not impressed? "**Content gender gap**" is a form of **systemic bias**, and WiR addresses it in a positive way through **shared values**.

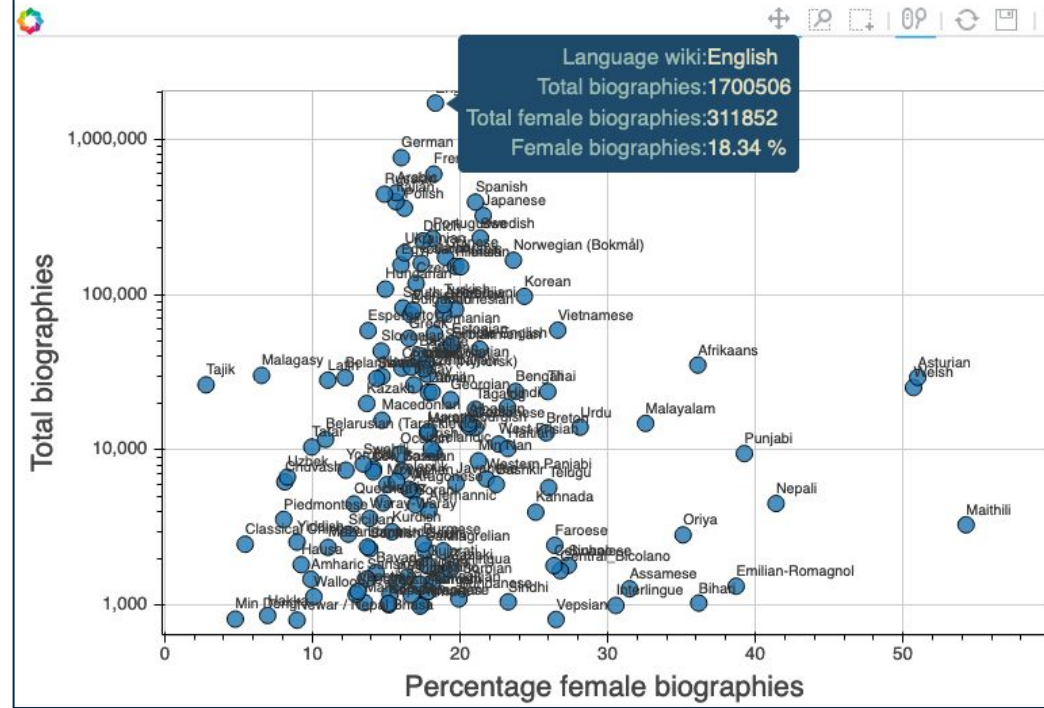
