	ember <u>Burgess</u> introduced the following order, a summary of which had been ouncilmember, which was read by title:

BOND ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000,000 WATER AND SEWER SYSTEM REVENUE BONDS OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte, North Carolina (the "City") is authorized by The State and Local Government Revenue Bond Act, General Statutes of North Carolina, Section 159-80 et seq. (the "Act") to issue, subject to the approval of the Local Government Commission of North Carolina (the "LGC"), at one time or from time to time, revenue bonds and revenue refunding bonds of the City for the purposes as specified in the Act; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously issued under the terms of the General Trust Indenture dated as of November 1, 1996 between the City and First Union National Bank of North Carolina, the successor to which is First Union National Bank, as trustee, (the "Trustee"), as amended by Series Indenture, Number 2 dated as of August 15, 1999 between the Issuer and the Trustee (the "General Indenture"), its Water and Sewer System Revenue Bonds in the aggregate principal amount of \$215,375,000, of which \$213,275,000 remains outstanding;

WHEREAS, the City has further determined to issue its Water and Sewer System Revenue Bonds, Series 2001 (the "2001 Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$150,000,000 to provide funds to finance the capital costs of improvements to the water and sanitary sewer systems of the City (the "Water and Sewer System"), including, but not limited to, the extension of existing water and sewer lines and rehabilitation or replacement of others; construction of new water and sewer mains and outfalls; rehabilitation and upgrades of water and wastewater treatment plants; and acquisition of land for the Water and Sewer System;

WHEREAS, the City will issue the 2001 Bonds under the General Indenture and Series Indenture, Number 4 dated as of May 15, 2001 (the "Series Indenture") between the City and the Trustee; and

WHEREAS, the City and the LGC have arranged for the sale of the 2001 Bonds to Banc of America Securities LLC, First Union National Bank, Scott & Stringfellow Inc., trading as BB&T Capital Markets, and Salomon Smith Barney Inc. (the "Underwriters") under the terms of a Bond Purchase Agreement to be dated on or about May 24, 2001 (the "Purchase Contract"); and

WHEREAS, an application has been filed with the Secretary of the LGC requesting LGC approval of the 2001 Bonds as required by the Act, and the Secretary has notified the City Council (the "City Council") of the City that the application has been approved by the LGC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, as follows:

Section 1. In order to raise the money required to finance the capital costs of improvements to the Water and Sewer System, including, but not limited to, the extension of existing water and sewer lines and rehabilitation or replacement of others; construction of new water and sewer mains and outfalls; rehabilitation and upgrades of water and wastewater treatment plants; and acquisition of land for the Water and Sewer System, in addition to any funds which may be made available for such purpose from any other source, the 2001 Bonds are hereby authorized and shall be issued pursuant to the Act.

Section 2. The aggregate principal amount of the 2001 Bonds authorized by this order shall not exceed \$150,000,000. The 2001 Bonds hereby authorized shall be special obligations of the City, secured by and paid solely from the proceeds thereof or from revenues, income, receipts and other money received or accrued by or on behalf of the City from or in connection with the operation of the City's Water and Sewer System.

Section 3. The issuance of the 2001 Bonds by the City, in substantially the form to be set forth in the Series Indenture, be and the same hereby is in all respects approved and confirmed. The form and content of the 2001 Bonds and the provisions of the Series Indenture with respect to the 2001 Bonds (including without limitation the maturity dates and rates of interest) shall be approved and confirmed in a subsequent resolution of the City Council.

The principal of, premium, if any, and interest on the 2001 Bonds shall not be payable from the general funds of the City, nor shall they constitute a legal or equitable pledge, charge, lien or encumbrance upon any of its property or upon any of its income, receipts or revenues except the funds which are pledged under the Indentures. Neither the credit nor the taxing power of the State of North Carolina or the City are pledged for the payment of the principal of, premium, if any, or interest on the 2001 Bonds, and no holder of the 2001 Bonds has the right to compel the exercise of the taxing power by the State of North Carolina or the City or the forfeiture of any of its property in connection with any default thereon.

Section 4. The 2001 Bonds shall be sold to the Underwriters under the terms of the Purchase Contract as the same shall be approved in a subsequent resolution of the City Council.

Section 5. The proceeds from the sale of the 2001 Bonds shall be deposited in accordance with the Series Indenture.

Section 6. If any one or more of the agreements or provisions herein contained shall be held contrary to any express provision of law or contrary to the policy of express law, though not expressly prohibited, or against public policy, or shall for any reason whatsoever be held invalid, then such covenants, agreements

WHEREAS, the City will issue the 2001 Bonds under the General Indenture and Series Indenture, Number 4 dated as of May 15, 2001 (the "Series Indenture") between the City and the Trustee;

WHEREAS, the City desires to execute and deliver a Bond Purchase Agreement dated May 24, 2001 (the "Purchase Contract") among the City, the Local Government Commission of North Carolina (the "Commission") and Banc of America Securities LLC, First Union National Bank, Scott & Stringfellow Inc., trading as BB&T Capital Markets, and Salomon Smith Barney Inc. (the "Underwriters"), pursuant to which the City and the Commission will sell the 2001 Bonds to the Underwriters in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, copies of the forms of the following documents relating to the transactions described above have been filed with the City:

- 1. the Series Indenture;
- 2. the Purchase Contract;
- the Preliminary Official Statement to be dated on or about May 15, 2001 (the "Preliminary Official Statement") with respect to the 2001 Bonds;

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

The Trustee is hereby appointed as Registrar and Paying Agent thereunder.
- Section 3. That the 2001 Bonds shall be sold to the Underwriters pursuant to the terms of the Purchase Contract. The form and content of each of the Purchase Contract is in all respect approved and confirmed, and the Mayor, the City Manager or the Director of Finance of the City, or their respective designees, are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute and deliver each of the Purchase Contract for and on behalf of the City, including necessary counterparts, in substantially the form and content presented to the City, but with such changes, modifications, additions or deletions therein as shall to him or her seem necessary, desirable or appropriate, his execution thereof to constitute conclusive evidence of his or her approval of any and all such changes, modifications, additions or deletions therein, and that from and after the execution and delivery of the Purchase Contract, the Mayor, the City Manager and the Director of Finance of the City, or their respective designees, are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to do all such acts and things and to execute all such documents as may be necessary to carry out and comply with the provisions of the Purchase Contract as executed.
- Section 4. The form and content of the Preliminary Official Statement are in all respects authorized, approved and confirmed, and the use of the Preliminary Official Statement and the Official Statement to be dated on or about May 24, 2001 (the "Official Statement") by the Underwriters in connection with the sale of the 2001 Bonds is hereby in all respects authorized, approved and confirmed. The Mayor, the City Manager or Director of Finance of the City is authorized to execute the Official Statement on behalf of the City.

WHEREAS, Mecklenburg County has the authority pursuant to N.C.G.S. §153A-136 to require participation in a recycling program by requiring separation of designated materials by the owner or occupant of improved property prior to disposal; and

WHEREAS, the municipalities in North Carolina have been granted the authority by N.C.G.S. §160A-317 to require participation in a recycling program by requiring separation of designated materials by the owner or occupant of improved property prior to disposal; and

WHEREAS, N.C.G.S. §153A-122 authorizes municipalities by resolution to permit County ordinances to be enforced within the municipality's corporate limits; now therefore be it
