## Quicklaw for Microsoft Office: Can't See All Text in Right-Hand Pane

To see all the text in the right-hand pane, change your system's display font size.

To change the font size to **Normal** in Windows XP:

- 1. Click Start, select Settings, and select Control Panel to open the Control Panel window.
- 2. Double-click **Display** to open the **Display Properties** window.
- 3. Click the **Appearance** tab.
- 4. Select **Normal** from the **Font Size** drop-down list.
