Beneficiary Eligibility Review by ACO

Care Management Team:

-Verify patient CURRENTLY Attributed to MSSP

- -Medically stable
- Has chronic diagnosis
- Cannot be managed outpatient/home

-Utilize Interqual to ensure patient meets SNF admission criteria

- Approved by Medical Director/Mid-level for SNF admit

- 1. <u>Requester Completes</u> SNF admission orders, care management forms, obtains chest x-ray for TB rule out
- 2.<u>Requester</u> Sends forms and x-ray report to ACO Care Management team
- 3.ACO Care Management team reviews SNF admission orders, care plan and x-ray report
- 4.ACO Care Management team then send to admitting SNF
- 5.ACO Care Management team arranges for transfer

- SNF creates individualized case management plan and shares with SNF Care Manger, SNF Director, and ACO Care Management team within 1 business day
