


Ray Charles, Chairman of the Rhythm & Blues Foundation, has handed out over \$125,000 to recording artists "who, throughout their lifetimes, have made significant to contributions to rhythm & blues music" as part of the foundation's first annual Career Achievement Awards

Checks for \$15,000 were awarded to the following greats: LaVern Baker, Charles Brown, Ruth Brown, the Clovers, Etta James, Jimmy Scott, Percy Sledge and Mary Wells. Winners were chosen from over 60 candidates recommended by over 100 performers.

In Oct., 1988, a \$1.5 million endowment was made to the foundation by **Ahmet Ertegun** and Atlantic Records.

According to Charles: "This kind of recognition has long been overdue for these great artists. I'm glad we're able to finally give something back to this special group of R&B artists who have contributed so much to our music."

Amidst all this good will, Charles has found time to ink a new recording contract with Warner Bros., and consult a feature film about his life.

American rocker Melissa Etheridge was the only American to play at a last-minute free concert celebrating the recently reunited Germany — and the dismantling of the Berling Wall — at West Berlin's Deutschlandhalle. Joining East and West German acts Bap, Nina Hagen and Tote Hosen, plus Andrew Cash and Joe Cocker who brought the house down with his version of "A

Little Help From My Friends." The concert prompted tears and cheers from the capacity crowd of 12,000 East and West Germans, in addition to the countless thousands who were listening to the 10-hour concert outside the hall on a special PA system set up for the event, as well as on a special radio broadcast that was heard across West Germany.

What comes in a box and goes BOOM? Try, "Downtown Train," the first brand new single from Rod Stewart's Warner Bros. Anthology, "Storyteller."

How explosive is this project? It's the Most Added single of the week by a runaway; it's going on three different formats; when programmers play it, the phones go berserk, and some PDs are calling it Rod's "career song."

After diligently and patiently building Stewart's most recent string of hit singles, WB Promo Domos George Gerrity and Stu Cohen were overwhelmed by the extent of their promotion genius, which rightfully found them grinnin' ear to ear on Tuesday night.



TEMP MILL FITS THE BIL

Kemp Mill Records began a decade and a half ago renting space in the least desirable locations, but parlaying a policy of the lowest possible price into one of the Mid-Atlantic region's leading retailers. A 13-year veteran of the company, Howard Applebaum, the head of Purchasing and Advertising, has watched one store outlet grow into 34 outlets with close to 300 employees and their pick of the prime mall locations. Aggressive risk takers, Kemp Mill has carved out a niche by taking chances; now their luck's finally run out as Applebaum talks to HITS' always chancey Jesse Nash.



Kemp Mill Records started, like a lot of record chains did, undercapitalized: we had no money, we put a few records in the shop, hoped to sell them, turn it over, buy more records, and so on. And soon one store turned into two, which turned into three. which turned into four... What our calling card has been since the very beginning — and still is — is price. We are, I believe, the price leaders in our marketplace. I'm told we sell compact discs cheaper than anybody in the country. And that's what we do best: we sell price.

What drew you to the business?

I didn't have anything else to do. (Laughs) Three guys started Kemp Mill Records — only one of the founding members, Stan Wahler, is still here. He's president of the company today. About a year after it opened, Joel Goldberg, joined the company. They said to him, "Why don't you join the company? If we do well, we'll make you a partner." But there were no assets in the corporation at that point. The next year, I joined. I happened to know Joel.

How did you end up as the head of purchasing and advertising? Well, I was manager of a store,

Well, I was manager of a store, but I used to hang around when

the sales people came in. As a kid in junior high and high school, I would buy records and I always wanted to turn my friends on to them. I wanted to say, "Hey, man. You're gonna love this fuckin' record. Listen to this new Laura Nyro record. It's the best thing in the whole world." So, being in the record business is natural to me. And marketing I'm sort of drawn to — selling products and figuring out better ways to sell them, developing niches in the marketplace, and promotions and merchandising — they all interest me.

How would you describe the marketplace now?

I'm really concerned about what's going on in the record business right now. Only about 16 or 18 percent of the people in the United States own CDs. I thought it would be higher by this time, that the penetration would have been better. I believe that the stagnant sales in our business of both software and hardware are due to the fact that consumers have decided that CDs priced the way they are are too expensive.

What's the solution?

It requires this sort of leap of faith on the part of the manufacturers. Right now their costs of goods are pretty low. They're in a position where they're making a lot of money on compact discs — and I

think that's great, by the way because when they're making a lot of money, I have more money for advertising. But I think they need to do what we did: two years ago, we were selling all our compact discs for \$13.99, and we asked, "If we lower our prices, can we make it up in volume?" We lowered our prices to \$11.99 and \$10.99 — that's where our prices are today — and our volume increased dramatically.

You never know until you try.

Exactly, and I'd like to see the manufacturers take the same action. A year-and-a-half ago, they took a risk and did lower a lot of

like to see digital audio tape brought on slowly.

What are your key selling tools?

We're very price aggressive. We price all our hit stuff at \$10.00 and that drives a lot of sales. Our advertising is loud, aggressive and obnoxious — on certain levels, it screams at people. They're a poor imitation of Crazy Eddie.

What are your thoughts on the P.M.R.C. and censorship?

I'm pretty liberal and I believe the record business ought to police itself before somebody tells us we have to be policed. It really is shocking, though, what's going on with lyrics. Many reasonable people seem to think there's some kind of problem and I happen to

their catalogue prices, and I feel they're reaping the rewards of that aggressive marketing because our catalogue sales have never been better.

What needs to happen?

The industry needs to get the price of compact discs down to where the price is good for 60 or 70 percent of the people out there, not just 16 or 18 percent. Then I'd

agree. I'm not into censorship; I don't want to see any censorship. I don't want to be told I can't sell a Guns N' Roses record to an 18-year old. But, as an industry, we need to be more aggressive with stickering some of our records, saying the material may be unsuitable in some way. Parents need to be able to evaluate in some manner what their kids are listening to.



WVIC Lansing, MI's PD Kevin Robinson got his start at WBWB doing every air shift he could, until he finally graduated to morning drive. In 1984, he moved on to Louisville and WLRS where he did nights and served as Production Director. When afternoon guy Brian Christopher went to Tampa, Robinson took over afternoons, Asst. PD, Music and Research Director and whatever else needed doing. Working his fingers to the bone paid off, as Robinson got the PD nod from WVIC this fall.

Millions of people around the world are dying to know about Lansing. Could you make their day and tell 'em about it?

Lansing's not a whole lot different from Louisville in what we're trying to do with the radio station, as well as the market make-up. Louisville metro is a little more ethnic — it's 5% ethnic here in Lansing and basically a good ol' rock 'n' roll market. What I had to do initially was find out that acts like INXS are considered dance

bands. INXS is a white-boy dance record. Love & Rockets is solely a dance record for this market. So, we play a lot of straight-ahead rock 'n' roll and if something dance-ish or urban-ish comes and hits us in the face screaming, "Hit!" — then we'll play it. We added Janet the third week at #1! Lansing is a blue collar town, but at the same time it has the cosmopolitan feel of the university — MSU is here. And every football Saturday, the whole market's blood

runs green and white. Too bad they can't win a game!

Has the station always leaned rock or is this a new direction?
This station really came to the forefront and became #1 in 1984 under some guy...! think his name is Stevens. Yeah, that's it — Jay Stevens. I think he's somewhere in Tucson or something like that now. Anyway, they became #1 by coming

What's it like for you being a program director for the first time?
A lot of what I heard when I was interviewing for other stations was, "Ya know Kevin, we like you for this job,

from a pop/adult format to a straight-ahead rock 'n' roll approach. The morning guy, Rich Michaels, has been here five years and the afternoon guy, Danny Stewart, has been with this station for twelve — and both of them are in the top twenty of average quarter hour drive time jocks in the nation. They own the market. The midday girl has been in the market for about eight years and has been with WVIC for about three. She's pulled phenomenal numbers. Our night guy, Hollywood Hendricks, is the best kept secret in the industry. He's been here almost three years and he's just a super guy. So, as far as personnel goes, we've got an incredible staff. The biggest challenge here is keeping them motivated and not comparing themselves, since we are #1, to (the rest of) Lansing. We need to constantly be the best station, no matter where you compare us. Musically, we are a heavily researched radio station...

That's what everyone says.

No, we really are. Research passively. If somebody sells four pieces of Fine Young Cannibals product at Wherehouse Records here, I basically don't care. I mean, I know it may mean a whole lot to the guy at Wherehouse, but it ain't no big deal to me. We have to be a very pas-

but ya know you've never been a PD. You've never felt that pressure..." Well, I felt some intense pressure in Phoenix. Intense! And there's still some intense pressure going on in that market. There's pressure here, but it's a different kind of pressure. It's almost a comfortable pressure in the fact that we know we're #1, but feel we have to keep it up more than ever. In Phoenix, people walked around those halls feeling that anything (and I mean anything!) could happen in that volatile situation. And this station here is very thought-out, very researched and very calculated. Everyone expects things to be planned out in advance, whereas in Phoenix, because of the volatile situation with KZZP and KKFR against us, anything could happen at anytime. If we had to drop something to steal the Debbie Gibson record off KZZP's airwaves, we did it. Check this out: in this market, we had the Phil Collins album early and were playing cuts off of it — and it was 6:30 before one of our competitors called the Atlantic people and said, "Hey, ya know they're playing a Phil Collins cut every hour?

So, you bought a house?

Yeah, I came here and bought a house. I put it on my Visa. It's so F*#%*%' cheap here, it's not even funny. ■



You don't compromise. You're sure of what you want.



Any message to the music industry?



THE LATEST ON UP AND COMING BANDS by John Sutton-Smith

Through their three albums, the songs of Celtic pop band the Waterboys have quietly defined the class of contemporary rock, flanking U2 on one side and Bob Dylan on the other. But singer/songwriter Mike Scott has been extremely hesitant about his role in such company, to the extent that he has made none of the usual commercial concessions, sanctioning no videos and refusing to tour until nearly two years after the release of the classic "Fisherman's Blues" (Chrysalis). Last week, with a threenight sold-out stand at L.A.'s Wiltern Theatre, Scott finally demonstrated his ability to step into the limelight and assume the great potential so strongly suggested by the band's records - an eclectic blend of rootsy folk and fiery pop. Not everyone seemed overwhelmed by the unpredictable pacing of the set, but then Scott is that rare kind of artist, like Dylan or Neil Young, who dances to his own tune. Mixing several of the classics from "Fisherman's Blues" — including title track, "Strange Boat," "When Ye Go Away," the hammy "Has Anybody Here Seen Hank?" and the bittersweet ex-lover tribute "And A Bang On The Ear" - with a tougher mini-set of material from the earlier "This Is The Sea" album, Scott picked up his electric guitar to scorch through "Medicine Bow," "Be My Enemy," and "The Whole Of The Moon," plus a rare rendition of "Spirit" and a particularly fine Rodney Crowell ballad, "Song For A Life."... CMJ NOTES: Reports from the CMJ include high marks for the odd pairings at the awards show (e.g., Jane Siberry with the Ramones) plus standout performances from the Chili Peppers, naturally thankfully the killer "Higher Ground" remake is becoming the monster it should be - plus Seattle's Soundgarden, whose powerful display preceded an acoustic version of "Dirty Boulevard" by N.Y.'s own Lou Reed Other showcase highlights: EMI's rocking Anglos Crazyhead, Chameleon's Mary's Danish and Dramarama, Epic's awesome Screaming Trees, and one of the year's sleeping giants, Innocence Mission, whose deft folk-pop may seem light at first listen but is eminently breakable. The A&M band's current tour has included stops at N.Y.'s Knitting Factory and Boston's T.T. Bears, plus upcoming appearances at a 91X-sponsored bash and three nights at L.A.'s Club Largo.... Speaking of Soundgarden, their debut viddy for "Loud Love," directed by Kevin Kerslake, is a manic quick-cut and crazy-camera pastiche of the up-and-coming hard rockers.... RCA's Sheryl Ingber hosted a press luncheon at the trendy Duplex for their great rock hopefuls Ranging Slab, and the Slab turned out to be a smart and entertaining lot - a fact well evident on their smoking debut.... Detroit's irrepressible Romantics rocked a wild and crazy Roxy crowd, showcasing some new material and their New York import Clem Burke, rightly considered one of the top drummers in the biz. Lots of industry curiosity for a band that's only a Diane Warren song or two away from a serious comeback.... Personal pix of the week: Best new song by old artist: "Losing My Mind" by Liza Minnelli with the Pet Shop Boys, from her new Epic album "Results." Best remake by contemporary artist: the Waterboys' cover of Van Morrison's "Sweet Thing." Massive U.K. dance hits: Felly with Technotronic doing "Pump Up The Jam" (out here on SBK), and Jive Bunny & the Mastermixers with "That's What I Like."



According to Lakers coach Pat Riley, the opposite of momentum is menmotion. Both momentum and menmotion are contagious, sez Pat, and all you need is a single element to turn one into the other. This concept applies to the personal management biz as well. Look at Martin Kirkup and Steve Jensen's Direct Management, for example. They're goin' great, and suddenly lan McCulloch leaves Echo & the Bunnymen. Presto — instant menmotion. So what happens next? Joe Jackson stiffs. A few months later, the B-52's album zooms in from deep left field to become the strongest seller in the entire WEA system, powered by the irresistible single "Love Shack." Presto — momentum

returns to Direct. The shift can be felt as far away as London, Jensen's base of operations. Steve excitedly reports to Martin in L.A. that Bryan Ferry, who's perhaps the slowest, most deliberate recording artist on the planet (his last three albums took a total of nine years to record!), has already cut 14 (!) tracks for his next album, all recorded live in the studio with a lean & mean combo made up of drummer Andy Newmark, bassist Luico Hopper and guitarist Neal Hubbard. This news makes Kirkup's upper lip decidedly less stiff. With

the Boy Meets Girl follow-up ready to ship, and with the remade/remodeled Echo tracking in Jan., Steve and Martin are as tight as two guys 6,000 miles away from each other can be.... The jury's still out on the 52's second single, but we'll vote for "Roam."... A&M could have a surprise winner in Scotland's Del Amitri, whose Chrysalis debut went nowhere, but who sound MAJOR (as in Crowded House) on this new one, which is coming in Jan. Part of it has to do with maturation, part of it is the result of the inspired production by little-known Mark Freegard, whose work here is the stylistic antithesis of his main claim to fame, Marillion. Keep an eye on this kid Peter Paterno may only be a formal announcement away from the helm of Disney's entry into the rock arena, but for the moment he's still a lawyer, and he's playing the part with gusto. It was Paterno who put together the symbiotic P&D deal between Van Halen manager Ed Leffler and Elektra. Leffler's 5150 Records is just what the doctor ordered for Elektra, which sports Motley Crue and Faster Pussycat but has a weak bench. What's more, 5150's staff producer is Eddie Van Halen, no less. This'll finally give Ed a chance to prove that he's more than just a killer guitarist.... According to Karen Carpenter fan k.d. lang (who has become an awesome live performer, by the way), the next musical style to be discovered by trendsters will be easy listening. If there is indeed an "easy listening new wave" coming. Scottish trio the Blue Nile will be riding right on top of it. The band's exquisite second LP, "Hats," is slated for a Jan. release on A&M, but those L.A. record stores that deal in exotica can't seem to keep the Linn import CD in stock. Pick to click: "Downtown Lights" it's like Sinatra singing the theme from Blade Runner.



WILD AbouT HATRY

Harry Connick, Jr. seems like a pretty unlikely fellow to bring jazz — and the classic, romantic American songs of the Gershwins, Duke Ellington, Benny Goodman and the like — into the mainstream. Not that the 22-year-old New Orleans pianist did it on his own; no, the baggy suit sporting, former pianist at New York's famed Algonquin Hotel has the help of Rob Reiner and a little picture called "When Harry Met Sally....," an equally romantic film which captured the imagination of everyone engaged in, or even sitting on the bench of, the battle of the sexes. So, the son of the Crescent City's D.A. has become a poster child for a renaissance of jazz and he doesn't even know it; seems young Harry's been over in England acting in "Memphis Belle" and has missed most of the furor. But, don't worry — HITS' always meddlesome Holly Gleason will more than fill him in.

It seems like your soundtrack couldn't have been more suited to a film like "When Harry Met Sally." It wasn't obvious, but it was very romantic.

Well, there's a secrecy and an intimacy to jazz that's very romantic. It's very sensual, very romantic music — and it's where I feel most comfortable.

What do you mean?

Well, it's like when you're out on a date with somebody and you're in a real dark restaurant and you're across the table from someone. It's like when you're talking about the weather, but what you're thinking is, "I'd really like to kiss that person...."

And this music captures that?

Absolutely. I think those songs are beautiful — and singing ballads is something I like to do. There's something about the sound of your voice, the way the breath feels coming out of your mouth, feeling your lips forming the words because you've got plenty of time to really enjoy it.

A lot of people seem to agree. How does it feel bringing all this attention to jazz?

It's a great opportunity because young people haven't really been exposed to jazz music before. It's sort of jazz music's fault — who wants to watch 5 or 6 musicians standing onstage, never talking to

the audience? That's NOT entertaining. But, as long as I have the ball in my hands, I'm going to try to do everything I can to make it as authentic as possible.

You're awful young. What drew you to jazz?

Probably growing up in New Orleans. You're exposed to it. And my parents were big music fans who were always playing records around the house, so that kind of music was a constant thing.

There's supposed to be a "When Harry Met Harry and Sally" tour. Tell me about it.

I'll be doing some orchestral music.
I'll be basically doing the album live
and maybe some songs from my
next album. And I always get excited when I play with an orchestra
— I've only done it once before, but
it's an amazing feeling.

Will you be using the same players in every city?

The record wasn't THAT big a hit! No, we'll be finding an orchestra in every city who'll play with us, which should keep things interesting and improvising...

Do you like New York?

It's fine.

Do you miss the South? Of course, it's my home.

Then how does a Southern boy end

up in N.Y.C.?

Wynton Marsalis told me that George Butler, the head of A&R for Columbia's jazz department, wanted to sign me; so, I moved up there to pursue a recording career.

How old were you?

Eighteen. I was petrified, but it was something I had to do.

Plus, you knew there was interest in you.

Oh yeah, there was no dramatic struggle. I wasn't a heroin addict and I didn't have to live on the streets. It was cold and I lived in the Y.M.C.A. It was a struggle, but it wasn't too much; I pretty much had what I needed.

Are you worried this current interest in jazz is just a phase?

If it's a trend, it's a trend. But, I hope it isn't. This music will last forever, because it's so good. People just have to come and hear it — and I think this record and this tour are helping. You have to understand I'm not trying to battle rock and roll, I'm just thinking jazz music should have a place up there that's equal to every other kind of music that people listen to.

I hear you've been in London.

I'm doing a film called "The Memphis Belle." It's an ensemble piece with ten men that's set in England during World War Two, because that's where they flew all the B-17s out of. I play the part of the tail gunner on the B-17.

Who else is in it?

All kinds of people, Eric Stolz, Mathew Modine, John Lithgow.

Pretty serious company. Is it intimidating?

A little at first. I was a little nervous the first few days. But, as I got to know them and all, they were such great people and were always offering me advice.

Will you give up the piano for acting?

No, I'm going to spend my whole life trying to figure it out, learning how to play jazz piano well. It's still something I don't know how to do well — and I think it's something that will be a quest of a lifetime.





THE LEGACY LIVES ON

When and why did you start talking about a Poco reunion?

RY: It (Poco) was really kind of an incompleted part of my life. We never got to make a record. Randy left the band when we first started Pickin' Up The Pieces. That whole thing just never really took off, and never really got to where it deserved to get. The time was never really right for any of us to get together. We'd started on it about three years ago.

IM: Rusty and I have been talking about this thing for the past two and half, three years. We've been wanting to work (together). It kind of got down to the point where he and I had talked about doing a Poco album together. I thought about it. I told him, "To be quite frank with you, I think I'd like to work with the original band. If all of those guys are willing, ready and able to discuss it, I certainly am; but on the condition that everybody can still either play or sing." We had a meeting up at my studio in Santa Barbara. We spent four days in a kind of rehearsal/recording situation. I was really hesitant about whether it was going to work or not.

For fans of country-rock, Poco has always been magic. The combination of Rusty Young, Paul Cotton, Randy Meisner, Jim Messina and Richie Furay was one of much promise. Unfortunately, it was promise that was never realized as the members began flying off in different directions: Meisner to The Eagles, Messina who paired up with Kenny Loggins and Richie Furay who pursued a higher vision and spending the last twelve years as a preacher. Now after all these years, the original Poco's back together and the magic is just as potent as ever. "Call It Love" got "Legacy" off to a strong start, and the band is revving up for a tour. HITS' Stephen Padgett got the lowdown on what brought the band together after all this time.

Youngsters have larger egos than they deserve. It must have contributed to all the splits in Poco's past. Are you older and wiser now?

RY: Yeah, I think after all the years we've finally figured it out. We worked out a system of checks and balances so that we can all be more adult now than we were 20 years ago. We can work problems out instead of people saying, "That's it. I quit. I'm gone."

The liner notes suggest that Legacy is just a one-off project.

RY: I've committed to one alburn and one tour. But the history of bands I've been was there's nothing set in stone, ever. The only way it would make sense to do it again would be if people really like the album and there was a demand for another album somewhere down the line. But it sure wouldn't be next year or the year after that.

How do you explain the fact that you. Milli Vanilli and Warrant can all have hits at the same time?

RY: Radio people have said that it works for them because it's a break from both those kinds of music. It's a break from the Bobby Browns. It breaks up the sound, so that a radio station doesn't have just

that one kind of sound going.

A disclaimer on the album says you all come from different philosophical persuasions. What sorts of hurdles did you have leap to get this together?

RY: I really like that little disclaimer. It kind of sums up the whole thing. We're five different guys who come from five very different places. I'm a heathen. On the opposite side, you have Richie Furay, who's a saint. When we first got together to do the project, we all talked about the fact that Richie was a minister. I mean, that's so un-rock and roll these days. Rock and roll has gone so blue.

JM: Richie, probably of all of us, had made the biggest commitment in his life to move on to a totally different career. He'd become a minister, and he was very concerned about whether or not he could do this project without compromising us and/or his ministry. I felt the same thing; I didn't want to compromise the music because of the ministry. We decided that we all had to satisfy a certain thing, and that certain thing was to make rock and roll as we as a group can.

"Richie was a minister. I mean, that's so un-rock and roll these days. Rock and roll has gone so blue."

rock and roll band. We stink, we smell, we sweat, but we play with our hearts and that's it. We challenged ourselves a lot on this record. PL: And we're not afraid to play the blues. We're not a band who is going to flinch when it comes to playing the blues. There are a lot of bands out there playing wimpy three chord bailads.

Are you referring to your former band?

TG: I'm not going to talk about them. We're friends and let's leave it at that. We just went in different musical directions.

You mixed two song tltles: Wheels of Fire, I Wanna Be Your Man.

PL: (sigh) They're words. Wheels of Fire, that's a term I remember hearing from when I grew up. It made an impression, it's a great image. Just because it's been used and Cream didn't make it up, they heard it somewhere, too — doesn't mean a thing. Being a musician is like being a magpie: you steal things. Little things, ideas and stuff. You do your own interpretations. I mean. how many different songs with the words Call Me have been a hit?

Do you guys lie in interviews?

PL: Sometimes you have to. Sometimes you'll have an old fart who wants to hear a road story. You know what he wants to hear, he knows what he wants to hear: he wants dirt. Do you oil the wheels of the truth? You make it a lot bigger than it is. Give 'em what they want and they go away happy.






