Holt was proud to have these students as visitors and hopes they took pleasant memories back with them.





Buildings and Grounds Keeps the School Clean





Officers this year were Don Cragun, Gordon Smith, Connie Roberts, and Franka Ballard. Mrs. Steinfatt was the advisor.






Key Club Conducts Annual Christmas Drive

Holt Forms First Literary Club


