



DETAIL OF STATE TAX COLLECTIONS IN 1957

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The \$14.4 billion tax revenue collected by State governments during fiscal 1957 was derived from a great variety of tax sources. The following pages show the most detailed information that can now be provided readily as to the 1957 yields of these sources, together with final 1956 tax figures in similar detail.

Readers concerned mainly with major tax classes, broad interstate comparisons, and recent State revenue trends can best refer to the earlier Bureau of the Census report, State Tax Collections in 1957. That publication shows State-by-State tax revenue figures in terms of 27 standard categories. It also provides selected historical and analytical data--ratios, percentage distributions, and per capita amounts--which are not repeated here.

NATURE OF THIS REPORT

This report is designed to serve expressed needs for information concerning the nature and yield of specific taxes of individual States, supplementing the tax revenue data which appear in other Bureau of the Census reports in terms of standard type-of-tax categories. The standard reporting framework is reflected here in the historical nationwide totals of table 1 and the amounts for lettered and numbered categories shown for each State in table 2.

The further detail appearing in table 2 is of two types:

(1) Most of the individual subordinate items there pertain to particular taxes; numerous minor sources, especially various State licenses, have commonly been merged into appropriate "other" residual groups. This type of detail indicates the contribution of specific taxes of each State to the standard tax revenue classes into which they fall.

(2) Analytical detail is also provided, to the extent found practicable, for certain major tax sources. For example, table 2 shows both gross collections and offsetting refund amounts, as to sales taxes on motor fuel for most States, and a distribution, by type of business, of revenue from general sales and gross receipts taxes in every instance where such detail has

been available. As shown here, this type-of-business breakdown commonly represents (for purposes of brevity) a selective abridgement of tabulations prepared by the States concerned.

The wide variation in the nature and extent of detail appearing in table 2, below the level of the uniform Census classification, reflects differences in the form of records and reports of individual States, as well as basic differences in their tax structure.*

Figures shown here for 1957 are preliminary; those for 1956 are final, and replace the detailed amounts first presented in the report, Detail of State Tax Collections in 1956, which also provided final 1955 data. Comparable detail, formerly issued annually up to 1950, has not been published for the intervening fiscal years 1951 through 1954.

CONCEPTS AND LIMITATIONS

This report relates to revenue from State taxes only. Any interstate comparisons should take note that the proportion of total State and local revenue derived from State-imposed taxes differs materially from one State to another.

On pages 29-30, there appear definitions of the standard categories for Census reporting of State tax revenue--i.e., the categories shown as lettered and numbered items in table 2. For the two kinds of more detailed items shown in table 2 (specific tax sources and analytical distributions for certain major taxes) the designations there commonly employ the terminology of the individual States. For comparison of such items, it should be recognized that similar terms may differ considerably in actual content or definition as among individual States.

The 1957 amounts shown in table 2 for subclasses will, in most instances, add directly to the individual-State amounts for standard categories appearing in the advance report, State Tax Collections in 1957. In a few cases, the earlier preliminary figures are modified herein in the light of more complete information. The 48-State aggregates appearing in table 1, however, appear here without change from their original August publication, to avoid presenting

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interim data still subject to review and further slight adjustment.¹ Final 1957 amounts will be presented in the Compendium of State Government Finances in 1957.

In some instances, as indicated by annotations, subordinate items in table 2 do not add to the totals shown for the standard categories involved. In most instances, this is because the supplemental data were derived from sources that apply somewhat different accounting bases from those of sources from which the standard tax items were drawn. Commonly, such apparent discrepancies arise from use of accrued amounts versus cash amounts, supplemental detail in terms of gross collections versus revenue amounts net of refunds, and differences in the time period for which tax amounts are recorded. In a few cases, table 2 reflects minor adjustments of detailed figures for fiscal 1956, made after publication of the report, Compendium of State Government Finances in 1956. Figures for the standard tax categories have not been revised, since the net changes involved would be negligible.

¹Revised information now available indicates that the preliminary 1957 amount for "general sales and gross receipts taxes" was understated by about \$80 million. See "Note" at bottom of table 1 and footnote 1 for Pennsylvania in table 2.

TIME PERIOD COVERED

Except for four States, the 1956 and 1957 tax amounts herein are for State fiscal years ending June 30. Data for New York and Pennsylvania are for their fiscal years ending March 31 and May 31, respectively. For Alabama and Texas, 1957 amounts are for the 12-month period ended June 30, 1957, and 1956 data herein are for their regular fiscal years that closed on September 30, 1956, and on August 31, 1956, respectively.

SOURCES AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Most of the amounts shown in this publication were initially obtained by a mail canvass of numerous State agencies and officials. In many cases, particularly as to distributions of major sales or gross receipts taxes, data have been derived from periodic State reports and statements and from unpublished tabulations. The 1957 figures, as indicated above, are subject to possible later revision in the light of additional information.

State officials and their staffs have been most cooperative in providing information for this report and related publications. Their assistance is gratefully acknowledged.

DETAIL OF STATE COLLECTIONS IN 1957

DEFINITIONS OF STATE TAXES

State tax revenue comprises amounts collected—including interest and penalties but excluding amounts refunded—from all taxes imposed by a State and collected by it or collected and transmitted to it by local governments. State tax revenue includes local shares of State-imposed taxes except any amounts locally collected and retained.

Standard categories for Census reporting of State tax collections are defined below:

A. **SALES AND GROSS RECEIPTS TAXES.**—Taxes, including "licenses" at more than nominal rates, based upon the volume or value of transfers of goods or services, upon gross receipts therefrom, or upon gross income, and related taxes based upon use, storage, production, importation, or consumption of goods. Dealer discounts or "commissions" allowed to merchants for collection of taxes from consumers are excluded. Distinctively imposed severance taxes are excluded here and reported under that category.

1. **General sales or gross receipts taxes.**—Sales or gross receipts taxes which are applicable with only specified exceptions to all types of goods, all types of goods and services, or all gross income, whether at a single rate or at classified rates. Taxes imposed distinctively upon sales or gross receipts from selected commodities, services, or businesses are reported separately under categories listed below.

2. **Selective sales and gross receipts taxes.**—Sales and gross receipts taxes imposed on sales of particular commodities or services or gross receipts of particular businesses separately and apart from the application of general sales and gross receipts taxes.

a. **Motor fuels.**—Selective sales and gross receipts taxes on gasoline, diesel oil and other fuels used in motor vehicles, including aircraft fuel. Note that any amounts refunded are deducted from gross collections.

b. **Alcoholic beverages.**—Selective sales and gross receipts taxes on alcoholic beverages.

c. **Tobacco products.**—Selective sales and gross receipts taxes on tobacco products, including cigarette tubes and paper.

d. **Insurance.**—Taxes imposed distinctively on insurance companies and measured by gross premiums or adjusted gross premiums.

e. **Public utilities.**—Taxes imposed distinctively on public passenger and freight transportation companies, telephone, telegraph, and light and power companies, and other public utility companies and measured by gross receipts, gross earnings, or units of service sold. Taxes levied on such companies on other bases are classified elsewhere in accordance with the nature of the tax.

f. **Pari-mutuels.**—Taxes measured by amounts wagered at race tracks including "breakage" collected by the government.

g. **Amusements.**—Selective sales and gross receipts taxes on admission tickets or admission charges and on gross receipts of all or specified types of amusement businesses.

h. **Other selective sales and gross receipts taxes.**—Selective sales and gross receipts taxes relating to specific commodities, businesses, or services not separately enumerated above (e.g., lubricating oil, fuel other than motor fuel, meals, margarine, cement, etc.).

B. **LICENSE TAXES.**—Taxes exacted (either for revenue raising or for regulation) as a condition to the exercise of a business or non-business privilege, at a flat rate or measured by such bases as capital stock, capital surplus, number of business units, or capacity. Excludes taxes measured directly by transactions, gross or net income, or value of property except those to which only nominal rates apply. "Licenses" based on these latter measures, other than those at nominal rates, are classified according to the measure concerned.

1. **Motor vehicles.**—License taxes imposed on owners or operators of motor vehicles, commercial and noncommercial, for the right to use public highways, including charges for title registration and inspection of vehicles. Does not include taxes on the business of motor transport nor property taxes or sales and gross receipts taxes relating to motor vehicles.

2. **Motor vehicle operators.**—Licenses for privilege of driving motor vehicles, including both private and commercial licenses.

3. **Corporations in general.**—Franchise license taxes, organization, filing, and entrance fees, and other license taxes which are applicable, with only specified exceptions, to all corporations.

4. **Public utilities.**—License taxes distinctively imposed on public passenger and freight transportation companies, telephone, telegraph, and light and power companies, and other public utility companies.

5. **Alcoholic beverages.**—License taxes for manufacturing, importing, wholesaling, and retailing alcoholic beverages other than those based on volume or value of transactions or assessed value of property.

6. **Chain stores.**—License taxes imposed distinctively on chain store organizations (i.e., groups of stores engaged in a similar kind of business under the same management) or upon individual units of a chain store system.

7. **Amusements.**—License taxes imposed upon amusement businesses generally or upon specific

amusement enterprises (e.g., race tracks, theaters, athletic events, pool halls, etc.). "Licenses" based on value or number of admissions, amount of wagers, or gross or net income are reported elsewhere.

8. Occupations and businesses not elsewhere classified.--License taxes (including examination and inspection fees) required of persons engaging in particular professions, trades, or occupations, and such taxes on businesses not elsewhere classified. Includes charges relating to inspection and marketing of seed, feed, fertilizer, gasoline, oil, citrus fruit, and other commodities, as well as licenses relating to operation of particular business enterprises.

9. Hunting and fishing licenses.--Commercial and noncommercial hunting and fishing licenses and shipping permits.

D. Other license taxes.--License taxes not listed separately above (e.g., animal licenses, marriage licenses, individual permits to purchase liquor, and other nonbusiness privileges).

C. INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAXES.--Taxes on individuals measured by net income and taxes distinctively imposed on special types of income (e.g., interest, dividends, income from intangibles, etc.). Taxes measured by income from intangible property are reported here even though locally designated as "property" taxes.

D. CORPORATION NET INCOME TAXES.--Taxes on corporations and unincorporated businesses (when taxed distinctively from individual income) measured by net income. Such taxes may be called "license" or "franchise" taxes. However designated, they are classified here if measured by net income.

E. PROPERTY TAXES.--Taxes conditioned on ownership of property and measured by its value. Property taxes are to be distinguished from special assessments, payable by owners of property benefited by specific public improvements and apportioned according to assumed benefits to the property affected.

1. General property taxes.--Property taxes which are applicable, with only specified exceptions, either to all property, to all tangible property, or to all real property, whether at a single rate or at classified effective rates. Includes State property-based taxes levied on subordinate local governments, such as taxes on towns levied by certain New England States.

2. Special property taxes.--Property taxes applying to special kinds of property, at rates that are not directly related to general property tax rates.

F. DEATH AND GIFT TAXES.--Taxes imposed on the transfer of property at death, in contemplation of death, or as a gift.

G. SEVERANCE TAXES.--Taxes imposed distinctively on removal of natural products--e.g., oil, gas, other minerals, timber, fish, etc.--from land or water and measured by value or quantity of products removed or sold.

H. POLL TAXES.--Capitation taxes levied as specific amounts, uniform or graded, against persons, or as ad valorem taxes on an arbitrary valuation of polls.

J. DOCUMENTARY AND STOCK TRANSFER TAXES.--Taxes on the recording, registering, and transferring of documents such as mortgages, deeds, and securities. However, taxes on recording or transfer of motor vehicles titles are reported at item B.1.

K. OTHER TAXES.--Taxes not listed separately or provided for in categories above.
