OBHUNT

Standby Agent Report for Period 1-31 May 1956

REFERENCE: SGAA-20568, 10 May 1956

Action Requested: None; for information and files.

1. There are seven OBHUNT standby agents.
2. RNDOLLAR was rushed to the hospital on 22 May and the following day had an appendectomy performed. He was released on 29 May and is making a satisfactory recovery. Arrangements have been made for U.S.E.P. to pay the expenses of the operation and hospitalization. RNDOLLAR is on their priority list and is presently processing for emigration to the United States.
3. AIRWISE was contacted several times by [] and [] during this past month. He assisted in the handling of the details for RNDOLLAR'S operation and hospitalization and served as our contact for RNDOLLAR during this time. He was last met on 31 May when he was passed his and RNDOLLAR'S pay.
- * 4. AILICH returned to Khalkis after AIPUMP departed for the United States. He was instructed to return to Athens with all his personal effects and is now sharing quarters with AICCOOL and AIRBLOWN in Pireaus. AILICH is also registered with U.S.E.P. and is processing for resettlement in the United States.
5. AIRBLOWN and AICCOOL have moved from their hotel and now have quarters in a private home in Pireaus, which they share with AILICH. Both men are attending the advanced course at the Benchfitters School. They were met by [] regularly during the last month and were last seen on 29 May when they were paid.
6. RNORDAIN and AIRBORNE are living in private quarters in Agaleo, a small suburb of Athens. They telephone this office at regular intervals and are met at the "Jailhouse" by [] and [] They were met and paid on 29 May.
7. All of our present roster of standby agents are registered with the necessary organizations to permit their emigration. They are in various degrees of processing and others such as AIRWISE, RNORDAIN and AIRBORNE are in a "hold" category at our request. Further processing of these men is suspended until such time as we request that it proceed.
