We have received your records request under the Texas Public Information Act, dated May 24, 2023. Your request is outlined below, along with our responses and supporting documentation.

- 1. "[Open Meetings Act] certificates for Bishop, Neason, Anderson, Keller, Bahena, Kennedy, Gossett and yourself for the past five years"
 - a. Attached.
- 2. "[A] listing of all District officials/employees who act as administrator for [the District's Facebook account]... a listing of all citizens who have ever been barred from viewing the District's information, inclusive of date of banishment, date of access reestablishment (if any) and reason for banishment... [and] a copy of the authorization under which said account was established and copy of the guidelines which you are following in its management"
 - a. As District Manager, I am the sole authorized agent for the District's social media accounts. The initial job posting for District Manager included several sections detailing what the position would be tasked with, including a Public Relations section that read as follows:
 - Being the face of the SLMUD by ensuring the SLMUD remains transparent and informative. While working with the Superintendent of Operations and Office Manager, specific items include:
 - Establishing relationships and forging strategic alliances with other authorities, public entities, SLMUD customers, state agencies and the Texas legislature (TCEQ, GLO, GCWA, etc).
 - Be point of contact for San Leon residents. Research and answer all questions or direct to the appropriate contact (operations/management).
 - Promote the SLMUD's reputation for knowledge and transparency. This includes town hall learning forums, social media, and other constant communications.

The only individuals who have previously been banned from the page were people who were consistently spreading disinformation and general ill will, namely Phillip Haskett, Paul Fenn, David Jetelina, and David Koresh. At your request, those accounts were restored access to the pages on May 26th of this year and will continue to have access provided they maintain themselves with decorum and respect.

- 3. "... copies of all OH campaign finance reports for Bishop, Neason, Anderson, Bahena, Kennedy, Gossett and yourself for the past five years."
 - a. While I have not had campaign finance reports given that I am neither an officeholder nor have I ever run for office with the San Leon MUD, attached are the reports that the District has in our files from the other individuals listed.
- 4. "... copies of all documents, emails, faxes, text messages and or other electronic communication (including but not limited to electronic messaging) to/from all District managers (sic) and current/former board members and district attorney from the time period 5-May-2023 thru 23-May-2023 that involve any aspect of a) the resignation of Neason and b) the selection of her replacement."
 - a. Attached.

Please provide a copy of the authorization under which said account was established and copy of the guidelines which you are following in its management.

Please provide copies of all OH campaign finance reports for Bishop, Neason, Anderson, Bahena, Kennedy, Gossett and yourself for the past five years.

At last nights Board meeting you placed a stack of CV's near the doorway of the meeting room. To better understand the Board's decision making process and reasoning behind the Board's actions surrounding the selection of a replacement board member please provide copies of all documents, emails, faxes, text messages and or other electronic communication (including but not limited to electronic messaging) to/from all District managers and current/former board members and district attorney from the time period 5-May-2023 thru 23-May-2023 that involve any aspect of a) the resignation of Neason and b) the selection of her replacement.

Disclosure of this information is in the public interest because providing a copy of the information primarily benefits the general public. I therefore request a waiver of all fees and charges pursuant to Section 552.267 of the act.

I shall look forward to hearing from you promptly, as specified in the law. To ensure expediency please use my email address associated with this request. Thank you for your cooperation.




