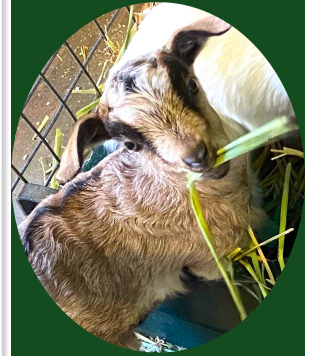


Carrum Newsletter
