Captain Al Gaspari is the Executive Board Chairman of the Associations of Star Alliance Pilots (ASAP) and a member of the United Airlines, Alliance & Scope Oversight Committee (ALPA). He has 25 years of professional pilot experience having flown for three airlines.

Currently he is flying for United Airlines as Captain on the Boeing 737 based in Los Angeles, California, USA. Gaspari recently served as elected Vice-Chairman of ALPA Council 57 (Los Angeles) for a term of three years. Concurrently, he was a member of the United Airlines Master Executive Council and MEC Sub-Committee Chairman. In addition to these leadership positions, he has served as Grievance Committee Chairman (LAX), Local Scheduling Committee, and ALPA Int'l Central Air Safety Committee/Air Safety Committee (America West Airlines).

His ALPA volunteer involvement began in early 1995 as the first Secretary/Treasurer (LAX) at Mesa Airlines.
