303(d) List Consideration: The receiving stream is not listed on the 303(d) list. Therefore no permit action is needed.

Endangered Species Consideration: No comments on the application were received from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USF&WS). The draft permit and Statement of Basis will be sent to the USF&WS for their review.

Type of treatment: stabilization pond, rock reed filter, intermittent sand filter, chlorination, and post aeration.

Sludge Condition: Sludge will remain in the stabilization pond.

Activity Under the standard industrial classification (SIC) code 4952, the applicant's activities are the operation of a municipal treatment plant.

Changes: Changes from the previously issued permit listed below. Permittee is responsible for reading this permit in detail carefully and becoming familiar with all the changes even they are not listed below.

1. The receiving stream description has been corrected. 2. The facility and the outfall latitudes have been corrected.

3. Parts II, III, and IV have been modified.

4. The pH limits have been changed to 6.0 - 9.0 s.u. to ensure the required accuracy in reporting.

5. The ammonia limits for the months of November - April have been modified based upon the toxicity criteria contained in Section 2.512 of Regulation 2.

6. The D.O. limit is now expressed as a monthly average.

7. The description of the facility location has been modified.

Public Notice

In accordance with APCEC Regulation 8 the public notice will be published by ADEQ in a newspaper of general circulation on or before July 14, 2006 for one (1) day only. Comments must be received at ADEQ prior to the close of the public comment period August 14, 2006. The public comment period will begin on the date of publication and will end no sooner than 30 days from that date.

A draft permit and draft public notice will be sent to the District Engineer, Corps of Engineers, and to the Regional Director of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service on a case-by-case basis, and the EPA and Arkansas Department of Health prior to the publication of that notice.

Issuance of the final permit: The permit will become effective on or after September 1, 2006 unless:

Comments are received and/or public hearing is requested prior to August 13, 2006, in which case the permit will be effective on or after October 1, 2006.

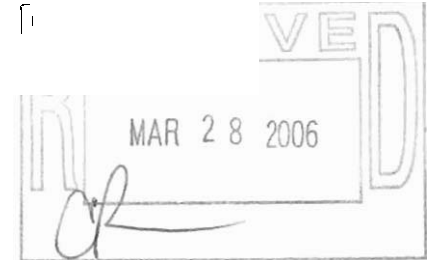


