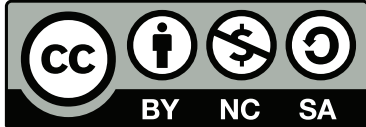

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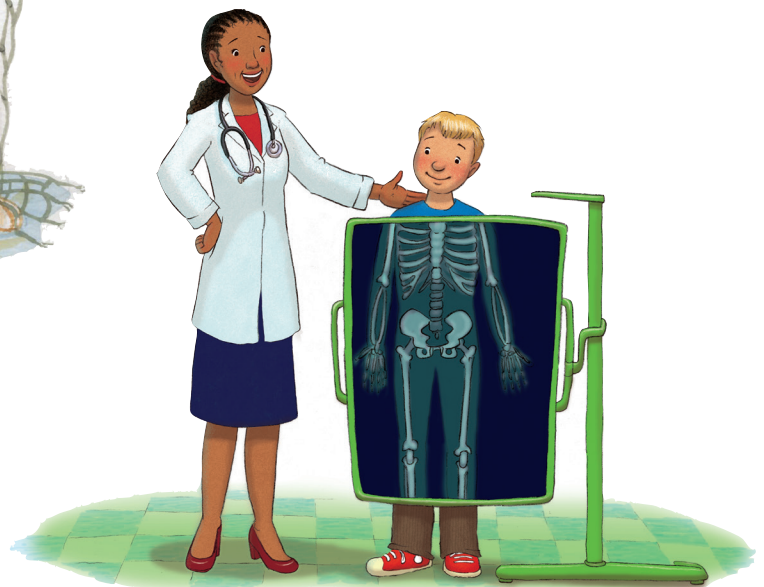
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About CKLA

Core Knowledge Language Arts (CKLA) is a comprehensive, preschool through fifth grade program for teaching reading, writing, listening, and speaking while also building students' vocabulary and knowledge across essential domains in literature, global and American history, and the sciences. In the early grades, CKLA focuses on oral language development through carefully sequenced read-alouds as well as systematic instruction in reading and writing skills. In later grades, CKLA continues to advance students' knowledge and vocabulary through read-alouds and in-depth discussions while also immersing students in complex texts and advanced writing assignments that draw on the academic content in which they have been engaged in since preschool.

Introduction

CKLA Preschool is a comprehensive English language arts curriculum designed to give four- and five-year olds foundational language and literacy skills. Engaging, accessible plans are provided for infusing 45 minutes of daily instruction into activities that are common in high-quality preschool classrooms. For example, guidance is given for conducting activities during morning circle, learning centers, small groups, whole group, book readings, and transition times (i.e., when students move between activities).

Including regular lessons and Pausing Points designed for review and enhancement, CKLA Preschool offers instructional plans for approximately 115 days of the school year.

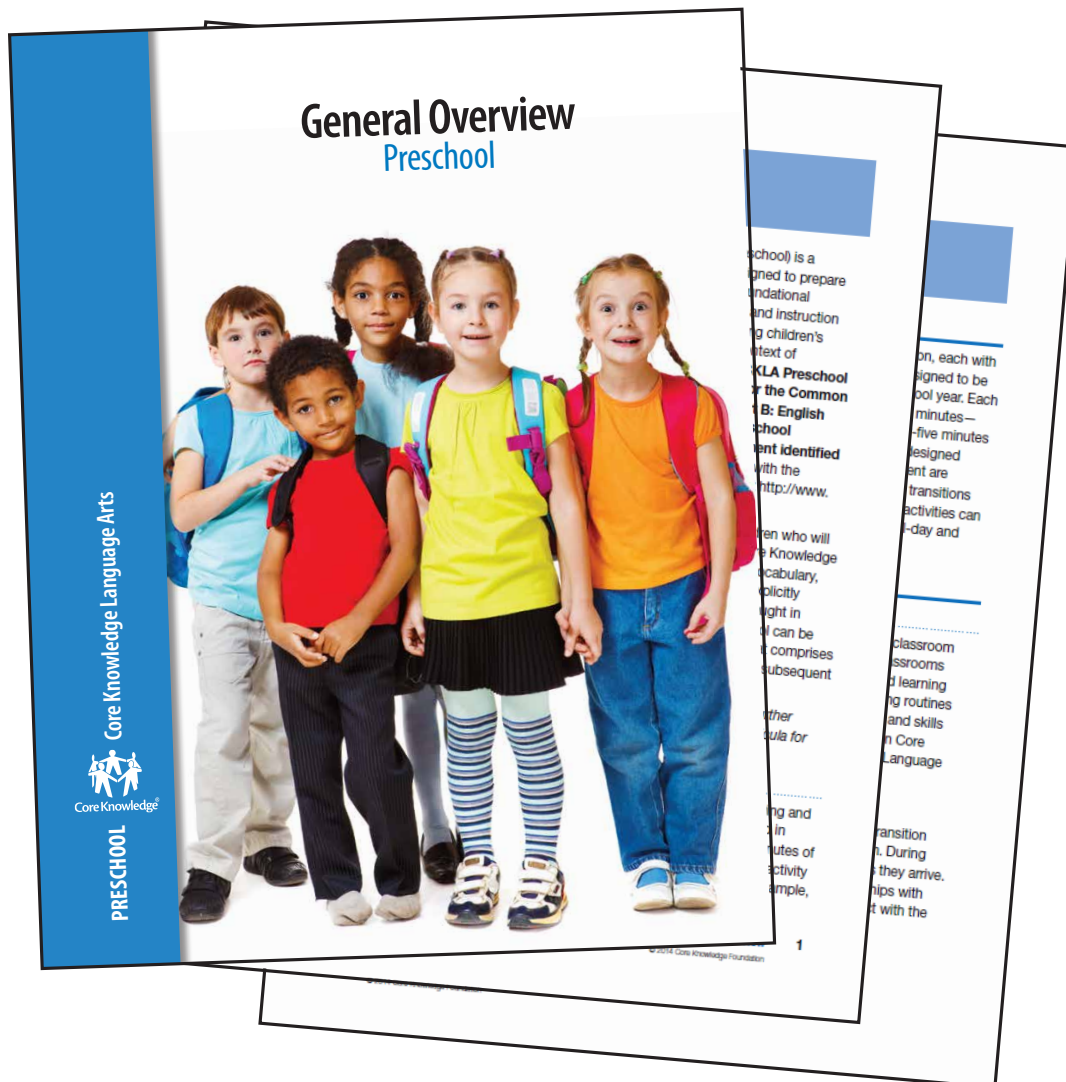
Plan Your PreK Implementation

CKLA Skills Grades K-3

Introduction

CKLA K-3* is comprised of two strands—a Skills strand and a Listening & Learning strand—so that children can master sounds and letters for fluent decoding and encoding during one part of the day and then have additional time to build the knowledge, language, and vocabulary that are essential for strong comprehension.

CKLA K–3 is based on decades of cognitive science research revealing that reading is a two-lock box, a box that requires two keys to open. The first key is decoding skills, which are addressed in CKLA’s Skills strand.

The second key is oral language, vocabulary, and background knowledge sufficient to understand what is decoded. These are covered in the Listening & Learning strand. Together, the two strands of CKLA unlock a lifetime of reading for all children.

CKLA K-3* is comprised of two strands—a Skills strand and a Listening & Learning strand—so that children can master sounds and letters for fluent decoding and encoding during one part of the day and then have additional time to build the knowledge, language, and vocabulary that are essential for strong comprehension.

*In the Amplify (purchased) version of CKLA, the two strands of grade 3 are integrated into one teacher guide and lesson plan.

Decoding is essential, but so is the ability to comprehend what has been decoded—and that depends on language and content knowledge. This strand builds on the research finding that students’ listening comprehension outpaces their reading comprehension throughout elementary school.

The Listening & Learning strand lessons are comprised of teacher read-alouds, class discussions, vocabulary work, and extension activities. These exercises are organized in 11–12 domains per grade. Each domain is dedicated to a particular topic such as the five senses, Native Americans, early Asian civilizations, or insects.

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Presenting the Read-Aloud

10 minutes

It is well documented that the language in written text is far more complex than that typically used in conversational speech, even among adults. Read-alouds provide opportunity to expose young children to this complex language.

The Sense of Sight

← Show image 2A-1: Boy leaping onto a rock¹

Have you ever heard people say, “Look before you leap”? They are warning you to be careful and think things through before you act. “Look before you leap” is a saying that makes a lot of sense, because every day we use our eyes to look at the ground ahead of us before we walk, run, or leap. Imagine how much more dangerous it would be to do these things with your eyes closed! Our sense of sight helps to keep us safe.

← Show image 2A-2: Boy looking to cross the street

Your eyes help **protect** the rest of your body.² They help you avoid bumping into things or tripping or falling as you move. You use your eyes to look both ways before you cross the street. But while your eyes are busy protecting you, what’s busy protecting your eyes? Now listen closely and you’ll learn about the body parts that work together to keep your eyes safe.

← Show image 2A-3: Child’s head with round eyeball

You might not be able to tell when you look in a mirror, but in fact, your eyes are round like balls. That is why they are called eyeballs. Each of your eyeballs is about as big—and almost as round—as a normal-sized gumball or marble, about an inch across.³ But your eyeballs aren’t hard like gumballs; they’re actually squishy like gummy bears. They are set into holes in your head—called eye sockets—so that they won’t get dirty or poked.

← Show image 2A-4: Girl with eyes shut

Your eyelids are little pieces of skin that come down and cover your eyeballs when you close your eyes or blink. Even when you are not trying to, your eyes blink automatically every few seconds in order to keep your eyeballs moist. The long hairs on your eyelids are called eyelashes; they help brush away dirt before it can get

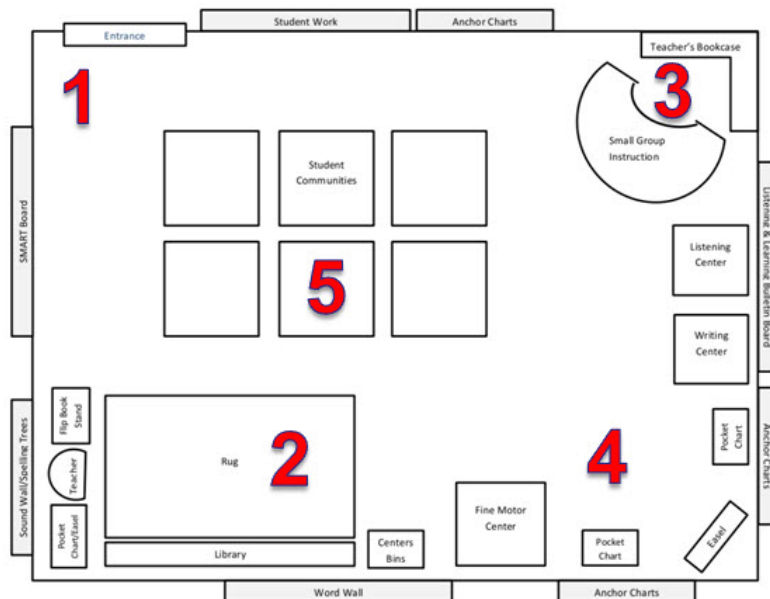

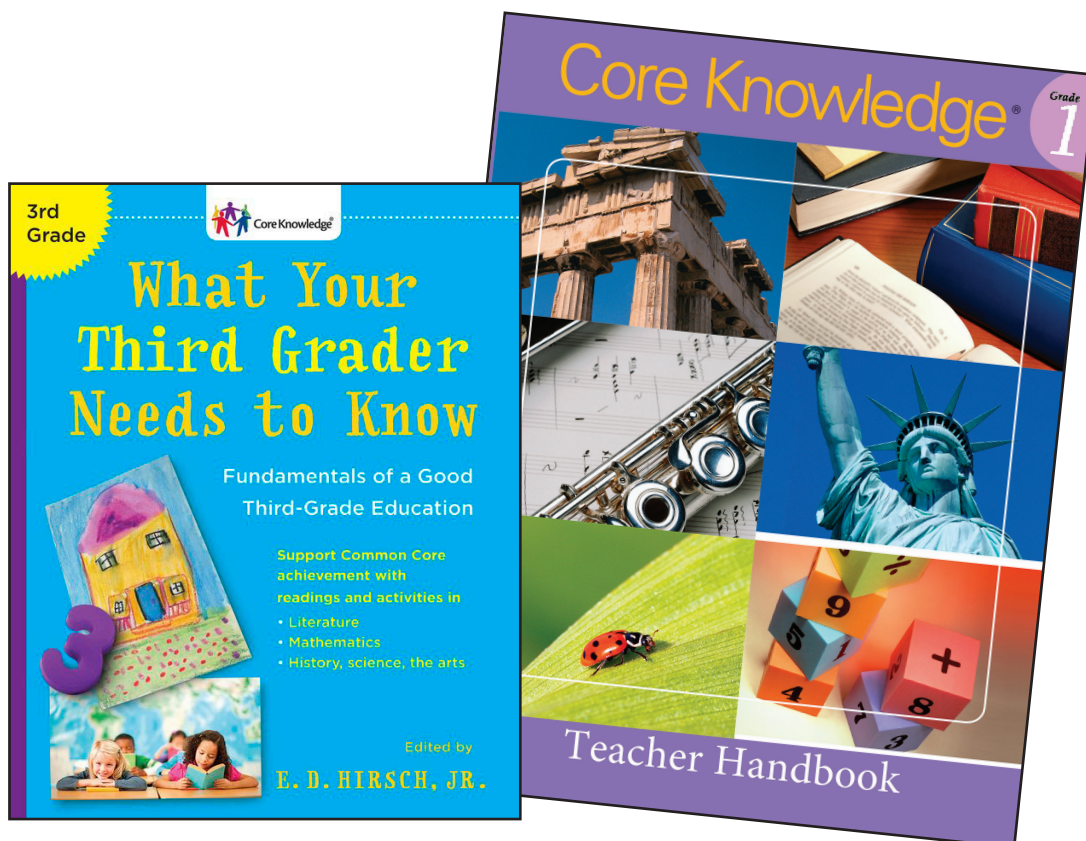

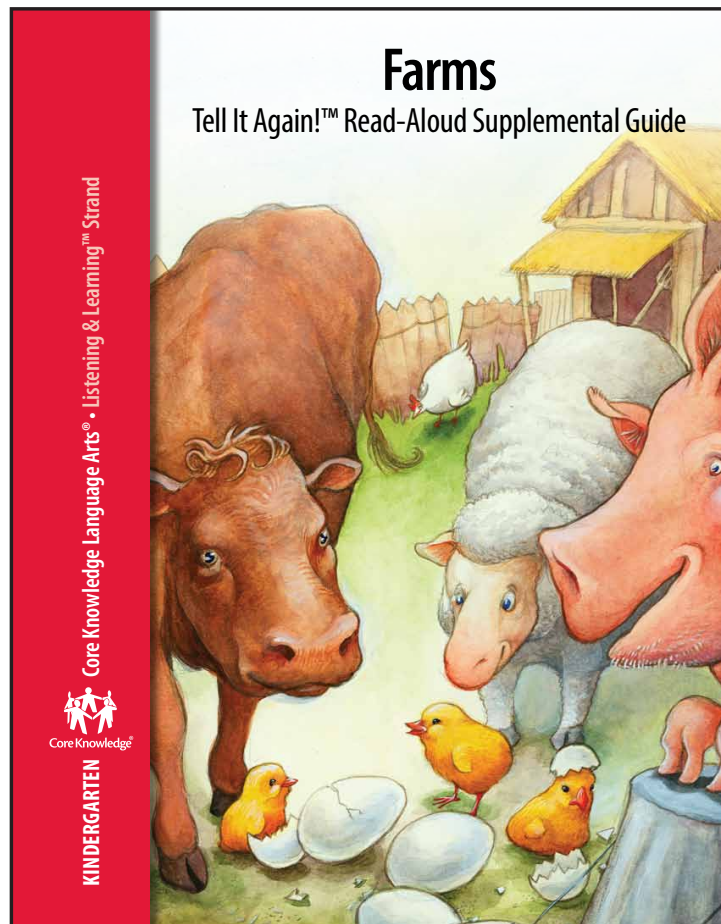

As with preschool through grade 3, units in grades 4 and 5 are domain based, covering a rich array of history, science, and literature. See the [P-5 sequence of domains](#) for a complete list of grade 4 and 5 domains, designed to both deepen and broaden students' knowledge. The grade 4-5 CKLA lessons require 90 minutes of daily instruction. The domain-based content is organized in units (8 units in grade 4 and 9 units in grade 5), which range from 10 to 26 days of instruction.

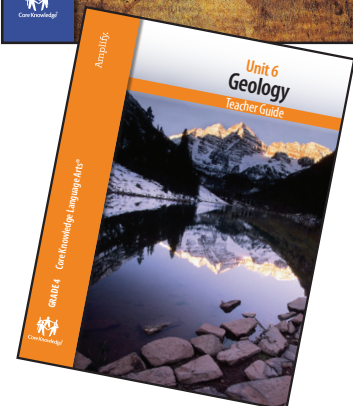
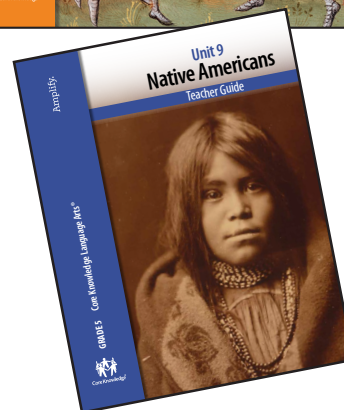
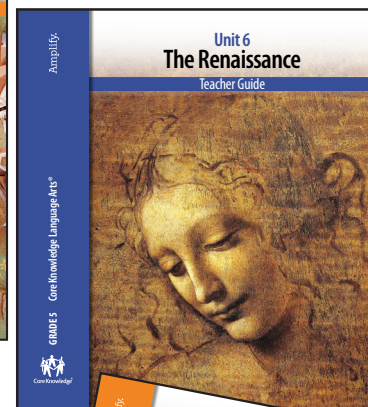
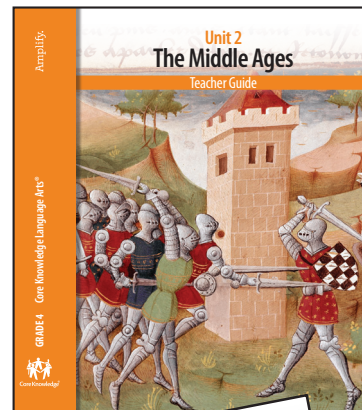

Learn About CKLA 4-5

The introduction documents for [Grade 4](#) and [Grade 5](#) provide descriptions of the components as well as background information on the common lesson types and instructional practices embedded at these grade levels. These introductions also contain information for teachers to reference throughout the school year.

Unlike the K-3 CKLA materials, grades 4 and 5 do not have two separate strands of instruction for Skills and Listening and Learning. With the strong foundation of reading skills and knowledge acquired in the K-3 program, students in grades 4 and 5 are increasingly able to tackle complex written text with rich academic content. Lessons vary day to day, but each unit includes read-alouds; whole-group, small-group, and partner reading; close reading; literal, inferential, and evaluative comprehension questions; vocabulary; grammar; writing; morphology and spelling (10-15 words per week); and unit assessments.

As compared with earlier grades, one of the biggest shifts comes in writing instruction. While grade 3 emphasizes five steps in the writing process (planning, drafting, revising, editing, and publishing), in grade 4 the writing process expands to seven components (adding sharing and evaluating). More importantly, in grades 4-5 the writing process is no longer conceptualized as a series of scaffolded, linear steps to follow. Rather, students move back and forth between components of the writing process in a flexible manner, similar to the process mature and experienced writers follow.



CKLA 4-5 draws on students' mastery of the basics as they tackle advanced grammar, morphology, spelling, and vocabulary while also being immersed in academic texts and engaged in rigorous writing across multiple genres.

Unlike the K–3 materials, grades 4 and 5 do not have separate strands of instruction for Skills and Listening & Learning. With the strong foundation of reading skills and knowledge acquired in the K-3 program, students are increasingly able to tackle complex text with rich academic content.

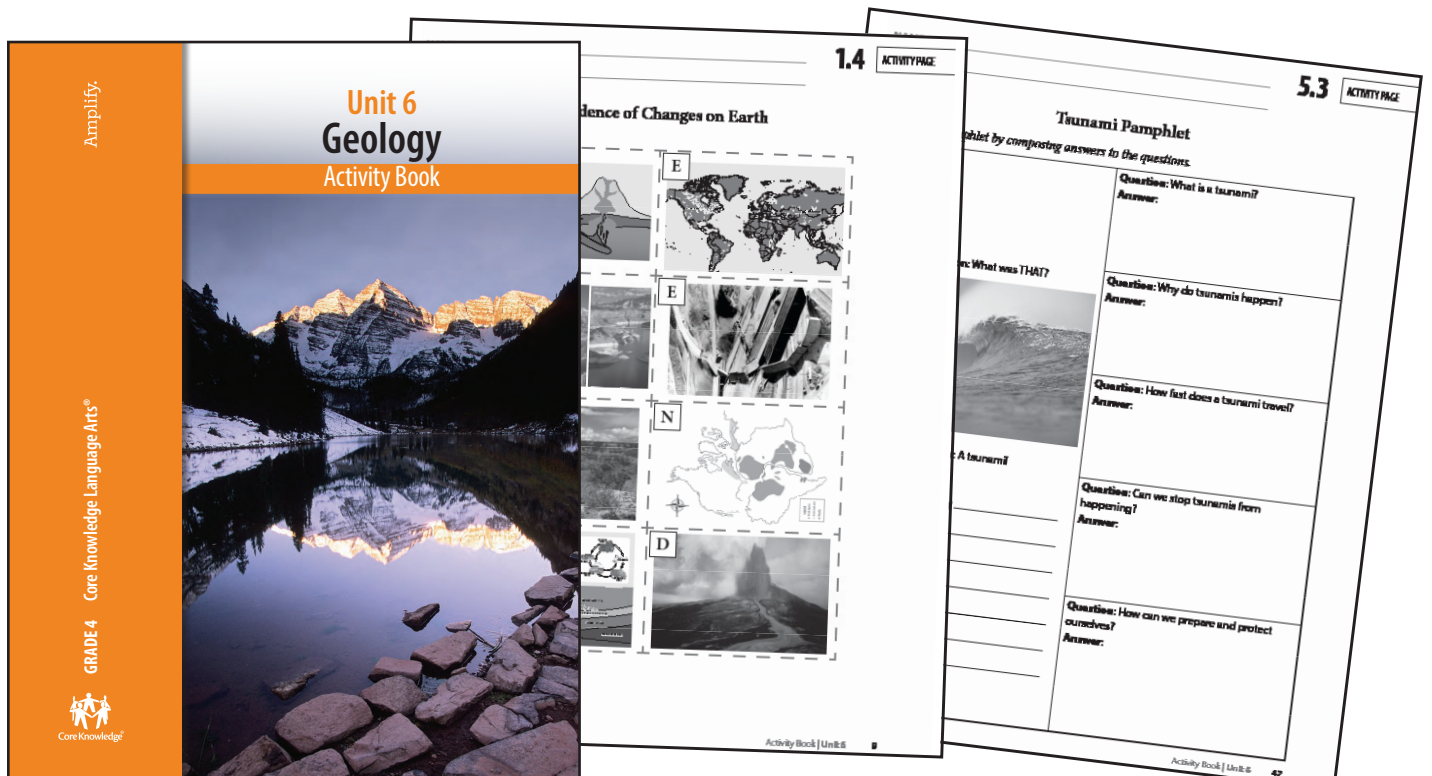

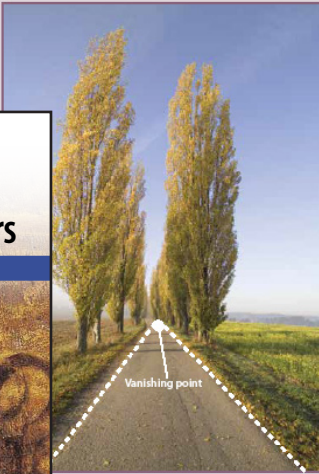

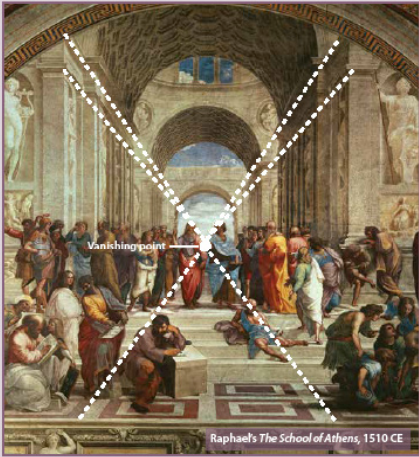

The Power of Perspective

The architect Brunelleschi inspired Renaissance artists when he developed the mathematical rules for perspective, a way of showing depth on a flat surface. Brunelleschi observed that when we look at things, objects that are close look bigger, while those that are far away look smaller. He also observed that if you stand between two parallel lines that stretch into the distance, the lines appear to come closer together until they meet at a point on the horizon. When the lines come together, they seem to vanish, so this point is called the vanishing point.



These mathematical rules, or instructions on how to achieve a sense of perspective, were published. Even today, artists used these rules to create a sense of depth and space in their work. When applied, these rules are a tool for directing the viewer's eye to the most important subjects of a painting. This is in direct contrast to art from earlier times such as the Middle Ages, when depth and space were not highlighted. The Renaissance painter Raphael, in his painting *The School of Athens*, used the structure of the building and the pattern of the floor to create a sense of perspective.

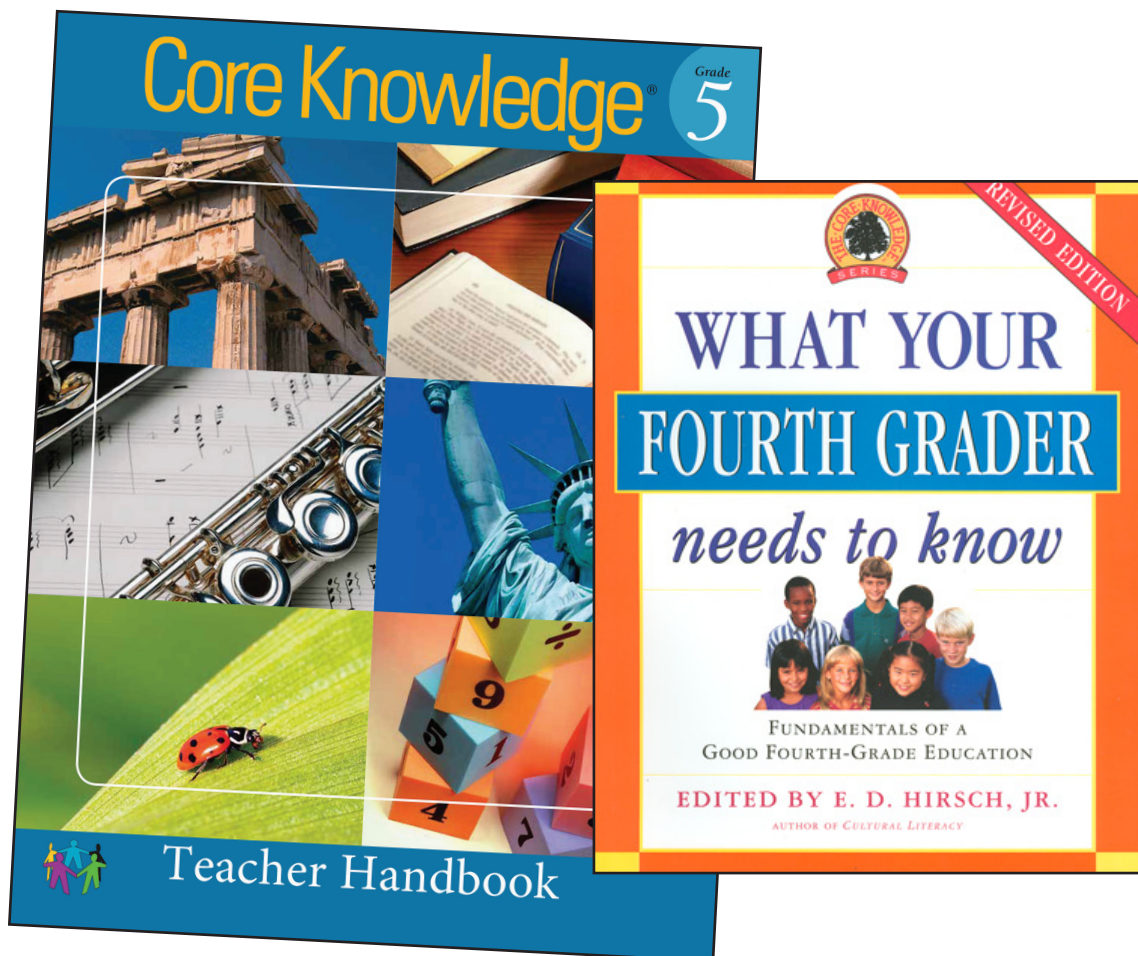

Enhance Your CKLA 4-5 Lessons

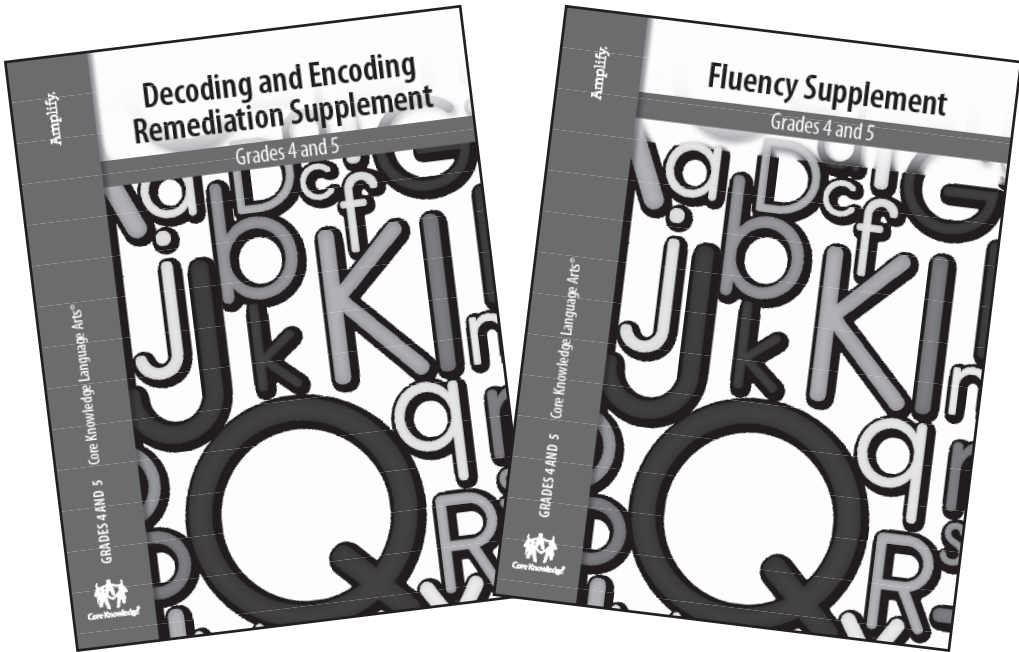
Opportunities for differentiation of instruction feature prominently in the CKLA program. In each Teacher Guide, there are multiple suggestions for how to support and challenge students throughout the lessons. These optional questions, activities, and information are labeled “Support and Challenge” in the Guides. Each unit also concludes with a Pausing Point for differentiation of instruction. The purpose of the Pausing Point is to provide opportunities for remediation and enrichment based on the results of the unit assessment and “Tens” scores from across the unit. You may wish to provide remediation or enrichment opportunities to individual students, small groups, or the whole class, based on students’ needs. We recommend using resources such as the [Core Knowledge Teacher Handbooks](#) and the [What Your Grader Needs to Know](#) series to guide your enhancements to CKLA 4-5.

Additional resources, such as the CKLA [Fluency Supplement](#) and the [Decoding and Encoding Remediation Supplement](#), can also support students with additional opportunities to practice reading with fluency and expression (prosody) and to provide targeted remedial instruction to students who may occasionally struggle with gaps in letter-sound knowledge, as evidenced by occasional problems in reading and/or spelling entire words or parts of words.
