10. When you click into the course (learning path) you can click on the icons, what we call learning items, to access course information/course content.

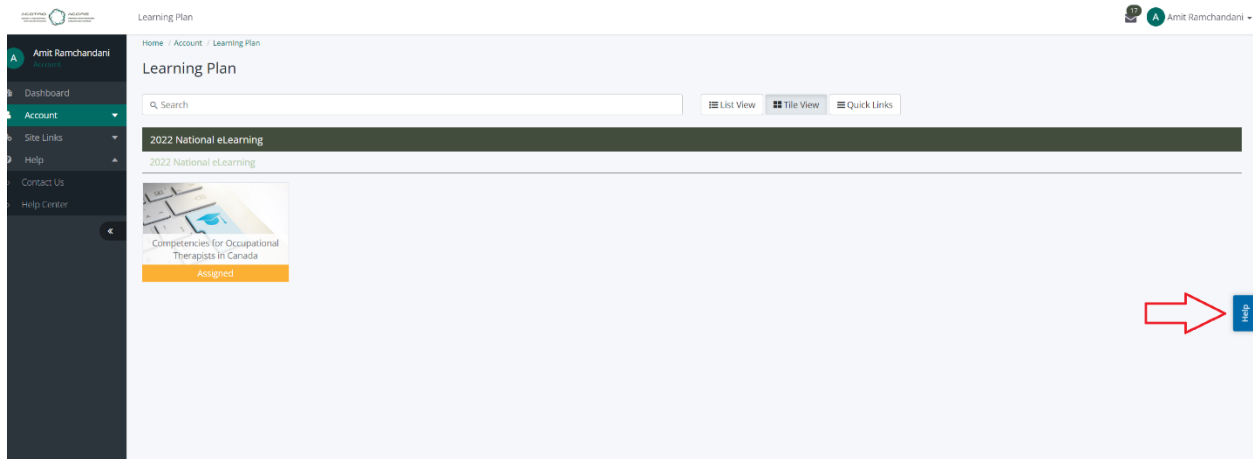
