

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS CAUTION

### Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapor and spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Call a physician if irritation persists. **If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comment listed below.

1. Replace the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL statement with the following:

Store in a cool, dry area away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Replace cap, wrap container securely in several layers of newspaper, and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.

2. In the active ingredient declaration, add the chemical name of the compound tetramethrin directly following the accepted name "Tetramethrin".
