



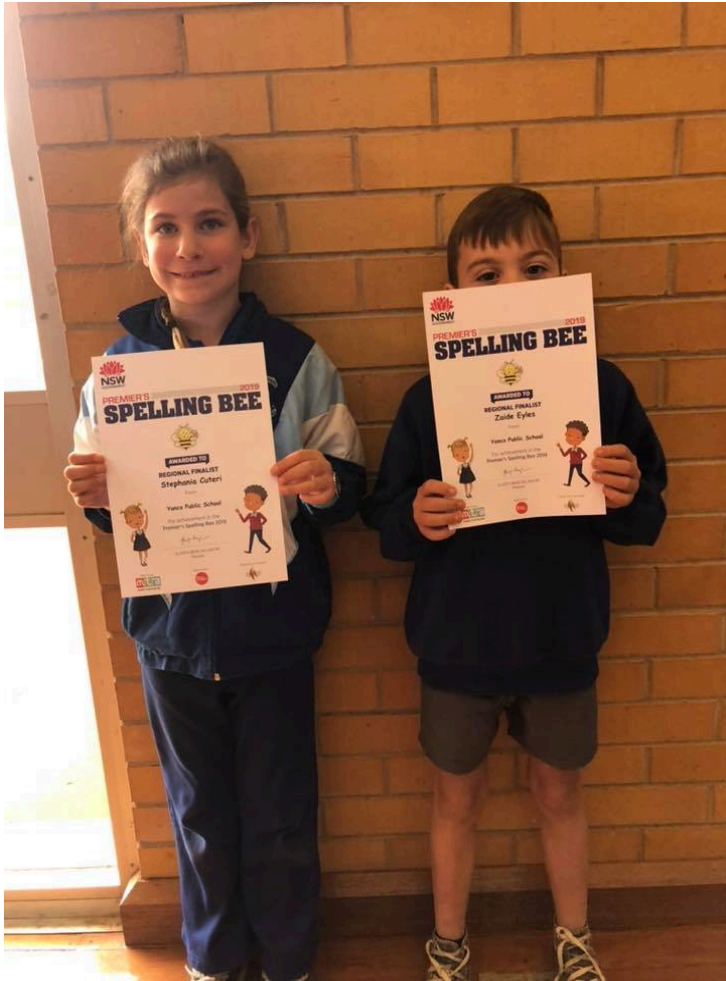

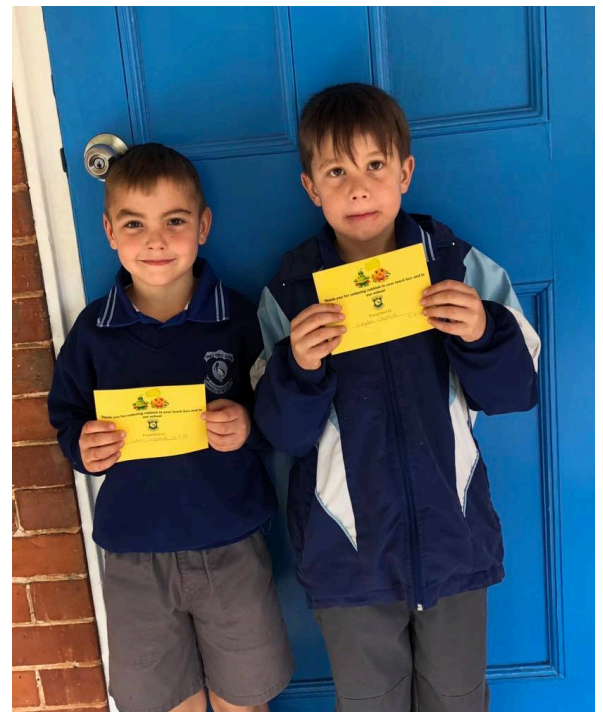
Agapanthus and Strawberry Plants

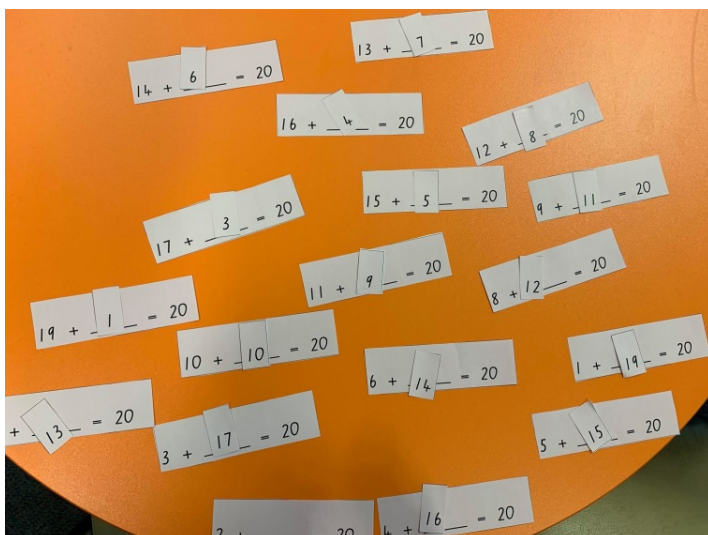
Learning Support

The students participating in learning support have been displaying impressive determination and their efforts are a credit to them. Activities these students have participated in include:

- quick recall of friends of 20 facts quizzes/matching;
- counting and numeral formation (using pom poms and little tongs for fine motor and counting practise);

- proofreading their own texts and;
- spelling rule sorting activities.
